FRES-NOTES

HOMER HAPPY: Fresno hit three home runs in Wednesday night's 9-5 victory over Ontario, matching its second-highest total of the season. It marked the Grizzlies' first three-homer game since May 16 vs. Visalia, when Matt Klein, Jack O'Dowd and Tanner Thach combined to go deep in an 11-3 victory. It was also Fresno's first game with multiple home runs since June 13 at Visalia, when Kyle Fossum homered twice in a 15-7 win. Wednesday was the club's 10th game with at least two home runs this season and improved the Grizzlies to 9-1 when hitting multiple home runs.

WORKING THE COUNT: The Grizzlies continue to win with patience at the plate. Fresno drew a season-high 12 walks in Tuesday's series opener before adding nine more Wednesday, giving the club 21 walks in the first two games against Ontario. Fresno has now drawn 69 walks in eight games against the Tower Buzzers this season—an average of 8.6 walks per game—helping offset a .243 batting average in the season series. The Grizzlies own a .404 on-base percentage against Ontario, nearly 160 points higher than their batting average.

SURVIVING THE OFFENSE: No matchup has produced more offense for Fresno this season than the series against Ontario. Through eight games, the two clubs have combined for 145 runs, with Fresno holding a 73-72 advantage despite being out-hit 102-66. Ontario enters Thursday batting .337 with a 1.006 OPS and 16 home runs against Grizzlies pitching, while Fresno has countered by drawing 69 walks and hitting 11 home runs of its own. Grizzlies pitchers have also piled up 84 strikeouts in the matchup, averaging more than one strikeout per inning.

SCORING EARLY: Fresno's offense has done its best work at the beginning of games this season. The Grizzlies have scored 59 runs in the first inning and a team-high 73 runs in the second inning, accounting for 132 of their 492 runs (26.8%) before the third inning begins. The second inning has been Fresno's highest-scoring frame this season, while the club has also topped 60 runs in the seventh inning (63). Establishing early offense has been a key ingredient to the Grizzlies' success, as they again jumped on Ontario early in Wednesday's 9-5 victory.

POWER PLAY: Wednesday marked the first time this season that Wilder Dalis, Cameron Nelson and Yeiker Reyes all homered in the same game. Dalis launched his fifth home run of the season, Nelson hit his third, and Reyes connected for his first with the Grizzlies. The trio accounted for seven of Fresno's nine runs, helping the club record its first three-homer game in more than six weeks.
