LATE RALLY FALLS SHORT IN 7-4 LOSS TO BULLS

Victor Mesa Jr. homered and scored twice on Saturday, but the Jumbo Shrimp fell 7-4 to the Bulls. **Kameron Misner** led off the game with a home run, and later in the first, **Josh Lowe** notched an RBI triple and **Curtis Mead** registered an RBI ground out to make it 3-0 very quickly. **Troy Johnston's** RBI single in the bottom of the first got Jacksonville on the board. A **Taylor Walls** triple and error plated a Bulls run in the fourth. The score remained 4-1 until the seventh, when **Rene Pinto** launched a two-run home run and **C.J. Hinojosa** added an RBI single. Mesa Jr. cracked a solo shot in the eighth. In the ninth, **Tristan Gray** lashed an RBI double and **Griffin Conine** added an RBI single to get it to 7-4.

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 48-for-164 (.293/.441/.561/1.002) with 12 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 40 walks and 26 runs scored in 47 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks third in the International League in on-base percentage, fourth in OPS, tied for fourth in walks, ninth in slugging percentage, tied for ninth in extra-base hits (23), tied for 15th in home runs and 19th in batting average. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (4.9 percent) and 25th in line drive rate (28.2 percent).

BULL-Y PULPIT

In Jacksonville's first road trip of the 2022 season, the Jumbo Shrimp took four out of six from Durham. The clubs have played seven series since, including this current one, and the Bulls have won six of them, with just one split. Jacksonville is just 12-29 (.293) against Durham over this stretch. The Bulls have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp 273-201, an average of 6.7-4.9 per game. Durham has also outscored Jacksonville by a 64-54 margin over these 41 games.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 36 of Jacksonville's 56 games (64.3 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 18 of the club's last 25 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 18 of its last 21 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 15-21 (.417) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder **Griffin Conine** suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 22 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 21-for-his-last-70, slashing .300/.405/.629/1.034 with five doubles, six home runs, 19 RBIs, 13 walks and 13 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 13 of those 22 games, with multiple RBIs in four contests.

THE GREAT AWAKENING?

The Jumbo Shrimp were shut out on May 22, marking their 17th loss in 20 games. During that 20-game stretch, Jacksonville ranked 27th in Triple-A in batting average (.233), 29th in OBP (.319), 30th in SLG (.351), 30th in OPS (.670), 25th in hits (157) and 29th in runs scored (75). Over the last eight games, however, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated 52 runs - tied for the eighth-most in Triple-A, and tied for second in the International League - on 91 hits (4th in AAA) with 45 walks (8th). As a team over these last eight games, Jacksonville is 91-for-313, ranking fourth in batting average (.291), fifth in OBP (.381), eighth in SLG (.444) and seventh in OPS (.825).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, **Javier Sanoja** was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 21 of his last 23 games, notching 11 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 35-for-92 (.380/.443/.543/.986) with eight doubles, two triples, one home run, 18 RBIs, 12 walks and 14 runs scored. Among the 201 IL hitters with at least 100 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.6 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 8-19 record in May was the club's worst record in any month since at least 2005.

ABOUT SHAUN

-A native of Coral Springs, Fla., Anderson was originally selected by the Washington Nationals in the 40th round of the 2013 draft out of American Heritage High School (Plantation, Fla.). After a three-year career at the University of Florida in which he garnered All-America honors, Anderson was picked by the Boston Red Sox in the third round of the 2016 draft.

-Anderson made his major league debut for the San Francisco Giants on May 15, 2019 against the Toronto Blue Jays at Oracle Park. He went 5.0 innings and yielded three runs, two earned, on two hits with five strikeouts against three walks. His first MLB win came three starts later when he tossed 7.0 innings of two-run ball in an 8-2 Giants victory over the Baltimore Orioles on June 1, 2019 at Camden Yards. Anderson struck out four, walked one and ceded five hits.
