SHRIMP SHUT OUT BY STRIPERS, 2-0

The Jumbo Shrimp mustered only one hit on Thursday in a 2-0 loss to the Stripers. The only runs in the game came in the seventh inning. Gwinnett finally broke the scoreless tie on a **Carlos Santana** RBI single before **Kyle Farmer** added a sacrifice fly to make it 2-0. The lone Jacksonville hit was **Cam Cannarella's** leadoff single to start the game. The Jumbo Shrimp failed to even get a runner to third base en route to being one-hit for the third time this season and shut out for the sixth time. **Dax Fulton** fanned five in 2.2 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen has worked five games in a row yielding no more than two runs. During this span, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have ceded only five runs, four earned, in 20.0 innings for a 1.80 ERA. Jacksonville relievers have combined to yield only 19 hits and eight walks while striking out 27 during this span. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has registered the fourth-fewest innings of any Triple-A relief corps (456.0) while ranking fourth at the level in ERA (4.32).

ROAD KILL

Following a hard-fought 5-4 victory on July 2 at Nashville, Jacksonville improved their road record to an impressive 24-15 (.615). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with 13 consecutive road losses before finally winning 6-3 on Wednesday at Gwinnett. However, with another defeat on Thursday at the Stripers, Jacksonville has still lost 14 of its last 15 road games, getting outscored by a whopping 97-51 (-46) margin during this span.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

In 24 games from May 10-June 10, **Deyvison De Los Santos** went just 21-for-94 at the plate, batting .223/.247/.330/.577 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs, three walks and eight runs scored. In the 38 games since, however, the Santo Domingo, D.R., native is 40-for-133 at the plate, slashing .301/.377/.519/.896 (8 2B, 7 HR, 25 RBIs, 14 BB, 16 R). In 2026, De Los Santos has shaved his strikeout rate down to 18.3 percent from a peak of 26.3 percent in both the 2022 and 2023 seasons (24.7 percent in 2024, 22.4 percent in 2025).

NEED FOR SPEED

Heading into play on July 1, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked second in Triple-A in stolen bases with 141, but the club's 79.7 percent success rate placed only 14th at the level. Since that point, Jacksonville has swiped 54 bases in 28 games (1.92 per game) on an 85.7 percent success rate. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have piled up 195 stolen bases, good enough for second in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are averaging 1.79 steals per game, just shy of their team-record pace of 2.03 last season, when they swiped 305 bags in 150 games.

RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp have dropped 20 of their last 26 contests, with 12 of those defeats coming by just one run. A big culprit in these losses has been their lack of success hitting with runners in scoring position. Over the last 26 games, Jacksonville is just 51-for-241 (.212) at the plate with runners in scoring position. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .245/.340/.404/.744 with runners in scoring position, significantly better than their .227/.330/.368/.698 line with the bases empty.

OH GREAT STARTING PITCHING, WHERE ART THOU

Jacksonville ranks seventh in Triple-A in innings pitched by starting pitchers at 484.0. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled to get length from their starting pitching of late. Just six times has the club seen its lid-lifter toss at least 5.0 innings in the 27 games since July 2. Jacksonville starters have mustered only 98.1 innings pitched over the last 27 games (3.6 per game) with an ugly 8.51 ERA (93 ER in 98.1 IP). The club is just 7-20 in these contests.

12-GAGE

Jacksonville infielder **Gage Miller** has gotten off to a blistering start to his time in Triple-A since a May 26 promotion from Double-A Pensacola. The Palmyra, Pa., native has reached base in 25 of his 32 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, slashing .323/.463/.583/1.046 with seven doubles, six home runs, 21 RBIs, 21 walks and 22 runs scored. In fact, Miller has either scored and/or driven in a run in 21 of those 32 contests. After posting a 12.9 percent walk rate and a .102 ISO in 2025, Miller has increased those numbers to 14.8 percent and .214, respectively, in 2026.

ABOUT BRADLEY

-Blalock was high school teammates with fellow future major leaguer Parker Meadows at Grayson High School (Loganville, Ga.). The Boston Red Sox selected Blalock in the 32nd round of the 2019 MLB draft.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 to Milwaukee for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujanyer Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 15, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."

2025 SEASON

-Blalock struggled at Coors Field in Denver; he had a 2-4 record and 12.27 ERA in seven appearances, including six starts, at home (29.1 IP, 50 H, 40 R, 40 ER, 9 HR, 14 BB, 9 K, .388 BAA). He was slightly better in seven appearances, including six starts, on the road for Colorado, going 0-2 with a 6.44 ERA (29.1 IP, 35 H, 21 R, 21 ER, 8 HR, 9 BB, 18 K, .307 BAA).

-Opposing left-handed hitters batted .294/.366/.500/.866 against Blalock in 265 plate appearances. Blalock held right-handed to a .220/.290/.332/.622 line in 257 plate appearances.
