On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series at the Richmond Flying Squirrels tonight. It is the lone series between the teams this season, as Richmond won't make a trip to Reading. The Flying Squirrels won the 2023 season-series over Reading 8-1, sweeping the R-Phils in Richmond to open the 2023 season last April.

A Very Good Week at Home

Reading defeated Hartford 6-3 on Sunday to complete its strongest week of the season with a 5-1 record. It marked the fifth time since the schedule shifted to six-game series in 2021 that the R-Phils won 5/6 games in a series. The last time they did it was Aug. 1-6, 2023 at Hartford. The last time Reading won 5/6 games at home was May 10-15, 2022 against Bowie. It was also Reading's second-straight series win at home. The last time the Fightin Phils won back-to-back series at home was in August of 2022. Reading also had matched its home-series wins from 2023, as the R-Phils won just two home series last season.

Success at Home

This season, the Fightin Phils are playing their best baseball at home, holding an 11-7 record. Reading finished 2023 with just a 23-44 record at FirstEnergy Stadium, so they are just 12 wins away from matching that mark. Reading is on pace for 42 wins at home this season.

No Free Passes

Sunday marked the first time this season that the Fightin Phils pitching staff did not issue a walk. The last time Reading pitching did not allow a walk in a game was nearly one-year to the date, occurring on May 13, 2023 against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats at home.

Pinpoint Pina

Robinson Pina pitched six innings for the second time this season, and has now earned a winning decision in his last four starts. Pina is tied for the Eastern League lead in wins with four, which also ranks as tied for second in Double-A. Pina has the best strikeout to walk ratio in the Eastern League by a wide margin at 12, with second place sitting at 6.40. That mark also leads all of Double-A and is tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball. Pina's 10.8 strikeout-per-nine ratio also ranks as seventh in the Eastern League. Over his last four starts Pina is: 4-0, with a 2.86 ERA (22 IP, 3 BB, 29 SO).

Relivers Rolling

Reading's bullpen was stellar again on Sunday against Hartford. The group of Carlos Francisco, Matt Russell and Tyler McKay combined to pitch three innings, allowing one hit and no-earned run. They also combined for five strikeouts. Tyler McKay earned his first save since returning to Reading, and Tommy McCollum had his team-leading fourth-save of the season on Saturday night. The R-Phils bullpen posted a 3.52 ERA last week (23 IP, 9 ER).

Lee Sang Heating Up

Marcus Lee Sang turned in a strong week against Hartford. He was 5-17 (.294), with a home run and three RBI, while also scoring three runs. Lee Sang also owns a five-game hitting streak and 12-game on-base streak. This season, Lee Sang is hitting .308 in the nine-hole, and .189 in all other spots of the lineup.

Welcome Back Kendall Simmons

Kendall Simmons had a good week back last week after his activation from the injured list. In three games last week, Simmons was 4-8, while slashing .500/.636/1.000, with a 1.636 OPS. He also had a double, home run, three RBI and four runs scored.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 15, 2004: At Portland, Ryan Howard blasts two home runs and drives in five to lead Reading to a 13-2 thumping of the Sea Dogs. John Castellano chips in with four hits. The Phils break the game open with a 7-run 8th inning.

Richmond Roundup

Richmond enters today with a 12-21 record, which is fifth in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels were swept on the road at Erie last week, and are currently on an eight-game losing streak. After this week, Richmond is back on the road at Bowie. Last season, Richmond finished 74-64 and lost to Erie in the first round of the playoffs.

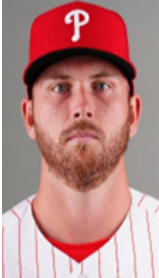
Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Ryan Murphy makes the start tonight for Richmond. This season, he's 1-3, with a 2.57 ERA over seven starts (28 IP, 24 H, 8 BB, 25 SO). Murphy suffered the loss at Erie last Wednesday allowing two runs (one-earned) and three hits over five innings, with eight strikeouts. Murphy spent all of 2023 with Richmond, going 2-9, with a 4.36 ERA. He pitched two-scoreless innings in relief against Reading on Apr. 8, 2023, and threw four-scoreless frames on June 28 at the Fightin Phils. He split 2022 between four levels, pitching mostly with High-A Eugene and Richmond. Murphy split his first pro season in 2021 between Single-A San Jose and Eugene. The Gianys drafted the 24-year old in the fifth round of the 2020 draft out of Le Moyne College in New York.

2024 Notes: Started season on Triple-A Lehigh Valley's Development List. Activated off Development List and transferred to Double-A Reading Apr. 9. Made first start same night against Portland. Roughed up by Sea Dogs, surrendering seven hits and four-earned runs in just 2.1 innings of work. Threw strikes on 60% of pitches in no decision. Early-season struggles continued on Apr. 14 vs Portland, when he lasted just two innings, and allowed three-earned runs on seven hits. Fell victim to defensive miscues as well in loss. Early-season struggles continued when he lasted just 3.1 IP Apr. 20 at BNG. Fell victim of high pitch count, throwing 84 total. Posted season-high four strikeouts in no-decision at Rumble Ponies. Struggled en route to loss Apr. 27 vs SOM. Matched season-high with seven hits allowed and six runs (five-earned) and walked season-most four batters. Threw strikes on just 50% of pitches. Placed on Development List Apr. 30 and activated May 7. Did not pitch from Apr. 27 to May 7. In first start off Development List, gave best outing of season. Went five innings against Hartford, yielding just one-earned run in first win of season.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by the Philadelphia Phillies as an undrafted free agent to a minor league contract on June 16, 2020.

2023: Pitched the entire season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Led the team in wins, strikeouts and innings pitched.

2022: Spent majority of the season with Double-A Reading. Amongst all Phillies minor league pitchers, ranked first in games started (25) and innings pitched (119.2) and was second in strikeouts (133). Was on the injured list with a right ankle contusion from May 12-20. Promoted to Lehigh Valley on September 5.

2021: Began professional career with High-A Jersey Shore. Was on the injured list from June 18 through July 16 with right biceps tendinitis, which included a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Phillies (ROK). Promoted to Reading on July 23 and transferred back to Jersey Shore on September 7. Overall, he struck out 60 over 58 innings pitched. In eight relief appearances, he posted a 3.13 ERA (8 ER, 23.0 IP)

2020: Did not pitch as season was cancelled due to COVID-19 Pandemic. Participated in the Florida Instructional League.

Finished collegiate career in 2020 with a 1-1 record and 1.96 ERA over an impressive four starts in shortened-season. Struck out 20 hitters across 23 innings pitched.
