# **SUNDAY'S RECAP**

Chesapeake enjoyed it's largest victory of the season - a 10-1 triumph over Akron - on Sunday afternoon. The Baysox scored seven runs in the bottom of the sixth inning, which was capped off by an estimated 436-foot three-run home run from Creed Willems - his second homer in as many days. Jeremiah Jackson also had a two-run shot. Right hander Braxton Bragg started for Chesapeake, and contributed five shutout innings with just two hits allowed. The Baysox matched their season-high in runs scored (10) and extra-base hits (6) in a game this season.

### CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in doubles (10) and tied for third in extra base hits (17). The Orioles No. 12 prospect has homered in consecutive games for the Baysox (5/17, 5/18 vs AKR) for the third time in his carrer. Willems has homered in three-consecutive games once (4/9-13 for High-A Aberdeen) in his professional career. Willems' .997 OPS in the month of May ranks fifth in the Eastern League. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

## **WALK THIS WAY**

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (28). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. No player has drawn more walks in the circuit since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

## **ACTION JACKSON**

Over his last seven games, IF Jeremiah Jackson is batting .370 (10-for-27) with two home runs, four doubles, and a 1.120 OPS. The first year Baysox shortstop is third in the league in doubles (12). The next home run for Jackson will be the 100th of his **pro career.** A former Mets farmhand who played 158 games with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Jackson has homered in every Eastern League ballpark aside from FNB Field in Harrisburg.

# **BULLPEN BEASTS**

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.14 ERA, which is third-best in Double-A and fifthbest in MiLB. Baysox relievers lead the Eastern League and are second in Double-A in strikeouts (216).

# **ONE RUN WONDERS**

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (135), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with 11 so far this season. Chesapeake is currently tied with Triple-A Oklahoma City for the most one-run games in all of Minor League Baseball (19).

# **SCOUTING THE SENATORS**

The Harrisburg Senators enter the week with a record of 19-20 on the season, currently fourth-place in the Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, Harrisburg's 88 runs in the month of May are 19 more than any other Eastern League team. They also lead the league in team batting average (.272) and extra-base hits (49) this month. The Senators roster features three active members of the Nationals Top 30 prospect list (per MLB.com) - IF Cayden Wallace (No. 10), IF Yohandy Morales (No. 12), and IF Kevin Made (No. 26). Harrisburg is managed by returning skipper Delino DeShields, who appeared in four games for the Baysox in 1999 during his playing career.

# TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Kyle Luckham is slated to get the ball for Harrisburg on Tuesday night. Luckham matched a season's high with seven hits and four runs allowed in his last start against Altoona this past Wednesday. In his two previous starts, he matched a season's high with seven innings pitched. Luckham has spent time each of the past three seasons with Harrisburg and owns a career 4.58 ERA through three starts in his career against the Baysox. Both Silas Ardoin and Creed Willems have homered off Luckham in their careers. Luckham was a 15th round pick of the Nationals in 2022 out of Arizona State.

# Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. The New Britain, CT native also managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he led them to a league-best 18-10 record and a Fall League Championship Game appearance.

Before the Baysox, Mercado spent two seasons as manager of the Aberdeen IronBirds - the Orioles' High-A affiliate. Mercado received the Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award in 2022 by the Orioles.

Prior to joining the O's, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut and served as Dean of Students for over 18 years.

# **CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS**



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

# **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

# **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
