The Grizzlies won their sixth straight game (seven of their last eight), their longest winning streak in 2024. Fresno beat San Jose for the fifth consecutive contest after sweeping them at Excite Ballpark to open the season. The Grizzlies completed their social straights shutout and third in their lost five games. Fresno starter Bryan Perez (1-0) was sensational over a career-high five and two-thirds scoreless innings of work. Perez allowed three hits (all singles) and four walks while punching out six. Over three starts, Perez has a 132 ERA. Perez left the contests with the bases-loaded in the sixth to reliever Collin Baumgartner. The Knass product struck out Javier Francisco to escape the Jam. Baumgartner retired all seven batters he faced, fanning four of them. He ended his evening with a career-best two and one-third frames and theore to back tro-back triples to start the fun. Perez has hit safely in all 15 games to start the season with eSnider (180) lined back-to-back triples to start the fun. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 Innings. Another staff member fans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 21st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight NLB seasons tring in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2006-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. Mahoney's dominant start in Stockton helped the Grizzlies earn a series victory against the Ports. On Friday, April 19, Mahoney and a trio of relievers combined on a three-hit shutout, the first one thrown by the Grizzlies in 2024. Mahoney relished the victory after six sensational innings of work. He allowed two hits and one walk while fanning five. Mahoney ald not allow a hit until one out into the sixth frame. At one point, Mohoney retired 12 batters in a row (2nd-6th innings). In three starts this season, the South Carolina product is 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA. Over 16.1 innings, Mahoney has permitted three runs (earned) on 11 hits and four walks while punching out 16 (0.92 WHIP, 193 batting average against him). The Rockies #20 overall prospect on MLB.com gives the 2024 Grizzlies their first California League award this season.
