LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on May 27 in a start at Toledo and was tagged with his second loss of the season. He worked 5.1 innings and allowed four runs on nine hits and one walk. He struck out six and threw 100 pitches. Lindblom notched season-highs in pitches, strikes (68), hits and runs.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Lindblom has faced Durham twice in his career once with Indianapolis on June 28, 2017 and for the second time earlier this year in a home start on April 9. He shutout the Bulls over 5.0 innings at First Horizon Park and picked up his lone win of the season. He allowed two hits and two walks and struck out four.
