YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 4-3, in 12 innings to snap a five-game losing streak. **Victor Bericoto** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the first inning. In the fifth, **Diego Velasquez** scored on a wild pitch to extend the lead to 2-0. **Jack Choate** started for Richmond and threw six scoreless innings, tying the longest outing of his career. Brady Allen tied the score with a two-run double in the bottom of the seventh. **Braxton Roxby** threw three hitless, scoreless innings out of the Richmond bullpen. In the top of the 12th, Velasquez hit an RBI single and Bericoto drove in **Aeverson Arteaga** with a sacrifice fly to open a 4-2 lead. The SeaWolves scored a run in the bottom of the 12th but **Tyler Myrick** ended the game for his third save of the year.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Richmond dropped four-of-six at The Diamond against the SeaWolves from May 13-18. The two teams meet again for a six-game series at UPMC Park from August 5-10.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,935 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 4-14 in their last 18 games. They dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the Senators. The previous week, they went 1-5 at Binghamton and lost three times on walk-off hits. Of Richmond's 39 losses this season, 20 of them have been by two runs or less (13 by one, seven by two). The Richmond offense has the third-fewest strikeouts (437) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (175). Richmond's pitching staff has a league-high 4.81 ERA.

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Akron. They are 7-2 in their last nine games. For the year, the Erie offense leads the Eastern League in batting average (.263), runs (304), hits (475), total bases (767), doubles (110), RBIs (277), OBP (.345), SLG (.425) and OPS (.770). Erie's roster features eight of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including C/1B Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 7), RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 17), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), INF Max Anderson (No. 21), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 25) and RHP RJ Petit (No. 28). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list features four Erie players, including Liranzo (No. 5), Hamm (No. 11), Melton (No. 24) and Bigbie (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his 11th start of the season and the second of his career against the SeaWolves. In his last start on Sunday at The Diamond, Lonsway was hit with his second straight loss after allowing three runs over 3.2 innings against the Senators. He faced the SeaWolves on May 15 and threw 6.2 innings and allowed three runs in a loss. For the season, Lonsway is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (50.1) and 10th in ERA (3.22). Since joining the team last summer, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run nine-of-16 Double-A outings, including four-of-11 starts in 2025. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. **For more on Lonsway, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Carlos Peña makes his seventh Double-A start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Saturday at Reading and threw six innings, his longest outing of the year, and allowed one run in a win. On May 15 at The Diamond, Peña threw five innings and allowed three runs in a loss. Dating back to 2022, Pena has spent parts of three seasons with the SeaWolves, going 10-9 with a 3.27 ERA in 35 games (25 starts). He was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2019.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to catch 28 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for second among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for third among Double-A catchers with 17 runners caught stealing, which is tied for first in the EL. Morgan is fourth in the Eastern League with 11.

BERI'S BACK: Outfielder/first baseman **Victor Bericoto** returned to the Richmond roster on Tuesday. He was placed on the injured list with Triple-A Sacramento on May 9 and played six games with the ACL Giants on a rehab assignment before returning to the Flying Squirrels. Bericoto opened the season with Richmond and hits .319 with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs in 13 games before being promoted to the River Cats on April 20. In his Richmond career dating back to 2023, Bericoto has homered 25 times, which is tied with **Frankie Tostado** for the eighth-most in franchise history, two behind a four-way tie for fourth place.

HELLO, GAVELLO: Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. On May 29, he hit his first Double-A homer, a two-run shot to right. On Wednesday night in his first plate appearance, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the ninth inning. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in 12-of-17 Double-A games he has played, including five doubles, and is batting .333. He has played one game at shortstop, one at third base and 14 games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

TAKING THE JAIRO: **Jairo Pomares** has picked up at least one hit in six-of-his-last-seven games dating back to May 29, batting .385 (10-for-26) with a homer, two doubles, three RBIs and three walks, raising his season batting average from .185 to .213. That stretch includes four two-hit games. He hit a solo homer on Wednesday, his first since May 2, snapping a 25-game homerless streak.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: **Diego Velasquez** picked up three hits on Friday for the second time in his last six games. He has also walked 12 times in his last 12 games dating back to May 24, the most in the Eastern League in that span, posting a .453 on-base percentage. He is now tied for seventh in the Eastern League with 28 walks this season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Diego Velasquez** is tied for seventh in walks (28) and tied for eighth in hits (51). **Seth Lonsway** is 10th in ERA (3.22) and ninth in innings pitched (50.1). **Jack Choate** is tied for first in games started (11), fifth in strikeouts (59). **John Michael Bertrand** is tied for first in games started (11) and fourth in innings pitched (55.2). **Joe Whitman** is 10th in BAA (.227).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 220 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features five players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Joe Whitman** (No. 5), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 10), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 21) and **Jack Choate** (No. 26). **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. **Adrian Sugastey** is ranked as the top defensive catcher. **Aeverson Arteaga** is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Whitman (No. 7), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27).

SHUFFLING THE RANKINGS: Baseball America announced updated top-30 prospects lists for all 30 clubs on Friday afternoon. On the San Francisco Giants' list, **Joe Whitman** jumped from No. 10 to No. 5, **Diego Velasquez** climbed from No. 13 to No. 10 and **Jack Choate** moved from No. 28 to No. 26. **Sabin Ceballos** fell from No. 16 to No. 21 and **Aeverson Arteaga** went dropped out of the top 30 after being ranked No. 27.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1958: The Richmond Virginians beat the Montreal Royals, 5-1, at Parker Field. Bob Chakales pitched a complete game and allowed one hit, a two-out single in the second inning by Sandy Amoros. Richmond scored four runs in the first inning. Bobby Del Greco doubled off George "Sparky" Anderson's glove and scored on a single by Johnny Jaciuk. Bob Oldis added a two-run triple and scored on a single by Cletis Boyer. **1960:** The Richmond Virginians lost to the Rochester Red Wings, 2-0, at Parker Field. The only two runs scored on a two-run homer by reigning IL Rookie of the Year Charlie James in the fifth inning. Facing Bob Gibson, the Vees loaded the bases with one out in the fourth but did not score. Gibson threw a complete-game shutout and struck out 10 batters for his first win of the season. **1979:** The Atlanta Braves beat the Richmond Braves, 12-6, in an exhibition at Parker Field. Glenn Hubbard went 4-for-5 and drove in four runs, driving a two-run single in the first and a two-run homer in the eighth. Richmond held a 6-3 lead before Atlanta scored nine straight runs over the seventh and eighth. **2005:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 4-3, in 12 innings at The Diamond. Michael Rosamond beat out a broken-bat infield single to win the game in the bottom of the ninth. **2014:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Fightin Phils, 5-1, at Reading. Kyle Crick started and allowed one run, a solo homer, over five innings. Relievers Andrew Carignan, Edwin Quirarte and Derek Law covered the final four innings. Jarrett Parker had a double and two RBIs. Angel Villalona added a pinch-hit, two-run homer in the ninth inning.
