YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 9-1. Erie's Trei Cruz homered on the first pitch of the game in the top of the first inning. Diego Rincones extended the lead to 2-0 with an RBI single in the second and the SeaWolves plated five runs in the third to open a 7-0 lead. **Jimmy Glowenke** drove in Richmond's only run with an RBI single in the seventh, his first Double-A hit. Jake Holton opened the SeaWolves' lead to 9-1 with a two-run single in the ninth. **Randy Rodriguez** worked 2.2 scoreless relief innings with three strikeouts.

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 16th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17. In the current series, the Sea-Wolves have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 30-5.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are on their longest losing streak of the season, dropping seven straight since last Thursday. The slide is the longest losing streak since the Flying Squirrels dropped seven straight from July 18-25, 2018. The current losing streak is tied for the fourth-longest in team history, trailing a 15-game streak from April 15-May 3, 2015, a 14-game streak from May 7-20, 2016 and an eight-game streak from July 30-August 7, 2014. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 19-of-their-last-26. Their 7-19 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 161.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 241.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.10 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and the third-lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball, trailing Low-A Columbia (2.93) and Low-A Down East (3.06).

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, two games ahead of Altoona, and have won seven-of-their-last-nine games. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (284), hits (415), total bases (684), RBIs (263) and OBP (.355) and rank second in batting average (.252), triples (12), homers (56), walks (234), SLG (.416) and OPS (.771). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system, Dingler is rated as the best defensive catcher, Perez is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Mason Black makes 10th Double-A start and his third against Erie. Last time out, he allowed a season-high six runs over 3.1 innings in a loss at Binghamton on Saturday and tied a career high with four walks issued. He first faced the SeaWolves on April 21 at The Diamond and allowed four runs (two earned) over 2.1 innings in a loss. On May 10 at UPMC Park, Black threw four scoreless innings, his lone scoreless outing this year, and allowed one hit. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more on Black, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Ty Madden makes his 10th start of the season and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday against the Patriots and struck out six, allowing two runs in four innings in a no-decision. Madden was selected by the Tigers with the 32nd pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas, where he was the Big 12 Pitcher of the Year that season. He made his professional debut in 2022 with High-A West Michigan and went 6-4 with a 3.10 ERA over 19 starts. Madden was promoted to Double-A Erie last August and closed the year going 2-2 with a 2.78 ERA in seven starts. He made his final start of the 2022 season against Richmond on September 16 at UPMC Park and tied a Double-A high with four runs allowed over 4.2 innings. Madden started Game 2 of the Southwest Division Series at The Diamond on September 22 and allowed two runs, back-to-back solo homers by Ricardo Genovés and Carter Aldrete, over two innings of work. He has faced the Flying Squirrels twice this year. On April 21 at The Diamond, he allowed two unearned runs over four innings with five strikeouts. He threw five scoreless innings and struck out six against the Flying Squirrels on May 10 in Erie. Madden is rated as the No. 4 Tigers prospect by Baseball America and No. 5 by MLB.com.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,833) and total attendance (157,150). The Flying Squirrels are ranked seventh of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: Carter Aldrete has driven in 10 runs over his last 14 games since May 17. In his last 22 games since May 6, he is batting .291 (25-for-86) with four homers, six doubles and 12 RBIs. Aldrete had hit safely in nine straight games prior to going 0-for-3 on Tuesday, which was the third-longest active hitting streak in the Eastern League. He has reached base in 16 straight games since May 14, which is the sixth-longest current streak in the league.

VALIN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his eight games with Richmond.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Tuesday and is slated to make his Double-A debut. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night, an RBI single.

ROCKET RANDY: Reliever Randy Rodriguez has gone 1-1 with one save and a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) over his last 10 appearances since April 27, striking out 29 batters and with a .114 BAA. He struck out a season-high five batters over two innings on May 21 against the RubberDucks. On Thursday, he threw 2.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with no walks and three strikeouts. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 25 IP, zero starts), Rodriguez has the highest K/9 (11.97) and strikeout percentage (32.0) and ranks third in ERA (2.45).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked seventh in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). Ismael Munguia is eighth in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Carson Seymour is sixth in ERA (3.11) and ninth in BAA (.219). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for sixth in strikeouts (52).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.324), tied for sixth in homers (9), second in RBIs (39), third in SLG (.559), fourth in OPS (.953), second in hits (58), tied for sixth in doubles (11), tied for third in extra-base hits (22), second in total bases (100) and 10th in runs scored (31). Jake Holton is fifth in OBP (.410) and seventh in walks (33). Trei Cruz is tied for seventh in extra-base hits (18) and fifth in runs scored (32).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
