TEERING OFF

- **TODAY'S GAME:** JR Ritchie takes the ball hoping for a traditional start and game after having to operate in doubleheaders in each of the last two weeks. He will face the man who is arguably the ace of the Wood Ducks' staff, David Davalillo.
- **NEW FACES:** The GreenJackets' offense received a new look during the roadtrip, as a trio of newcomers have entered the fray for their full-season debuts. The trio is headlined by outfielder Luis Guanipa, the Braves' #8 prospect, along with outfielder Junior Garcia and infielder John Gil.
- **JUST PLAY THE HITS:** The Augusta offense has been held quiet as of late, scoring 3 runs or fewer in 11 of the last 14 games. The 'Jackets saw their hit totals increase over the week in Myrtle Beach, and have scored 5 runs in back to back ballgames.
- **LEFT FOR DEAD:** The GreenJacket offense has struggled intensely against left handed pitching all season long, hobbling to a .145 average against southpaws. The last 10 games started by a lefty have all been losses for Augusta, but did not see a lefty starter against the Pelicans.
- **ERROR, PAGE NOT FOUND:** The GreenJacket defense started off slowly, but saw marked improvements as the season went on. There has been a slight step back following the All-Star break, with 17 errors committed in the last 11 games.
- **LOW POWER MODE:** The GreenJackets have struggled with the long ball often this season, but have seen the power numbers rise at home of late. 20 of the team's 34 long balls (counting Noah Williams' grand slam from a currently suspended game) have come at SRP Park, including Joe Olsavsky last night.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Augusta will battle some potentially turbulent weather to send JR Ritchie to the bump and turn the week around against the Wood Ducks, who counter with David Davalillo.

CAREER: Drafted 35th overall by the Braves in 2022 out of Bainbridge HS in Washington state... had a strong debut in 2022 in 5 starts between the FCL and Augusta... repeated with the GreenJackets to begin 2023, flashed obscure strikeout numbers (25 in 13.1 IP) but ran into some barrels across four starts before tearing his right UCL and requiring surgery... currently sits as the #4 prospect in the Braves' system with ceiling of a mid-rotation starter according to MLB Pipeline... breaking balls are defining characteristic, especially his slider... fastball sat low 90s and ran up to 96 in both HS and pro debut... was committed to UCLA but phenomenal senior year for the Bainbridge Spartans where he allowed just two earned runs and struck out 74 batters in 35.1 innings put him firmly enough on pro radar that he went to the Braves.
