## REQUIREMENTS:

For consideration as a 2021 scholarship applicant, all essays must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Address the required essay prompt above.
- All essays should be 250 words or less. Essays that are more than 250 words will **NOT** be considered.
- All essays must be submitted double-spaced in 12 pt. Times New Roman font.
