PAPILLION, NEB. – A high-scoring affair went the way of Omaha Storm Chasers in 10-9 series-opening victory over the Nashville Sounds on Tuesday at First Horizon Park.

Omaha sent 8 batters to the plate in the opening frame... **Drew Waters** led off the game with a double, then scored on a **Michael Massey** single... **Nate Eaton** singled as well and after **CJ Alexander** drew a walk to load the bases, **Tyler Gentry** walked as well, bringing Massey home and extending Omaha's lead to 2-0... **Brian O'Keefe** doubled in Eaton and Alexander to add on to the early lead and make it 4-0.

Ryan Fitzgerald led off the top of the 2nd inning with a double, then moved to third on a groundout and scored on an Eaton single for a 5-0 Chasers lead... **Nick Pratto** capped the inning with his second homer of the season, a 7-0 Omaha lead.

The Sounds answered in the bottom of 2nd, as **Tyler Black** cranked a three-run homer to left field, then a single and double plated two more runs to bring the score to 7-5 in favor of Omaha and knock starter **Andrew Hoffmann** out of the game... Hoffmann allowed 5 runs (2 earned) on 6 hits over 1.2 innings.

Black drove in another run in the third on a groundout, then a double in the fourth tied the game at 7-7, both runs scoring off reliever **Tyler Duffey**.

The game stayed tied at 7-7 until the 6th inning when O'Keefe, Waters and Massey loaded the bases, then Eaton knocked in his third hit of the night to center field and plate O'Keefe to give the Storm Chasers a 8-7 lead... Pratto then walked with the bases loaded to double the advantage to 9-7.

The Sounds countered in the bottom of the 6th inning to move within one, 9-8, but Omaha stayed ahead by a run into the 8th inning... Massey connected on his first home run of the season in the sixth game of his rehab assignment for a 10-8 lead.

Behind Duffey, **Evan Sisk** struck out 4 and allowed just the 6th inning run over 2.0 innings... **Dan Altavilla** relieved him in the bottom of the 7th inning and threw 1.1 scoreless innings with one strikeout before **Walter Pennington** took the mound and got the final two outs of the 8th inning to strand the tying run on base.

Will Klein came on for the bottom of the 9th inning to lock down his second save of the year, but the Sounds threatened as a pair of walks brought the winning run to the plate... a throwing fielding error by O'Keefe scored a run and put the tying run 90 feet away, but Klein punched out former Storm Chaser **Brewer Hicklen** to end the game.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ON TOP OF THE WORLD

Yesterday's 10-9 win over Nashville vaulted the Storm Chasers into sole possession of first place in the International League.

Today marks the fourth time this season Omaha has entered the day with a share of or in sole possession of first place in the league... it marks the second time Omaha has had sole possession of first place in the league, was also the case after the Chasers' win last Thursday vs. Gwinnett.

Scranton/WB sits just 0.5 game out of first place in the league, with a 10-5 record... Iowa sits 1.0 game back of Omaha, both in the league and division, at 10-6.

Omaha's +33 run differential leads the league and ranks 3rd in MiLB, behind the Tacoma Rainiers (+44) and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (+37).

STRIPPED THE STRIPERS

Last week's series between Omaha and Gwinnett was arguably Omaha's best offensive performance since the 6-game series was implemented in MiLB in 2021.

Omaha scored at least 6 runs and had 9 or more hits in all six games of the series, with at least 10 hits in all five wins during the week and a total of 60 runs scored over the six games... the team hit .326 (70-for-215) with a 1.055 OPS against the Strippers.

Last week against Gwinnett, Omaha set 6-game series records for... Hits (70), Runs (60), Total Bases (136), RBI (56), Average (.326), Slugging % (.633) and OPS (1.055)... when factoring in a handful of 7-game series, last week still holds the records for runs.

MASS EFFECT

Second baseman **Michael Massey** continues his Major League rehab today, after missing the missed Kansas City's final 7 Cactus League games with back tightness, he joined Omaha last week and has appeared in 6 games so far.

Massey has gone 11-for-27 at the plate (.407), with 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 runs batted in and 6 runs scored.

He has a hit in all 6 games he's played, with 2+ hits in 4 of 6 games and an RBI in 5 of 6 games... a pair of walks give him a .448 on-base percentage with a 1.152 OPS.

EATON IT UP

Nate Eaton's 8-game hitting streak entering play today ranks tied 3rd in the International League, creeping closer on his career-best streak.

Over his last 8 games, Eaton is hitting .452 (14-for-31) with a 1.114 OPS... his average is the highest in the league among 6 players with 7+ game streaks.

In his career, Eaton's career-best is a 10-game hitting streak, which he's done 3 times.

PUSHING P(ORTER)

Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** was named the International League's Player of the Week last week, after one of the top offensive performances in Minor League Baseball.

Porter led the league last week with a 1.400 slugging percentage and 2.050 OPS, going 8-for-15 (.533 average) at the plate against the Strippers.
