THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On June 2, 2007, Nashville's Joe Dillon tied a franchise record by driving in seven runs against Tucson. The record was then broken on July 17, 2018 when Anthony Garcia drove in 8 runs at New Orleans.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds play game three of a six-game series tonight against the Durham Bulls. Durham ran away with a 17-4 win yesterday to even the series. Right-hander Josh Lindblom takes the bump for the Sounds, going against Durham's Easton McGee.

Josh Lindblom: 34-year-old Josh Lindblom starts for Nashville in game three of the series. The right-hander is 1-2 with a 2.89 ERA (46.2 IP/15 ER) in nine games (8 starts) in 2022. He makes his 100th minor league start of his career tonight. Lindblom last pitched on May 27 at Toledo, taking his second loss of the season. He allowed four runs (all earned) on nine hits and one walk in 5.1 innings. Striking out six, he became the first Sounds starter to reach 100 pitches in a start this year. The Lafayette, Ind. native was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star for Milwaukee after going 5-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 22 games (20 starts) with Nashville last season. Lindblom was signed as a free agent by the Brewers after the 2019 season. He won back-to-back Choi Dong-Won Awards (KBO Cy Young) with Doosan in 2018-19. Lindblom was originally selected by the Dodgers in the 2nd Round of the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue.

Easton McGee: 24-year-old Easton McGee starts for the Bulls in game three of the series. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 5.79 ERA (37.1 IP/24 ER) in 10 games (7 starts) with Durham. McGee pitched 4.0 scoreless innings in his last start on May 27 vs. Charlotte. He did not allow a hit, striking out seven on 39 pitches (32 strikes). The Hopkinsville, Ky. native went 6-2 with a 4.07 ERA in 19 games (18 starts) for Double-A Montgomery in 2021. Before the canceled 2020 MiLB season, McGee was a Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star for Single-A Bowling Green. He was drafted by the Rays in the 4th Round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Hopkinsville (KY) High School.

Superlatives...Last night's loss dropped the Sounds to 25-5 when scoring first...27-7 when scoring 4+ runs...14-3 when recording 10+ hits...11-7 when committing 1+ errors and 15-10 on the road.

The Nashville List: Monday's win for Rick Sweet was his 180th as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

Making Moves: In conjunction with the Milwaukee Brewers, the Sounds announced on Monday that INF Willy Adames has joined the club on a Major League rehab assignment. Additionally, RHP Jason Alexander became the seventh Sound to have his contract selected by the Brewers this season and made his Major League debut yesterday against the Cubs (7.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K).

Super Mario: Catcher Mario Feliciano had a season-high 3 RBI in yesterday's game, going 3-for-4 with two doubles. He is batting .453 (24-for-53) with seven runs, four doubles and eight RBI in his last 13 games.

He Gets On Base: Jonathan Davis reached base safely in his 15th-straight game on Wednesday, going 2-for-5 with an RBI. During the 15-game streak, Davis is hitting .300 (18-for-60) with 11 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI, 12 walks and 4 stolen bases. It's the 8th-longest active streak in the International League.

Welcome Back Mark: 3B Mark Mathias played in his first game back with Nashville after a brief stint with the Brewers last week. The Californian went 1-for-1 with a double, three walks and a stolen base.

Earn It: Nashville's team ERA sits at 3.43 (430.2 IP/164 ER), despite giving up 17 earned runs yesterday. The 3.43 ERA is the best mark across Triple-A Baseball, ahead of Iowa's 3.84 as second-best. Nashville's seven shutouts also leads Triple-A Baseball.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on May 27 in a start at Toledo and was tagged with his second loss of the season. He worked 5.1 innings and allowed four runs on nine hits and one walk. He struck out six and threw 100 pitches. Lindblom notched season-highs in pitches, strikes (68), hits and runs.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom has faced Durham twice in his career - once with Indianapolis on June 28, 2017 and for the second time earlier this year in a home start on April 9. He shutout the Bulls over 5.0 innings at First Horizon Park and picked up his lone win of the season. He allowed two hits and two walks and struck out four.

- Struck out a season-high 8 batters on 4/21 vs. Charlotte and later duplicated the 8 strikeouts on 4/27 at St. Paul.
