SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

BEST IN THE GALAXY: After OF Carlos Rodriguez tied the franchise record with five hits on Wednesday, he combined for four during Thursday's doubleheader and three during Friday night's game... Rodriguez enters today with a six-game hit streak and has recorded multiple hits in four of the six games.

The Shuckers are the second Southern League team since 2019 to record at least 10 triples in their first 25 games, joining the 2023 Pensacola Blue Wahoos.

IN A BALLPARK NOT SO FAR AWAY: OF Lamar Sparks smashed his first home run of the season on Thursday, a 357' blast to right... Three of Sparks' 10 home runs at the Double-A level have come at Smokies Stadium.

MAY THE FORCE BE WITH YOU: RHP Kaleb Bowman tied his Minor League Baseball career-high with three scoreless innings during the second game of Thursday's doubleheader... It was tied for his longest appearance in professional baseball since he struck out 13 and allowed one run over seven innings on August 18, 2022 with the Guggenberger Legionäre against Untouchables Paderborn in the 1. Bundesliga-Baseball (Germany) Playoffs.

ONE OF FEW, HE IS: INF Ethan Murray has started every game for the Shuckers in 2024, a total of 25 games... Murray is the only Shuckers player to have appeared in every game during the 2024 season... Murray is one of six players at the Double-A level to have played in every game this season... Murray has also started at three different positions on the infield including shortstop (12), third base (7) and second base (6).

TODAY'S STARTER // LHP ADAM SEMINARIS [0-0, 1.84]: Seminaris makes his first start since September 17, 2023 against the Montgomery Biscuits... Today marks his sixth appearance of the year after five appearances out of the bullpen to begin the season...
