#### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox routed the Akron RubberDucks last night by a final of 17-1, falling two runs shy of their single game season high for runs scored in a game. Jud Fabian knocked in a game-high five RBI on four hits, including two homers. Austin Hays hit a two-run homer in his first at-bat of his rehab assignment. Anthony Servideo drove in three more RBI, and TT Bowens drove in a pair of RBI. Alex Pham delivered five innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts to earn the first win by a Bowie starting pitcher this season.

#### REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond, Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline. are on the active roster- IF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 29).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Aaron Davenport makes his sixth start of the season for the RubberDucks. Davenport has pitched five innings in four out of his five starts so far this year. The 23-year-old right-hander is off to a solid start in his first season at the Double-A level as he owns a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 innings pitched with 21 strikeouts. The Kirkland, WA native spent the last two years in High-A Lake County where he threw at least 107 innings in each of his last two seasons. The Guardians drafted Davenport in the 6th round of the 2021 Draft out of Hawaii.

#### HAYS IS HERE

Orioles outfielder Austin Hays began his rehab assignment last night and did not disappoint. The 2023 AL All Star hit a two-run homer in the first inning in his first at-bat. He finished the night going 2-for-3 at the plate with a two-run homer, a single and a walk in five innings of action. The 28-year-old has been on the injured list since April 22 after suffering a left calf strain. Hays slashed .275/.325/.444 with 36 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs, 76 runs scored and 67 RBI last season, was named to his first career All Star Game and started in center field. The former Baysox outfielder and No. 1 Orioles prospect played in Bowie from 2017-2019.

#### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF Jud Fabian blasted a pair of home runs last night to record his first multi-homer game as a professional. The Orioles No. 12 prospect crushed his first homer at an estimated distance of 419 feet. Fabian collected four hits on the night, his fourth career four-hit game, and drove in a gamehigh five RBI, his third career five RBI game and his first at Double-A. Fabian has now hit 21 career Double-A homers in 87 total games.

#### **ON-BASE BOWENS**

After going 3-for-4 with a double and two more RBI last night, 1B TT Bowens is currently on a 9-game hit and on-base streak, which is the second-longest active hit streak in the Eastern League along with Eddinson Paulino of Portland. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens leads the Eastern League in batting average (.347), is tied for second in RBI (22), is third in slugging percentage (.600) and third in OPS (1.019).

#### SERVIN' IT UP

Over his last five games, IF Anthony Servideo is batting .500 (8-for-16) with two homers, two doubles and six RBI. The 25-year-old has collected an RBI in his last three consecutive games and last night was his first three RBI game of the year. Last week against Erie was arguably his best series so far at the plate this season. On Saturday, Servideo delivered his first three hit game of the season and homered for a second straight game. He was a triple shy of the cycle. In the series vs the SeaWolves, the 25-year-old went 6-for-12 with two homers, three RBI, and eight runs scored.

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

Last night was Bowie's 11th win at home this season, the most by any team in the Eastern League so far. The Baysox are one of just three teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 11 games at home and have won seven of their last nine here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (107), first in home runs (24), and first in OPS (.858). Bowie clinched its third consecutive home series win after taking three of five against Erie.

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la Diversión  $^{\text{TM}}$ " or "Fun Cup $^{\text{TM}}$ " During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX**

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.
