BIRDS CAN'T OVERCOME EARLY HOLE, FALL IN SERIES OPENER: The

Cardinals fell behind 8-0 after 6 innings and mustered only 4 hits as the Tulsa Drillers took game one of six this week on ONEOK Field 8-1 on Tuesday night in downtown Tulsa. **Jimmy Crooks** homered to lead off the top of the 7th inning for Springfield for the Cardinals' only run. **Leonardo Taveras** fired 2.0 scoreless innings to finish the ballgame for Springfield. Tuesday's setback represents the first back-to-back losses for the Cardinals since a three-game skid from June 27-29, a stretch of 21 games during which the Birds went



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Jerming Rosario** makes his 8th start of the season for Tulsa...Last pitched on Thursday, July 25 at Frisco and took the loss surrendering 7 ER on just 4 H with 5 BB and one strikeout over 3.0 IP...In 4 starts in the month of July is 1-2 with an 8.16 ERA with 18 BB and just 11 K in 14.1 IP...Has not faced the Cardinals this season...Added to the Drillers roster on June 13 from High-A Great Lakes...Opened the season with the Great Lakes Loons and made 10 appearances (6 starts) going 2-0 with a 3.68 ERA with 38 K to 11 BB in 36.2 IP...Split the 2023 season between Great Lakes (19 appearances, 9 starts) and Low-A Rancho Cucamonga (6 starts) and went a combined 8-6 with a 4.21 ERA while adding 114 K in 92.0 IP over 25 appearances (15 starts)...Spent the entire 2022 season and the end of the 2021 campaign with Racho Cucamonga...First season stateside came in 2021 in the ACL after spending 2019 in the DSL...Signed by the Dodgers as an International Free Agent in July 2018 out of the Dominican Republic for \$600,000, the 2nd largest bonus handed out by LA during the 2018 international signing period behind C Diego Cartaya (Venezuela, \$2.5 million)...22 years old

CARDINALS VISIT T-TOWN FOR FINAL TIME IN REGULAR SEASON: The Cardinals head west to pay their final visit of the 2024 regular season to Tulsa, OK for a six-game series against the Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) this week. Springfield won 4 of 5 in Tulsa in a rain-shortened series from April 30-May 5.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

RDAD WARRIDRS: Despite the 8-1 loss in the series opener in Tulsa, The Cardinals has the best road record in the Texas League at 28-17 (.622). Spring-field's road ERA sits at 3.76 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland, and tops in the North Division. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.44, the 2nd-worst home ERA in the circuit.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After a 1-4 start to the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have bounced back and come into play Tuesday as one of the hottest teams in the Texas League. Over their last 23 games since June 30 the Cards are 16-7, tied with the Midland RockHounds for the best record in the Texas League during that time. With 15 wins in the month of July, the Cardinals have matched their season-high for victories in a month (April, 15-7). The Cards, however, have dropped back-to-back games for the first time in over a month, since a three-game skid from June 27-29. Over their consecutive losses, Springfield has been outscored 17-1.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in power numbers this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles during that same stretch. The Cardinals have clubbed 25 homers over their last 23 games, 4th-most in the Texas League, and have homered in 14 of their last 17 games. Springfield has also hit 41 doubles and is 2nd in the league with a .434 SLG and OPS of .792 during that time. During the same stretch the Cards have scored 126 runs (5.5/game), 2nd in the league behind Midland (148).

LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT: Despite seeing their power numbers tick up, the Cardinals have struggled with runners in scoring position of late. Over their last 6 games, the Birds are just 3-for-41 (.073) with runners in scoring position, and are 0-for-15 over their last two games. Since coming out of the All-Star Break, Springfield is batting .189 (14-for-74) with RISP.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 23 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 2nd in the circuit among qualified hitters with a .346 average while adding 6 of his 7 HR this season with 18 RBIs with 4 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .642 and has a 1.040 OPS. Among qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks**' .875 OPS and .401 OBP tops in the circuit. He is also 2nd behind **Tim Tawa** of Amarillo with a .474 SLG.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on July 12 vs Wichita, **Chandler Redmond** etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander **John Stankoweicz**. For good measure, **Redmond** added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. In the month of July, Redmond is batting .370 with 2 HR, 3 2B and 10 RBI and an OPS of .996.

MATTY TWO-BAGS: Cardinals INF/OF Matt Lloyd has been productive all season as the Cardinals' top run-producer. In the month of July he is tied for the Texas League lead with Carson McCusker of Wichita with 8 2B. Lloyd for the month of July is batting .267 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs with a .878 OPS.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 16-for-16 and his 16 saves and 38 appearances lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 13.0 IP (0.69 ERA) and is 6-for-6 in save opportunities.
