### SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

JUST TOP PROSPECT THINGS: OF Jackson Chourio tallied two extra-base hits on Thursday, helping the Shuckers score eight unanswered runs in a 10-4 win... It was Chourio's third game in 2023 with multiple extra-base hits, and his first since he tallied three on June 13 against Montgomery... Chourio has also tallied a hit in nine of his last 11 games.

A NEW CAREER-HIGH: INF Freddy Zamora extended his hit streak to 11 games, a new career-high, with a two-RBI double in the eighth inning on Thursday... His previous career-high was set between September 2-14, 2021 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in High-A... Over his current streak, the longest active in the Southern League, Zamora is hitting .400 [16-40] with five doubles and a home run.

**LEFTY DEMOLITION**: Entering today, **C/INF Wes Clarke** has a .947 OPS against left-handed pitchers, the fourth-best mark in the Southern League... Clarke has tallied 14 hits against left-handed pitchers, tallying two doubles and six home runs.

<u>HE GETS ON BASE</u>: C Jeferson Quero extended his career-best on-base streak to 17 games with a sixth-inning walk on Thursday night, tied for the second-longest by a Shuckers' player in 2023... INF Tyler Black set a new franchise with a 35-game on-base streak earlier in the season... Over Quero's streak, he has a .356 average (21-59) with a .487 on-base percentage and a .995 OPS.

ON THE RUN: INF Tyler Black became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday, June 25... Black enters today 13 away from breaking OF Johnny Davis' record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... Black enters today as the stolen-base leader in the Southern League and Double-A.

AWARD-WINNING PERFORMANCES: C/INF Wes Clarke was named the Brewers' Minor League Co-Player of the Month for June... Clarke became the third Shuckers player in 2023 to be honored by the Brewers' organization... In June, Clarke had a .404 on-base percentage, a .453 slugging percentage and drew 21 walks in 21 games... He also led the Brewers' organization in June in RBI (19), was tied for the lead in walks (21) and was second in home runs (5).

OFF TO SEATTLE: On Monday, June 26, C Jeferson Quero and INF Jackson Chourio were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS [4-6, 6.31]: RHP Christian Mejais is set to make his 16th appearance of the year, and his 14th start... Over two starts against Pensacola, Mejias has allowed three runs in 10.1 innings with 14 strikeouts... Mejias enters today 7.1 innings away from tying his career-high for the most innings thrown in a season [74.1 IP], set last year between High-A Asheville and Single-A Fayetteville in the Astros organization.
