FRES-NOTES

JULY 4TH TRIUMPH: The Fresno Grizzlies (4-9, 42-36) exhausted the Modesto Nuts (7-6, 48-29) 7-5 Thursday night from Chukchansi Park. Fresno stopped their six-game skid, which was their longest on the season and tied for the worst losing streak since the Grizzlies, Rockies affiliation. A crowd of 9,939 saw the Grizzlies come back from a three-run deficit and improve to 10-9 since 2005 on the Fourth of July. The Nuts and Grizzlies traded runs in the first with a pair of RBI singles. Modesto's Tai Peete dribbled a single to center, adding Carlos Jimenez. Fresno's Andy Perez swatted a single up the middle, notching Braylen Wimmer. In the top of the second, the Nuts scored three runs after four straight hits started the inning. Curtis Washington Jr. lined a single to right, plating Carson Jones. A bases-loaded hit-by-pitch and double play yielded the other two Modesto runs. The Grizzlies got a run back in the bottom of the second when Jason Hinchman launched a single off the left field wall, inching home Nick Gile. The Nuts extended their advantage to 5-2 in the top of the fourth after an Aidan Smith RBI single. This would be the last hit of the contest, as neither team achieved a knock for their last five innings at the plate (10 half-innings). Despite the deficit, the Grizzlies managed to claw ahead in the bottom of the fourth with the weirdest and wildest inning of the season. Fresno brought 10 batters to the dish, tallying four runs without supplying a hit. The Grizzlies drew five walks, were beamed by two pitches and took advantage of a Nuts miscue. Hinchman penciled in a bases-loaded walk before a pair of wild pitches tied the game at five. Finally, a throwing error pushed Fresno ahead by one. In the bottom of the eighth, the Grizzlies mustered an insurance run on a Perez sacrifice fly. Hinchman was the recipient of the late run. Fresno southpaw Isiah Coupet was roughed up in his first couple of frames, but settled in nicely to finish with six innings of work. Coupet (5-2, win) allowed five runs (earned), on eight hits and one walk while fanning seven. Code Denton and Bruson Hammer were electric out of the Grizzlies bullpen, combining for three masterful frames. Denton relished a 1-2-3 seventh with a pair of punchouts. Hammer wrapped up the win with four strikeouts over two innings. The lefty showed his emotion after the final out was made.

MODESTO MINI FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Modesto Nuts (Seattle Mariners Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game home-and-home series tonight at Chukchansi Park. The first three games of the series were played in Modesto and now shifts to Fresno for the final three contests. This is the fourth of five regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the second meeting in Fresno. The Nuts have already clinched a playoff berth by virtue of winning the first half in the California League North Division. In four years, the Grizzlies are 48-47 against the Nuts over their 95 games played (Modesto leads 9-7 in the 2024 season series) since the squads became a part of the same league for the first time since 1988. At that time, Modesto was affiliated with the Athletics and were named the A's, while the Grizzlies were known as the Fresno Suns, playing independently. Now, the Nuts are associated with the Seattle Mariners organization (affiliated with the Colorado Rockies prior to Mariners), while the Grizzlies are partnered with the Rockies. The two cities are 96 miles away from one another if you drive by car, following the CA 99 route. Fresno and Modesto are one hour and 32 minutes apart, if you drive non-stop. The halfway point between both cities is Planada, California.

GRIZZLIES STARS EARNED THEIR CLAWS: Two Fresno Grizzlies were selected by Minor League Baseball for their outstanding performances during the month of June. RHP Jack Mahoney was named California League Pitcher of the Month, while INF Braylen Wimmer received California League Player of the Month. Both Mahoney and Wimmer played together at the University of South Carolina. This is the second time the Grizzlies have swept monthly awards since becoming a Rockies affiliate, as C/1B Hunter Goodman and RHP McCade Brown won in June of 2022. It is also the third straight year that the Grizzlies have won Player of the Month for June, with Goodman in 2022 and INF Ryan Ritter in 2023. Mahoney was as good as advertised in the month of June. The Rockies #19 prospect went 1-0 with a 1.05 ERA over four starts. On June 21 vs. Stockton, Mahoney went the distance with catcher Ben McCabe, firing a nine-inning complete game shutout, the first in Minor League Baseball this season. In 25.2 June innings, Mahoney allowed three runs (earned), on 15 hits and five walks while striking out 23. The South Carolina product has not permitted a run in his last 211 innings, spanning four starts (tallied his last two outs in the fifth on June 7 at Modesto). Wimmer had an extraordinary month of June. Over 24 games, Wimmer went 36-for-93 (.387 AVG/.452 OBP/.677 SLG/1129 OPS) with six homers, nine doubles, 17 RBI, 20 runs, nine walks, two hit-by-pitches and five stolen bases. The South Carolina product tallied 10 multi-hit games, five multi-run contests and four multi-RBI games in June as well. Wimmer ended the month on a 13-game hit streak (June 15-30, lasted 14 games, July 1), where he went 23-for-54 (.426/.483/.741/1.224) with four bombs, five doubles, 11 RBI, 12 runs, five walks, one hit-by-pitch and three stolen bases. Thanks to the duo from South Carolina, the Grizzlies have won six weekly and monthly honors in 2024 (Welinton Herrera, Isiah Coupet, Wimmer and Mahoney, three times). Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record.

WELCOME BACK MICHAEL PROSECKY: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to a familiar face in LHP Michael Prosecky. The Louisville product was chosen as one of four California League Starters of the Year after an outstanding 2023 season with the Grizzlies. Last year, Prosecky made 21 starts, going 11-7 with a Single-A-best 2.72 ERA and California League-leading 125 strikeouts. Prosecky enjoyed the California League-lowest batting average against him (.217) and ranked among the Top 10 in five other league pitching categories. He ended his year tied for 10th in Grizzlies' Top 10 franchise single-season with 11 wins, tied for fifth in WHIP (.117) and third in ERA (2.72). Over Prosecky's final nine starts, he went 6-2 with a 1.12 ERA (48.1 IP, 32 H, 9 R, 6 ER, 14 BB, 57 K).

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpaner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker, Nate Schierholtz, Jason Ellison and Calvin Murray each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 56 times in 157 plate appearances (29 games; 41% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In nine of those 29 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 30 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 7-for-21 (.333) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch. Six of his seven hits have been singles with two of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swipped 11 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (26/29 in stolen bases on the season).
