**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** The Vancouver Canadians dropped game one of their six-game set with the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks), an 8-2 defeat on Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

Hillsboro led 3-0 after three innings thanks to a run in the first on a walk, a stolen base, a ground out and a sacrifice fly before Blaze Alexander hit a two-run homer in the third.

Despite the early deficit, Sem Robberse (L, 0-2) turned in his finest outing as a Canadian. The #13 Blue Jays prospect logged his first career quality start with six innings in which he allowed three runs on three hits, walked one and K'd four. He finished his outing by retiring the last ten batters he faced.

The C's got on the board in the fourth when Will Robertson slugged his third home run of the year to pull Vancouver within two, but a run in the seventh and four more in the eighth for the Hops put the proverbial nail in the coffin.

Three consecutive two out singles in the top of the ninth helped the Canadians add a run to their line, but it was far from enough in an 8-2 loss that allowed the Hops to snap an eight-game losing streak.

**BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO:** Vancouver and Hillsboro meet for their fourth series of the season this week. The C's faltered in round three August 3-8 when they were the home team for the first time; they lost the final four games of the series to fall to 8-10 against the Hops this year. Hillsboro has outscored the Canadians 85-74 in the season series thus far.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY:** August 25, 2010 - The C's overcame a 4-0 first inning deficit with a five-run third to beat Salem-Keizer 7-4 at Volcanoes Stadium. Three hits, a walk and two errors spurred the big inning, highlighted by A.J. Kirby-Jones' go-ahead two-run single. Zack Thornton got the win with three innings of relief to lead a bullpen game that was finished off by A.J. Griffin, who earned his 13<sup>th</sup> save of the season.

**500 CLUB:** Vancouver enters play today with 498 runs scored in 97 games, an average of 5.1 runs per game.

**BMOC:** Spencer Horwitz was named High-A West Player of the Week for August 17-22. The Timonium, MD native went 13-for-21 (.619) with three doubles, two home runs, six runs scored, six RBI and five walks. He reached base 67% of the time, slugged 1.048 and compiled an OPS of 1.715 in a series split with the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) while raising his season average from .260 to .274.

**OPENING SALVO:** Vancouver and opponents have combined to score 155 runs in the first inning this season, the most of any stanza. The C's have outscored their opposition 79-76.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING:** Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 13 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 25-for-49 (.510) with five doubles, three homers, 11 runs scored, 15 RBI and 13 walks while Morris is 16-for-54 (.296) with three doubles, a triple, seven runs scored, three RBI and six walks.

**ON THE HILL:** Paxton Schultz gets the nod for Vancouver. In his last turn on August 19, the right-hander earned the win over Tri-City with five innings in which he allowed four runs on seven hits with no walks and five strikeouts. He last faced the Hops on August 6 when he limited them to one run on four hits in five and a third but didn't factor into the decision. Schultz, 23, has a 6:1 strikeout-to-walk ratio in August.

Marcos Tineo climbs the slope for Hillsboro. He last worked August 19 in Spokane, a six-inning outing with three runs (one earned), seven hits, two walks and six strikeouts. Today is his second start against Vancouver; the C's hung him with the loss on August 4 with three runs on five hits in 6.2 innings in a duel with Adam Kloffenstein. Tineo, 24, began the year with Low-A Inland Empire, where he went 2-4 with a 5.51 ERA in 16 games (two starts) across 50.2 innings of work. Opponents hit .284 against him in the Low-A West but since his promotion he's held hitters to a .234 mark.
