LAST OUTING: Hall went 2.0 innings and tied a season-high with five strikeouts before being struck by a line drive on his arm that forced him out of the game in the third inning.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has never faced Norfolk but pitched in 39 games (29 starts) for the Tides in 2022-23 before being acquired by the Brewers in the offseason.
