TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) continue the first ever six-game series against the Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A Orioles). The Woodpeckers lead the series 1-0 following a 13-7 win on Tuesday night. Today, RHP Deylen Miley will start for Fayetteville and RHP Carter Baumler will get the ball for Delmarva.

THE OPPONENTS: The Shorebirds are in their second season as a member of the Carolina League after being a part of the Class A South Atlantic League from 1996 to 2020, winning titles in 1997 and 2000. After a brief affiliation with the Montreal Expos in 1996, the Shorebirds have been an affiliate of the Orioles since the 1997 season. They play their home games at Arthur W. Perdue Stadium which opened in 1996 and seats 5,200 fans. In 2021, the Shorebirds finished with an overall record of 68-52 and in second place in the Low-A East North Division.

HIGH-A HEROES: Several players that began the 2022 season in Fayetteville have quickly found success since being promoted to High-A Asheville. Outfielder Quincy Hamilton, the only position player to get promoted thus far, is hitting .425 with a home run and six runs batted in over his first ten games with the Tourists. On the pitching side, RHP Ryan Gusto threw three scoreless innings in his High-A debut on May 10 in relief. Additionally, RHP Jacob Coats has become a reliable option out of the bullpen as he has allowed just a pair of runs over 9.2 innings while striking out 14 batters compared to only three walks.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker, Houston's third round pick in 2021, has climbed to #6 in the organizational rankings per MLB.com. RHP Alex Santos is not far behind as he is the eighth-best prospect in the system. Outfielder Logan Cerny also finds himself in the top 30 at #28.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 52 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 55 long-balls, averaging over a home run per game. 24 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 31 on the road, the most road homers of any team in the league. In May, the Woodpeckers hit 27 home runs and are currently on pace to shatter that mark in June with nine round-trippers in six games. Fayetteville has also taken advantage of the long ball with runners on base, hitting 25 two-run home runs compared to 26 solo home runs.

SURGING CERNY: Outfielder Logan Cerny is out to his best stretch at the plate over the last week. In Tuesday's series opener, Cerny hit his eighth HR of the season and finished 3-for-5 with 3 RBI. Across the last eight games played, he is 14-for-31 with 3 HR, 3B, 3 2B, 12 RBI, 5 BB, 4 K. Since May 27th, Cerny has raised his overall batting average from .175 to .224 and overall OPS from .629 to .771.

GOOD WITH THE BAD: The Woodpeckers pitching staff has issued a Carolina League-high 295 walks so far in 2022. However, they have made up for it by missing bats as Fayetteville has struck out the most batters in the league with 580. Additionally, in the month of May, the Woodpeckers allowed the fewest hits (169) in the league and had the fourth-lowest earned run average of the month at 3.60, compared to a 4.99 ERA in April.

KOUBA KAI: RHP Rhett Kouba is the latest Fayetteville pitcher to receive the bump up to High-A, promoted to Asheville on Monday following his Sunday start against the FredNats. Kouba dominated over four games in Fayetteville, pitching to a 1-0 record and 2.40 ERA with 20 K's over 15.0 innings, including an 8 K game vs. Fredericksburg on May 31st.

MOST LEADS ARE SAFE: Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 19-2 when leading after seven innings and 22-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-20 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-5 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a 5-3 road win against the Down East Wood Ducks.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021.

As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers.

Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Greys and the Gary-Southshore Railcats. Kovalik trained at Driveline Baseball during the 2016 and 2017 offseasons.
