**JUNE 20<sup>th</sup> COLUMBUS (30-40) at WORCESTER (33-38) 6:45 pm**

Columbus Clippers RHP Xzavion Curry (1-6, 7.24) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Jason Alexander (3-4, 4.06)

**10-4 WooSox** – The Worcester Red Sox – who won last night, 10-4 after losing on Tuesday, 16-4 – try to gain the upper hand in their 6-game series against the Columbus Clippers (AAA-Cleveland) when they play game three tonight at 6:45 pm at Polar Park. Tonight's game is live on NESN and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. Last night the WooSox used 3 homeruns (2 by Wilyer Abreu and 1 by Jamie Westbrook, who had 5 RBI on the night) to gain a measure of revenge with their 10-4 triumph following a rough series-opener on Tuesday when the Clippers smashed 6 HR en route to their 16-4 victory.

**Must See Thursday Game** – Let's hope the Weather Gods cooperate and tonight's game goes off without a hitch. However, Thursday's have been Worcester's kryptonite this season. The WooSox have had six Thursday home dates this season and five have been impacted by weather...two of the six at Polar Park have been postponed due to rain (April 4 & 18) and three other Thursdays (May 2 & 23 and June 5) have had rain delays at the start. May 2 had a 48-minute delay, the WooSox endured a 2 hour & 46 minute rain delay at the start of May 23, and their last Thursday game on June 5 began after a 46-minute rain delay before first pitch. May 16 has been the only Polar Park Thursday game unaffected by weather thus far this season. We hope to add June 20<sup>th</sup> to that tonight.

**Home Goods** – Worcester is back over .500 at Polar Park this year with their 19-18 record in Worcester (compared to 14-20 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, were recently 0-7 from May 22 – June 5, then went 3-0 from June 6-8, before currently going 1-2 in their last three games at home.

**This Homestand** – This week/weekend is the 6<sup>th</sup> WooSox homestand of the year. They will have five homestands during the second half of the season that begins next week. It is Peanut Allergy-Friendly Week at Polar Park all homestand with games remaining tonight & tomorrow both at 6:45 pm and then over the weekend on Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm. **Welcome Back Jim Ed Rice** – Boston Red Sox and Baseball Hall of Famer Jim Rice will greet fans for photos in the Sherwood's Diner during the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> innings tonight as our Throwback Thursday guest. Jim was at Polar Park last July 27 and we are thrilled to welcome him back. Rice spent all 16 of his Major League seasons with the Red Sox, the 5<sup>th</sup>-most in franchise-history. In 2,089 games he batted .298 with 382 HR & 1451 RBI and ranks among the Top 5 in Red Sox history in games, runs (1249), hits (2452), HR, RBI, extra-base hits, and total bases. The outfielder was an 8-time American League All-Star. He won the 1978 AL MVP when he had 406 total bases (most in the American League since 1938) and became the only player in MLB history to lead the league in HR, triples, and RBI in the same season. Jim is the last player to win the International League Triple Crown when he hit .337 along with 25 HR and 93 RBI in just 117 games for the 1974 PawSox to lead the league in all three categories. He is Pawtucket's all-time hitting leader with a .340 average. Jim was enshrined in the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown in 2009. He was also a member of the first class of Red Sox Hall of Fame inductees in 1995, was elected to the International League Hall of Fame in 2008, had his uniform #14 retired by the Boston Red Sox in 2009, and was elected to the first-ever class of PawSox Hall of Fame in 2016. Rice will be introduced on-field before the game and will greet fans and pose for photos in the Sherwood's Diner on Summit St. behind the outfield during the 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> innings.

**WooSox Tickets** – Tickets for all WooSox Summer Games are on sale at woosox.com, by calling 508-500-8888, or at the Polar Park Ticket Office.

***Five Below*** – The WooSox are 33-38 and will finish below .500 during the first half. Three times this season (all this month), Worcester had fallen to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500. Those dates came most recently on June 14 (30-37) as well as on June 12 at 29-36 and on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

***Clipper Ship*** - The Worcester Red Sox and the Columbus Clippers (AAA-Cleveland) are meeting for the second time ever this week. Last season from April 11-16, Columbus came to Polar Park and won 5 of 6 games in resounding fashion. The Clippers out-scored the WooSox, 59-17, out-homered the Sox, 12-4, and posted victories by scores of 5-1, 10-3, 10-5, 16-1, 8-1, and 10-1 around the lone WooSox win by a 6-5 score on April 15. WooSox pitchers during that series were 1-5 with an 8.67 ERA as Clippers batters hit .325. Sox hitters had a .195 average during the 6-game set.

***Splitsville*** - After not splitting any of their first nine series of the year, the WooSox have split each of their last three series. They had to settle for splits during 6-game series at Charlotte and vs. Rochester, but this past weekend earned a split in Buffalo by winning each of the final two games of that 6-game set. Worcester is 4-5-3 in their first 12 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 4 splits).

***Ups and Downs*** – In the last month covering 25 games, this has been the WooSox pattern...a 6-game losing streak from May 22-28, a 3-game winning streak from May 29-31, a 4-game losing skid from June 1-5, won 3 straight from June 6-8, lost 3 in a row from June 9-12, and most recently they are 3-3 in their last six games.

***On-Base Machine*** – Worcester is 1<sup>st</sup> in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs with their .369 on-base pct. The WooSox are just 13<sup>th</sup> in the league with a .253 team batting average but the Sox are tops in the league with 367 walks (most in all of Triple-A in fact) and the WooSox lead the IL with 55 hit batsmen. It all adds up to an impressive .369 OBP.

***Trying to Get in Tune in June*** – The WooSox are 7-9 in June thus far. The teams is batting .269 this month (145-for-540) with 17 HR while pitchers have a 4.96 ERA (77 ER in 139.2) with 19 HRA. Worcester has out-scored their opponents 100-93 in June.

***Left at the Altar*** – The WooSox lead the International League with 554 runners left on base this season.

***Hit Me With Your Best Shot*** – WooSox batters are 1<sup>st</sup> in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 55 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

***Rankings*** – Worcester is 13<sup>th</sup> in the IL in team batting with a .253 average while Columbus is 1<sup>st</sup> at .266. On the pitching side, the Sox are 13<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (5.07) while the Clippers are 17<sup>th</sup> with a 5.31 ERA.

**Streaks** – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester’s longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester’s longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

**Series Math** – Worcester is 4-5-3 in their first 12 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 3 splits). After not splitting any of their first nine series of the year, the WooSox have split each of their last three sets. Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

**Two for Ones** – Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season – until May 16 (and then May 17 as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until their dramatic, 13-12 win on May 16 followed by May 17<sup>th</sup>’s 9-8 triumph. They are now 2-10 in 1-run affairs (by far the worst mark in the league in that category). Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 5-7 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

**Daydream Believers** – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (17-17) than at night (16-21).

**Comeback Kids** – Worcester has 15 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 9 losses during the opponent’s final at-bat.

**May Be or Might Be** - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. The WooSox finished 10-14 in April after going 2-1 in March. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

**April Recap** - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

**A Winning Tradition** – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

**Finish Line** – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7<sup>th</sup>-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1<sup>st</sup> half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half sending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

**You Need a Scorecard** – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

**Two Dozen to Go** - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

**PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE** – The Portland Sea Dogs (35-30) fell back into 2<sup>nd</sup>-place (a ½-game behind Hartford) in the Eastern League Northeast Division with four games remaining in the 1<sup>st</sup> half. The Sea Dogs suffered an 18-4 loss to the Richmond Flying Squirrels last night. Roman Anthony had 2 hits including a solo HR (#7) while Marcelo Mayer had 2 hits including his Double-A leading 25<sup>th</sup> double of the season. Robert Kwiatkowski dropped to 7-1 on the year giving up 5 runs in 1.2 innings.

**WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES** – No roster moves as of mid-afternoon.

Worcester has already used 57 players this season (27 position players and 30 pitchers). The list does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox on May 3 but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on May 12 with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 12 players to Boston in the 12 weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, and INF/OF Jamie Westbrook. Those 12 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O’Neill, and OF Masataka Yoshida who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Heineman, and Westbrook are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
