ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Great Lakes Loons 8-7 in ten innings at Dow Diamond.](#)

Wisconsin rallied from a 5-0 deficit to take a 7-6 lead in the top of the ninth only to see the Loons tie the game in the bottom of the ninth. Joe Gray Jr drove in the go-ahead run in the top of the tenth and Wisconsin held on for the win to even the series 2-2.

A FIRST: Wisconsin won when trailing after eight innings for the first time with their comeback last night. The Rattlers are now 1-32 when trailing after eight.

WE KNOW DRAMA: The Rattlers were down 5-1 in the top of the seventh and rallied to tie the game with four runs on five hits, including two-out RBI singles from Ben Metzinger and Eduardo Garcia. Great Lakes went back in front in the bottom of the seventh on a two-out RBI single by Yeiner Fernandez.

NO...REALLY...WE KNOW DRAMA: There were two outs and none on in the top of the ninth when Garcia singled. Alex Hall followed with a two-run home run to give the Rattlers a 7-6 lead. In the bottom of the ninth, Brannon Jordan retired the first two batters he faced before Chris Newell tied the game with a homer.

GRAY HAVENS: Gray's two-out, RBI single in the tenth was his fourth hit of the game. Gray has three four-hit games as a Timber Rattler.

GOING THE EXTRA MILE: Gray is 2-for-3 with five RBI in extra innings this season. He has knocked in five of Wisconsin's seven extra-inning runs in 2023.

MOLTO BENE: Wisconsin reliever Michele Vassalotti entered the game in the fourth inning and pitched three perfect innings with six strikeouts.

AND HE WALKED ON DOWN THE HALL: Hall's homer was his sixth of the season and his first since April 21. He reached base in all five plate appearances last night. Hall went 3-for-3 with two singles, the homer, a walk, and a hit batsman last night.

END OF THE LINE: Matt Wood was 0-for-6 last night and his eleven-game hitting streak came to an end.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season.

The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019 and again in 2022. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo Garcia (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Dalton Rushing (#7), Yeiner Fernandez (#14), Maddux Bruns (#15), Ronan Kopp (#19), Damon Keith (#24), Alex Freeland (#25), and Justin Wroblewski (#29).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner had a no decision at West Michigan on [June 10](#). He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and eight strikeouts over 6-1/3 innings. Woessner matched his single-game high as a pro for strikeouts and set a new pro single-game high for innings pitched in the game.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Woessner has never faced the Loons prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KENDALL WILLIAMS: Acquired by the Los Angeles Dodgers in a trade with the Toronto Blue Jays on September 1, 2020. The Blue Jays received Ross Stripling in exchange for Ryan Noda and Williams.

ORIGIN STORY: Toronto selected Williams in the second round of the 2019 draft out of the IMG Academy. The Blue Jays used the 52nd overall pick in that draft to take Williams.

FEEL THE EARTH MOVE: Williams was 3-3 with a save and a 4.53 ERA in 23 games – nineteen starts – for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in 2021. He had 87 strikeouts and 22 walks in 93-1/3 innings pitched.

BACK AT IT: Williams started last season back with Rancho Cucamonga and was 0-1 in four starts before joining the Loons on April 27, 2022. He went 3-5 with a 4.15 ERA in 23 games – 20 starts – for the Loons during the regular season. Williams also lost a playoff start against Lake County in the 2022 postseason. He didn't appear in a game this season until making a relief outing for the ACL Dodgers. Williams was assigned to the Loons on June 16, 2023.

LAST START: Williams lost Game Three of the Eastern Finals against Lake County on [September 16, 2022](#). He allowed five runs on five hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST APPEARANCE: Williams lost to the Mariners in an ACL game on [June 6](#). He allowed four runs on five hits with three hit batsmen and a walk in three innings as a reliever. Williams did not record a strikeout.

VS. WISCONSIN: Williams had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at home on [June 18, 2022](#). He allowed four runs on six hits and two walks with a strikeout over 3-2/3 innings.
