### Today's Game

The Fightin Phils hit the road and continue a series at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the ninth/10th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season and sixth/seventh-of-11 at Delta Dental Park in Portland. Following this week's seven-game series, the Sea Dogs come to Reading from July 18-20 to finish the season series. After winning the 2024 season-series 13-8, Portland holds a 8-0 edge in this year's season-series.

### Game 37 Recap

Despite outhitting Portland 9-3, the Fightin Phils fell 4-3 in the first game of this week's series at the Sea Dogs. With the game knotted at zero in the bottom of the fourth inning, Jean Cabrera got himself into trouble due to walks and Tyler Miller cleared the bases with a three-run triple. Miller scored on an Ahbram Liendo sac fly to make it 4-0, Portland. Reading had opportunities against the Sea Dogs bullpen, but left 11 men on base and were just two-for-12 with runners in scoring position. The Fightin Phils finally broke through in the top of the eighth with two runs thanks to a single from Leandro Pineda. Keaton Anthony doubled home a run in the ninth and Reading had the tying and winning runs aboard, but were unable to score and dropped the first game of the week. Behind Cabrera, the bullpen combined to allow no runs on just one hit, with five strikeouts and one walk to keep Reading in the game.

### It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is currently riding a season-high seven-game hitting streak, and is slashing .391/.462/.609 (1.071 OPS) over that stretch. Miller has now reached base in 26 of his last 29 games played in, dating back to April 12 and has a .352 on-base percentage over that span. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 13 steals rank tied for fifth in the Eastern League.

### Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with a double and two hits on Tuesday. He has doubled in five-straight games, marking the first time a Fightin Phil has doubled in five-straight games since Carlos Rivero did it from May 17-22, 2011. Dating back to the 2005 season, no Fightin Phil has doubled in six-straight contests. Since May 7 (nine games), Anthony is slashing .429/.474/.743 (1.217 OPS), with five runs, eight doubles, one home run and eight RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 3rd AVG (.325), 6th OBP (.383), 5th SLG (.535), 5th OPS (.918), 1st 2B (16), T-1st XBH (19) and 6th RISP AVG (.349).

### Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez stayed hot with two more hits in Tuesday's game at Portland. He now has multiple hits in back-to-back games and in four of the last six games he's played in. Since May 14 (seven games), Mendez is slashing .385/.414/.692 (1.106 OPS), with six runs, two doubles, two home runs and five RBI. Entering play today, Mendez is eighth in the Eastern League in average (.309), seventh in OBP (.380), 10th in hits (38) and T-9th in runs (22).

### Let's Go Leandro

Leandro Pineda stayed red-hot with two more hits on Tuesday night at Portland. He is on a six-game hitting streak, dating back to May 15, and over the streak, he is slashing .476/.522/.667 (1.189 OPS), along with four runs, four doubles and three RBI. After hitting just .104 in April, Pineda has posted a .320 average in May.

### New Crowe in the Nest

After signing with the Phillies on Tuesday, Wil Crowe is slated to make his Reading debut in game two of Wednesday's doubleheader. Crowe is returning to affiliated ball after spending 2024 with the Kia Tigers in the KBO in Korea. Over eight starts, Crowe went 5-1, with a 3.57 ERA. He last pitched in the United States in 2023, appearing in 17 games across three levels in Pittsburgh's system. Crowe has pitched parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the big leagues, most notably making 60 appearances with Pittsburgh in 2022 and starting 25 games for the Pirates in 2021. The 30-year old was a second round pick of the Washington Nationals in 2017 after playing college baseball at South Carolina. Crowe was traded to the Pirates in the 2020 deal that sent Josh Bell to Washington.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**May 21, 2013:** At Reading, Jesse Biddle and Mauricio Robles combine to shutout Altoona, 3-0, on just 4 hits. Biddle picks up his third win of the season by going 7.2 innings, allowing three hits and four walks while fanning nine.

### From Cats to Dogs

Portland enters today with a 21-15 record, sitting in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, Portland took two-of-five games at Somerset, with one game being postponed to June. Following this week, the Sea Dogs hit the road and head to Altoona for a six-game series with the Curve. Portland's roster features seven of Boston's top-30 prospects: Luis Peralas (4), David Sandlin (8), Connelly Early (9), Mikey Romero (11), Allan Castro (22), Yordanny Monegro (23) and Blake Wehunt (27).

### Portland Pitcher

Righty Blake Wehunt starts game one of tonight's doubleheader. Wehunt is 1-3, with a 3.71 ERA over six starts this season for Portland. He allowed two runs in five innings in a win last Thursday at Somerset and he allowed one run over five innings on Apr. 23 vs Reading. The 24-year old was a ninth round draft pick of Boston in the 2023 draft out of Kennesaw State. Righty Jack Anderson gets the ball in game two for the Sea Dogs. Over six appearances and one start, Anderson is 1-2, with a 2.16 ERA. He pitched in relief last Friday at Somerset, allowing two runs over two innings. Against Reading on Apr. 25, he tossed 2.2-shutout innings. The 25-year old was picked by Detroit in the 16th round in 2021 out of Florida State and selected by Boston in the minor league Rule Five last winter.

Mosser turned in arguably his best start of the season last time out, earning his first win of the season. He did not allow a run through the first six innings and his only blemish came in the top of the seventh on a solo home run from Eddinson Paulino. He threw the most innings and pitches of any Reading pitcher this season and was lifted with two outs in his final frame as he hit 100 pitches on the night. Mosser was relieved by Andrew Baker in the top of the seventh inning.

- Struck out season-high seven and pitched season-best 5.0 IP in back-to-back starts (4/13-19)
- Surrendered a season-high two home runs and five-earned runs Apr. 19 vs Binghamton
- Struck out a career-high 10 batters over season-best six innings Apr. 25 at Portland
- Allowed season-high 10 hits May 3 vs Harrisburg, along with seven runs (five-earned) over five innings of work
- Took loss May 10 at Binghamton, allowing six runs on three hits over 4.1 IP; had no-hitter through four innings, but opposing pitcher Jonah Tong combined for perfect game
- Best outing of season May 16 vs New Hampshire: W, 6.2 IP, 3 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO; threw season-high 6.2 IP and 100 pitches, both marks were season-highs by any Reading pitcher. Was first win of season
