

RIDERS BLANKED BY MISSIONS IN SERIES FINALE:

The Frisco RoughRiders were shut out by the San Antonio Missions 4-0 on Sunday night from Riders Field. San Antonio (15-18, 54-48) struck first in the top of the second when Marcos Castañon scored on a wild pitch to take a 1-0 lead. Romeo Sanabria then cranked a solo homer in the top of the third, stretching the lead to 2-0. After Frisco (12-21, 50-51) shut out the Missions offense for four-straight innings, Moisés Gomez hit an infield single that allowed Francisco Acuña to score on a throwing error, expanding San Antonio's lead to 3-0. In the top of the ninth inning, Sanabria lifted a sacrifice fly to pad the Missions lead to 4-0. San Antonio reliever Ethan Routzahn then worked a scoreless ninth to secure the win. Missions starter Jared Kollar (1-5) earned the win, pitching 5.2 shutout innings. Frisco starter Josh Stephan (5-5) took the loss, allowing two runs across 3.2 innings.

ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 4.29 in the second half is sixth in the Texas League, while it is 4.01 since the start of July, which is third in the league. Last week, Frisco starters owned a league-best 2.77 ERA, though they went 3-3 in the series against the Missions.

PICKING UP THE OFFENSE:

After a tough month in June on offense, hitting .218/.308/.306/.614 with a league-worst 3.4 runs per game and just 13 homers (tied for second-fewest in the league), the Riders were better in July. The Riders were third in batting average (.244), third in slugging (.379), fourth in OPS (.664), third in home runs (22) and third in runs per game (4.8). The Riders were also 29-for-36 in steals during the month.

HE IS ABIMELECTRIC:

Abimelec Oritz was on fire at the plate in July and that led to a promotion to Triple-A Round Rock on Tuesday. In the month, he hit .341/.400/.682/1.082 over 21 games with eighth doubles, seven home runs, 17 RBIs and eight walks. In his last 14 games, he is batting .429 (24-for-56)/.450/.821/1.271 with seven doubles, five home runs and 14 RBIs. He finishes his Riders career tied for fifth in franchise history with 34 home runs in his 204 games (tied with Nate Gold).

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:

In their last 20 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 14 of the 20 games, but they are 8-12. The Riders have blown six saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 31 games, he is hitting .333 (38-for-114)/.403/.395/.798 with seven doubles, seven RBIs, 12 walks, 15 runs scored and just 17 strikeouts. In July, he batted .310 (22-for-71) over 19 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been solid for the RoughRiders on offense in 2025. In his last 68 games since May 7th, he is batting .275/.334/.462/.796 with 19 doubles, eight home runs, 29 RBIs and 16 stolen bases. In his last 32 games, he is slashing .293/.340/.504/.844 with nine doubles, five home runs, 18 RBIs, 23 runs scored and nine steals.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.0 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
