game road trip with game four of a six-game series vs. the Norfolk Tides (Baltimore Orioles) at Harbor Park. It is the 16th of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year, and the 10th of 12 games Gwinnett will play in Norfolk. With a win, the Stripers would have back-to-back road victories for the fifth time in 2022 (have not won 3-straight).

AT NORFOLK: The Stripers are 64-68 (.485) in 132 games all-time at Norfolk's Harbor Park, including 4-5 (.444) in nine games this season. Gwinnett is 6-6-0 in 12 season. road series vs. the Tides all-time (2009-current), including 4-2-0 over the last six years (2015-current).

MULLDOZING: Tonight's scheduled starter Kyle Muller is riding a five-game quality start streak since 6/2, going 2-1 with a 1.87 ERA (7 ER in 33.2 IP), 0.77 WHIP, .171 BAA, and 11.49 SO/9.0 IP ratio (43 SO) in that span.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (99) and is among the top five in ERA (2nd, 2.96), WHIP (2nd, 1.08), BAA (2nd, .215), and innings (4th, 76.0).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-8 with a 3.18 ERA (55 ER in 155.2 IP), .219 BAA, and 192 strikeouts (11.10 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 30 starts.

KINGS OF THE "K": Stripers pitchers lead Triple-A in strikeouts with 768 in 75 games (10.24 SO per game). That's seven more than Round Rock of the Pacific Coast League (2nd, 761 SO in 75G). Gwinnett last led Triple-A in strikeouts for a full season in 2011 (team-record 1,223 SO). Kyle Muller (1st, 99), Tucker Davidson (6th, 69), Huascar Ynoa (8th, 67), and Bryce Elder (T-16th, 59) all rank among International League leaders in strikeouts.

CASTEEL IN THE CLUTCH: Ryan Casteel tallied a seasonhigh four RBI yesterday (2-for-4, 2B, HR), his most RBI in a game since 6/24/21, also at Norfolk (1-for-4, grand slam, 4 RBI in 6-2 win). Of his 17 hits, 12 have gone for extra bases (70.6%, 4 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR). For his Gwinnett career, 50.0% of his hits have been for extra bases (26 of 52). including 10 doubles, one triple, and 15 homers.

POSTSEASON HEROES ON REHAB: Two key players from the Atlanta Braves' 2021 World Series championship are currently on injury rehab assignments with Gwinnett: OF Eddie Rosario and LHP Tyler Matzek.

- Rosario: Batting .273 (6-for-22, 2 2B, 2 R, 5 RBI) in five games since joining the Stripers on 6/25. He is on the 10-day IL following a procedure to correct blurred vision and swelling in his right retina. Rosario, the 2021 NLCS Most Valuable Player, is rehabbing with Gwinnett for the second time in his career (13G from 8/11-26, 2011).
- Matzek: Has posted a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 1.0 IP) in one relief appearance since joining the Stripers on 6/29. He is on the 15-day IL with left shoulder inflammation after going 0-1 with a 5.06 ERA and .167 BAA in 13 games with Atlanta this season. It is his second career stint with Gwinnett (0-0, 9.00 ERA in 5G in 2019).

JACKSON ALSO REHABBING: Braves' RHP Jay Jackson made his first rehab appearance with Gwinnett yesterday (hold, 1.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 0 SO). He has been on the 60-day IL since 3/19 (right lat strain) and has not pitched for Atlanta since being acquired via trade with San Francisco on 11/22/21. In 57 career MLB games (SD, MIL, SF), he is 3-1 with a 4.31 ERA, .216 BAA, and seven holds.

TONIGHT: The Stripers continue the second leg of a 12- SHEW-MAKING IT HAPPEN: Braden Shewmake tallied a season-high three RBI on Wednesday, producing his third multi-hit effort in his last five games. He has hit safely in nine of 10 games since 6/7, batting .350 (14-for-40, 2 2B, 1 HR, 4 R, 7 RBI, 2 SB, .847 OPS) in that span. In 53 games overall on his Triple-A debut, he's batting .276 (55-for-199, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 27 R, 15 RBI, 6 SB, .724 OPS).

> CAN'T TOUCH TONKIN: Michael Tonkin enters play riding a 9.0-inning scoreless streak over his last eight outings. In that stretch, he's posting a 0.56 WHIP (4 H, 1 BB), .129 BAA, 16.00 SO/9.0 IP ratio (16 SO), and two saves. It's the second longest scoreless innings streak by a Stripers pitcher this year, trailing only Nolan Kingham's 9.1-inning, five-game stretch from 4/5-4/20. In 23 games overall, Tonkin is 3-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER in 23.0 IP), .186 BAA, 15.26 SO/9.0 IP ratio (39 SO), and five saves (5-for-6).

> **DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING:** Delino DeShields Jr. has reached base safely in 13 of 15 games with at least one plate appearance since the start of June, batting .333 (13for-39, 2 2B, 1 HR, 11 R, 6 RBI, 5 SB, .953 OPS). Overall with the Stripers this season, he has reached base safely in 43 of 51 games (84.3%) with a plate appearance, batting .271 (39-for-144, 6 2B, 1 HR, 24 R, 16 RBI, .759 OPS).

IL Leaderboard: DeShields ranks among the IL top 15 in steals (T-12th, 15) and walks (T-12th, 37).

WATERS WATCH: Over his last 10 games, Atlanta Braves No. 2 prospect Drew Waters is batting .268 (11-for-41, 2 3B, 1 HR, 5 R, 4 RBI, 2 SB, .801 OPS) with three multi-hit efforts. In 40 games overall, he's batting .250 (39-for-156, 6 2B, 3 3B, 4 HR, 21 R, 14 RBI, 3 SB, .708 OPS).

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year (leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. CLT and 5/11 at DUR, leadoff triple on 6/11 at JAX).
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .247 (165-for-667, 33 2B, 4 3B, 17 HR, 108 R, 62 RBI, 34 SB, .709 OPS) in 169 games.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .167 (7for-42, 4 R, 1 RBI, 2 SB) in 11 games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 170 of 200 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .277 (192-for-693, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 15 SB, .914 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.
