TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a three-game set with the Harrisburg Senators, Altoona is 9-7 against Harrisburg this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Fabricio Macias rocked a three-run double in the 8th inning, Andres Alvarez and Aaron Shackleford each homered in a 7-5 loss to Harrisburg.

WE'RE ON TOP: With three series victories over Harrisburg, Akron and Richmond to begin the second half, Altoona begins their post-All-Star Game road trip with the best record in the Southwest Division. Altoona has won three straight six-game series for the first time since this schedule format began in 2021.

ALL IT TAKES IS ONE: Altoona picked up a 1-0 walk-off win on Saturday, July 16 by Connor Scott. It was just the 8th time in franchise history that Altoona has won a game on a walk-off, 1-0, though it was the first time that the Curve won on a sacrifice fly in a 1-0 win. Altoona last won 1-0 on a walk-off from Tyler Gaffney on 6/7/2018 against Reading. Saturday also marked the 8th time in franchise history that the Curve won on a sac fly.

AARON SHACKELGOAT: Curve INF Aaron Shackleford picked up his second multi-homer game of the season on Friday, July 15 against Richmond. Shackleford hit the second of back-to-back homers with Blake Sabol in the first inning and added another solo homer in the third inning. The Curve previously got a multi-homer game from Shackleford on June 17 against Erie and he hit the first of back-to-back home runs on May 22 against Richmond with Andres Alvarez. In the second half (6/28 - Present), Shackleford is batting .344/.408/.656 with 8 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI and 2-2 SB.

In the second half, Shackleford ranks all over the league leaderboards: 7th in BA (.344), 3rd in SLG% (.656), 5th in OPS (1.064), T-7th in H (22), and T-2nd in XBH (12).

IMMACULATE ON A FRIDAY: Righty Luis Ortiz fired the third immaculate inning in franchise history on Friday, July 15 in Altoona's 4-2 win over Richmond. Previously, LHP Oddy Nunez (9/4/21 at Akron) and RHP Jeff Bennett (6/7/03 vs Harrisburg) had thrown an immaculate inning for the Curve.

HOT CURVE SUMMER: Altoona has three of the Eastern League's top hitters in the month of July. Matt Fraizer is batting .298/.365/.456 with 2 2B, 2 3B, 7 RBI and 6-6 SB, Jared Triolo is batting .295/.380/.393 with 1 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 8 BB and 5-6 SB, Fabricio Macias is batting .348/.340/.478 with 6 2B, 11 RBI and 2-3 SB and Aaron Shackleford is batting .350/.418/.683 with 8 2B, 4 HR, 8 RBI and 2-2 SB. Shackleford's 10 XBH are 1st in the Eastern League this month, overall this season he ranks 5th in SLG% (.523), and is T-8th in HR (15).

A TREE-IDENTIFICATION WALK: After drawing just 19 walks in 42 games across April and May, INF Jared Triolo drew 20 walks in 25 games in June. Over his last 23 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .400 on-base percentage. In that timeframe, he has the 4th-highest OBP among Eastern League players with 100 PA's.

THE FUTURE: Former Curve RHP Mike Burrows made an appearance in the SiriusXM Futures Game on Saturday night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles. Burrows threw a scoreless 5th inning allowing 1 hit and 1 walk, he also struck out 1.

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 44 of 87 games played this season and hold a 32-11 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 21-2 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 90 home runs on the season, tied for 14th-most by a pitching staff in Double-A and sixth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (123). The Curve have allowed a home run in 54 of 88 games.

THE 6-YEAR REPRESENTATIVES: Managed by Tripp Keister, Harrisburg features several Eastern League veterans including: RHP Ronald Herrera (Trenton), Dakody Clemmer (Akron), Edgar Garcia (Reading), Brian Gonzalez (Bowie and Hartford) and Wilson Garcia (Akron). Additionally, they have former Pirates legend, John Nogowski. Harrisburg is coming off a series at Hartford in which they dropped 4-of-6.

THE FIRST TO FILIBUSTER: Luis Reyes takes the ball on Saturday night for Harrisburg. Reyes has pitched three times against Altoona this season going 0-2 with a 16.20 ERA (15 ER / 8.1 IP). Reyes also made 5 starts for Triple-A Rochester this year where he allowed 23 runs in 13.1 IP to begin the season. Reyes first made his way to Harrisburg in 2018, going 5-6 with a 5.18 ERA in 12 starts. He spent the 2019 season in Potomac going 5-5 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 games, seven starts, in which he struck out 78 batters in 76.2 innings pitched. Reyes signed as an 18-year-old for \$85,000 from the Dominican Republic.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year... His 31 strikeouts in May were tied for 6th-most by an Eastern League Pitcher (Burrows also had 31 K's in May)... Placed on IL on 6/4 (shoulder) and activated on 6/25, was the first time in his life that he's missed a start due to injury... Placed on Temporary Inactive List on 7/1 to be the Best Man in his older brother's wedding, activated on 7/6... **Has allowed 2R or fewer in 11-of-14 outings this season...**

2021: Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Marlins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... Led all Marlins minor leaguers with 136 strikeouts, ranked second in walks with 49, and sixth in the organization with 99.0 innings pitched... Began the season with High-A Beloit and went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in four starts in the month of May, struck out 28 batters in 19.1 innings pitched... Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his fourth professional start on May 28 against Peoria, also allowed five hits and walked two in 4.1 innings... Lasted 3.1 innings or shorter in each of his first three starts in the month of June before picked up his third win of the season on June 19 at Peoria, allowing one run on two hits and one walk in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts... Went a career-high 6.0 innings on July 1 vs Wisconsin and struck out seven, allowed two runs on four hits... Came out of the bullpen on July 13 against Quad Cities following a rehab start by Marlins RHP John Curtiss, picked up nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings... Made his Double-A debut with Pensacola on July 27 and fired 5.0 no-hit innings against Mississippi with eight strikeouts... Turned in a dominant month of August with Pensacola allowing just six runs in 25.2 innings pitched, good for a 2.10 ERA... Turned in three straight scoreless starts totaling 16.2 innings between August 10-24... Went a career-high 6.2 innings on August 24 at Mississippi on just 79 pitches... Traded by the Miami Marlins to the Pittsburgh Pirates on November 29, 2021 along with RHP Zach Thompson and OF Connor Scott in exchange for C Jacob Stallings...

CURVE CUTS: Kyle Todd Nicolas... Attended Jackson High School in Ohio where he led the Polar Bears to a 30-2 record and state Championship as a senior... Was named Prep Baseball Report's Ohio Player of the Year in 2017... First team all-state and Federal League Co-Player of the Year as a senior... Went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 56 innings pitched in 2017. Threw 7.0 innings, struck out seven batters and held Lakota West to one run in the 5-1 state semifinal victory... Also played basketball for three years... Was high school teammates with Tigers prospect Dillon Dangler, they both played baseball and basketball for Jackson High School and won state championships in Baseball and Basketball as seniors... Kyle's father, Todd, coached the basketball team... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years...
