YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were swept by the Senators in a doubleheader. Harrisburg won the first game, 4-2. Kevin Made brought in the first run in the first inning with an RBI infield single. In the second, Paul Witt hit a three-run homer to open a 4-0 lead. Harrisburg starter Andry Lara held the Flying Squirrels scoreless until an RBI single by Carter Howell in the sixth. In the seventh, Alerick Soularie closed the score to 4-2 with an RBI groundout. Carlos Romero entered with two outs and worked a groundout to end the game. In the second game, the Senators shut out the Flying Squirrels, 2-0. C.J. Stubbs brought home the first run of the game with a double in the fourth. In the fifth, Cody Wilson doubled home a run to open a 2-0 lead. The Flying Squirrels loaded the bases with one out in the bottom of the seventh but Jack Sinclair worked out of the jam to end the game for his first save of the year.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, in the finale of a six-game series. The series marks the Senators' only trip to The Diamond this year. The Flying Squirrels played a six-game series in Harrisburg from April 16-21, going 3-3. Richmond returns to Harrisburg for six games from August 13-18.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped both games in Saturday's doubleheader, snapping a four-game win streak. They went 3-3 last week against the Baysox. They dropped four straight games to open the second half the previous week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .227 and averaging 3.77 runs per game (166 runs/44 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). Richmond is 5-13 in its last 18 home games dating back to June 6.

THE SENATORS are 5-12 to open the second half after finishing second in the Southwest Division in the first half, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg had lost seven straight games prior to Saturday's doubleheader sweep and has gone 6-16 over its last 22 games since June 19. On the season, the Senators offense ranks last in the Eastern League in batting average (.219), OBP (.301), SLG (.326) and OPS (.627). Harrisburg's pitching staff ranks third in the league in ERA (3.43). Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Daylen Lile (No. 10), RHP Andy Lara (No. 14), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Bryzky (No. 19) and SS Kevin Made (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospect list includes even Harrisburg players, including Lile (No. 6), Pinckney (No. 16), Bryzky (No. 17), Made (No. 18), C Israel Pineda (No. 21), Lara (No. 27) and RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Will Bednar makes his second Double-A start and his fifth appearance at Double-A. Last time out, he threw two scoreless innings to finish a combined shutout on Wednesday night. Bednar began the season with Low-A San Jose and made five appearances, going 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA. In his six games for High-A Eugene, going 0-2 with a 3.18 ERA. Bednar was selected with the 14th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Mississippi State, where he helped lead the Bulldogs to a national title that year. He was named the College World Series Most Outstanding Pitcher after throwing six hitless innings in Mississippi State's Game 3 clincher that year against Vanderbilt.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Michael Cuevas makes his 17th start of the season and his third this year against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he pitched the series opener on Tuesday and allowed five runs over two innings in a loss. He also pitched against the Flying Squirrels on April 17 at FNB Field and allowed four runs over six innings in a no-decision. In six career starts against the Flying Squirrels, Cuevas is 0-3 with a 10.29 ERA (24 ER/21.0 IP). Cuevas spent all of last season with Harrisburg and went 4-8 with a 5.53 ERA in 23 starts. He made his Double-A debut against the Flying Squirrels on April 12, 2023 and allowed five runs (four earned) over three innings. Cuevas was selected by the Nationals in the 23rd round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Brennan High School in Texas.

BLANK SPACE: On Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels pitched their 10th shutout of the season, beating the Senators, 5-0. The 10 shutouts are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg and trailing only 11 by Akron. Erie has nine. It is also the most shutouts in a season for the Flying Squirrels since they had 12 in 2016.

CARTER'S CRUISING: Dating back to June 13 in 20 games, Carter Howell is batting .307 (27-for-88) with eight doubles, two triples and 17 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times and he has two hits in three-of-his-last-10 games. His four triples are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League this season. He is also tied for third in doubles (19) and 10th in hits (75).

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 29 games dating back to June 6, Victor Bericoto is hitting .346 (41-for-118) with three homers, seven doubles, seven walks and 15 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 39 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .327 (49-for-150) with six homers, eight doubles, 13 walks and 24 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 11-of-21 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .361 (30-for-83) in that stretch. He went hitless in the two games on Saturday's doubleheader, ending his 10-game hitting streak.

TO THE MUNGUA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, Ismael Munguia is batting .317 (19-for-60) and has added four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 14 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. Last Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever Eric Silva has thrown seven consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 9.2 innings. He has 13 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.71. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14. On Thursday night against the Senators, he closed his second save of the year, striking out the side in order in the ninth.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked seventh among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,792), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 18), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.

SHINING STARS: Major League Baseball announced the full 2024 All-Star Game rosters last Sunday night and two former Flying Squirrels, outfielder Heliot Ramos and pitcher Logan Webb, were both selected for the first time in their careers. Webb, who pitched 14 games for Richmond in 2018 and 2019, became the first former Flying Squirrels pitcher to be selected as an MLB All-Star. With Richmond, Webb went 2-6 with a 2.88 ERA in his two seasons and was the team's Opening Day starter in 2019. Ramos, who joined the Flying Squirrels at age 19 in 2019, then the youngest player in franchise history, went on to play 87 games with Richmond across the 2019 and 2021 seasons, batting .239 with 13 homers and 41 RBIs. The pair marked the first former Flying Squirrels to be selected as MLB All-Stars since 2021. They became the fifth and sixth Flying Squirrels alumni to earn MLB All-Star selections, joining Brandon Crawford (2015, 2018, 2021), Joe Panik (2015), Brandon Belt (2016) and Adam Duvall (2016). The 2024 MLB All-Star Game will next Tuesday at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas at 8 p.m.
