### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT (FRIDAY'S VERSION):** A pair of two-strike, two-out hits by Jake Lamb and Malcom Nuñez led Indianapolis to a 9-8, walk-off win in 11 innings over Louisville in the completion of Friday night's suspended game on Saturday night at Victory Field. With Friday night's game knotted at 5-5 after regulation, the two teams traded runs in the 10th inning before a high-scoring 11th. Down by two runs after an Ivan Johnson double in the top half of the final inning, the Indians rallied for three runs – two coming with two outs – for their sixth walk-off victory of the season. After a Nick Yorke run-scoring groundout and stolen base, Lamb traded places with the Indians August Player of the Month to tie the game. Jack Suwinski was intentionally walked in favor of Nuñez, who worked an eight-pitch at-bat that resulted in the walk-off bloop single into right field.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT (REGULARLY SCHEDULED VERSION):** Following the walk-off victory, the Indians were shut out by the Bats in the regularly-scheduled contest, 6-0. The Bats silenced the Indians behind 5.0 shutout innings from spot-starter Sam Benschoter and 4.0 innings from Grant Gavin. The game featured a 1-0 pitchers' duel between Benschoter and Luis Cessa, who fanned a season-high eight across 5.0 frames, before the Indians bullpen took over. Louisville then plated four runs, all with two outs, in the top of the seventh. Johnson singled home a run before Levi Jordan – who struck out three times against Cessa and Michael Plassmeyer – launched a three-run homer against the latter. The Bats tacked on another run in the top of the ninth.

**VICTORY FIELD:** The Indians extended their record-breaking winning streak at Victory Field to 11 games with a walk-off victory yesterday before it was snapped on the shutout. The streak, dating back to Aug. 13, is the longest win streak at the ballpark since it opened in 1996. The previous two record-holding streaks of nine games came from April 25-May 12, 2013, and June 9-20, 1997.

**RIDING THE LINE:** Following last night's walk-off victory, the Indians (.64-.63) were above .500 for the first time since May 9 (17-16). They then dropped back to .500 with the shutout loss. Before this series, the last time they were at least .500 was on May 10 (17-17) during a six-game series at Louisville Slugger Field. The Indians have not finished with a full-season record above .500 since going 73-67 in 2018.

**NUÑEZ KNOCKS:** Malcom Nuñez has now hit safely in each of his last three games after hitting a walk-off single in the bottom of the 11th inning in the resumption of Friday night's suspended game and doubling in the nightcap last night. The walk-off hit, coming with two outs and a 2-2 count during an eight-pitch at-bat, was his first with the Indians since making his Triple-A debut during the 2022 season.

**PLAYER OF THE MONTH:** Nick Yorke yesterday was named Indianapolis' August Player of the Month after he ranked among International League leaders in hits (T-1st, 34), doubles (1st, 12) and batting average (7th, .340) in 27 games with the Indians. His hot month continued when he went 1-for-5 with three runs, a double, walk and three RBI in the resumption of Friday night's game, and he has now hit safely in seven of his last nine and 25 of his last 31. Since beginning a 15-game hitting streak on July 25, he is hitting .333 (39-for-117) with 14 runs, 14 doubles and 20 RBI. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to the Pirates from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester.

**TRIP TRIP TRIPLES:** Ji Hwan Bae roped a triple during last night's game, threatening to break up the shutout bid thrown by Louisville. His three-bagger was the Indians third of the series, following Jack Suwinski and Andrés Alvarez on Wednesday. The trio of triples were Indy's first since Aug. 13, and they hit just four during the month of August. The Indians have roped just 24 triples in 128 games this season, tied for the seventh-most in the International League, after leading the league with 42 in 2023 and 44 in 2022.

**TODAY:** The Indianapolis Indians and Louisville Bats, Triple-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds, close out their seven-game series today at 1:35 PM at Victory Field. This week's seven-game series is the final meeting between the two teams this season and second at Victory Field after the Indians took two of three games from the Bats from July 4-6. The Indians will look to take six of seven this week with a win today after losing their first game of the series last night. Taking the mound to close out the series today is RHP Beau Sulser (3-7, 5.29), who faced Louisville in Game 2 of Wednesday's doubleheader (more below). He has faced the Bats five total times in his career (four starts) with a 4.83 ERA (12er/22.1ip) and 16 strikeouts. Countering for Louisville is RHP Casey Kelly (0-0, 4.50), making his third start with Louisville and first since Aug. 17. Kelly faced Indianapolis once in his career, on June 20, 2016, with Gwinnett, and took the loss with 4.0 three-run innings (two earned), four walks and one strikeout.

**BOOMERANG:** Longtime Indianapolis Indian RHP Beau Sulser takes the mound for his second appearance (first start) with the Indians since signing with the Pirates as a minor league free agent on Aug. 15. He took the mound on Wednesday following opener Colin Holderman and tossed 4.0 one-run innings with just three hits, no walks and five strikeouts as the Indians went on to win in later innings. As the Pirates 10th round draft pick in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft, Sulser has made his way back to the organization a number of times since being designated for assignment following his MLB debut in 2022. This is his third separate time rejoining with the Pirates, and today will be his 40th appearance with the Indians (31st start) since making his Triple-A debut in 2021.

**THIS DATE IN 2001:** Designated hitter Micah Franklin hit for the first three-homer game in the Victory Field era in a 5-3 win against Toledo. It was the first three-homer performance for an Indianapolis player since Willie Greene on Aug. 22, 1995 at Omaha. Franklin converted all of his at-bats on the day into long balls and drove in four runs in the process. The home runs were his 19th, 20th and 21st of a team-leading 23 for the 2001 campaign.
