YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels dropped their second straight to the Curve, 6-3. Matt Gorksi gave Altoona a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI groundout. Marco Luciano tied the game with a solo homer in the third, his first Double-A hit. Jacob Gonzalez gave the Curve the lead with a two-run homer in the fourth. Later in the inning, Drew Maggi hit an RBI single and later scored on a wild pitch to open a 5-1 lead. Luis Matos singled in two runs in the fifth to close the Flying Squirrels within two, but Gonzalez scored on a wild pitch to extend Altoona's lead back to three runs. In the ninth, the Flying Squirrels stranded two on base. Richmond reliever Juan Sanchez worked two scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Today marks the fourth of 18 games between the Flying Squirrels and Curve this season. Altoona will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from June 6-11. The Flying Squirrels will head to Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona for a six-game series from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are 11-9 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels are 5-3 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won nine-of-the-last-14 games and are in first place in the division, 1.5 games ahead of Altoona. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history. The Flying Squirrels offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (125) and RBIs (111) and ranks second in batting average (.243) and OBP (.344). The Richmond pitching staff ranks first in strikeouts (235) and second in ERA (3.23).

THE CURVE are in second place in the division, 1.5 games behind the Flying Squirrels. Altoona has won nine-of-its-last-13 games and four-of-its-last-six. The Curve roster includes five of Baseball America's Top-30 Pirates Prospects: C Henry Davis (No. 3), INF Liover Peguera (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 + best power hitter + best outfield arm) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nick Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Lolo Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. The Altoona roster also includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates Prospects, including Davis (No. 3), Peguero (No. 6), Gorski (No. 17), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 20) and Frazier (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Kai-Wei Teng makes his fifth start of the season and the fifth of his career against the Curve. He last pitched last Saturday at Bowie and allowed one run over 3.2 innings with five strikeouts. He is currently tied for third in the Eastern League with 30 strikeouts this season. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. Over the last 2021 and 2022 seasons, Teng combined for 311 strikeouts, which was the fourth-most in the minor leagues during that span. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. For more on Teng, see page two.

FOR ALTOUNA: Right-hander Aaron Shortridge makes his fifth start and sixth appearance of the year. Last time out, he worked five innings and allowed two runs in a win at Reading on Saturday. He spent most of the 2022 season with the Curve, going 3-4 with a 4.88 ERA in 14 starts. He made one start against Richmond last year, working four innings and allowing two runs at PNG Field on July 14 in a no-decision. Shortridge was selected by the Pirates in the fourth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Vintage High School in Napa, Calif. For his career, he has pitched 19 games for the Curve, going 5-5 with a 4.90 ERA.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond's relievers have combined for a 2.34 ERA (30 ER/115.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels bullpen also leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (136) and is second in innings pitched (115.1). Richmond relievers are 8-for-10 in save opportunities (80%), the highest save conversion rate in the league. Raymond Burgos has pitched seven games without allowing an earned run, the second-longest streak in the league. His 10.1 innings pitched without allowing an earned run in the second-highest in the league. Four Richmond relievers rank in the top-13 pitchers in the league in ERA (no starts, at least 8.0 IP), including Burgos (T-1st, 0.00), Blake Rivera (T-1st, 0.00), Nick Swiney (8th, 0.73) and Erik Miller (13th, 0.87).

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .296 (64-for-216) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .296 (29-for-98). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .298 average (104-for-349). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year. In this week's series, Richmond has been held to 5-for-28 (.179) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-10 in Thursday's loss.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday and made his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit.

MAHAN MAYHEM: Riley Mahan blasted his fourth homer of the season on Tuesday night at The Diamond, a 419-foot, go-ahead shot to right. He has now homered three times in his last three home starts, including two homers on April 23 against the Sea-Wolves. In his last 13 games since April 15, Mahan is batting .280 (14-for-50) with four homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .417 (10-for-24) with a homer, three doubles and five RBIs over his last five games. He led off last Thursday's game in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs, picking up a pair of RBI singles and a sac fly. Munguia is tied for fourth in the league in hits (25) and second in runs scored (18).

MATIS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season, until going 0-for-3 in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. He has reached base in each of his four games since then and in 21-of-22 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just nine times in 93 plate appearances (9.7 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

TAKE A WALK: Andy Thomas is tied for sixth in Eastern League with 18 walks. He is sixth in the Eastern League with a 22.2-percent walk rate. Last season, Thomas led the Northwest League in on-base percentage (.373) and ranked third in walks (58). He has worked at least one walk in 12-of-his-19 games played so far this season. In last week's series at Bowie, he hit .375 (6-for-16) with a homer, a double, five walks and four RBIs, but he is 1-for-11 with one walk in this week's series against Altoona.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is ranked fifth in batting average (.324), tied for sixth in OBP (.410), fifth in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for fifth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), tied for third in extra-base hits (11), tied for seventh in total bases (40) and tied for fifth in runs scored (15). Ismael Munguia tied for fourth in hits (25) and second in runs scored (18). Riley Mahan is tied for fifth in homers (4) and tied for ninth in SLG (.508). Andy Thomas is tied for sixth in walks (18). Juan Sanchez is tied for second in wins (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for third in strikeouts (30). Evan Gates is tied for sixth in saves (3).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Domingo Leyba is tied for third in batting average (.333), tied for sixth in OBP (.410) and tied for eighth in hits (23). Henry Davis is 10th in batting average (.284), third in homers (6), tied for fourth in RBIs (15), fourth in OBP (.448), fourth in SLG (.597), third in OPS (1.045) and tied for seventh in total bases (40). Mason Martin is second in OBP (.455), seventh in OPS (.955) and tied for sixth in walks (18). Liover Peguero is tied for fifth in runs scored (15) and tied for fourth in stolen bases (9).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
