### NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs, 9-1, on Sunday in the series finale at Mirabito Stadium. Portland took three out of five games in the series. **Junior Santos**, **Bryce Montes de Oca**, and **Nolan Clenney** combined to throw 3.2 hitless and scoreless frames in relief. **Matt Rudick** had a multi-hit game, **JT Schwartz** extended his on-base streak to 16 games, and **Drake Osborn** extended his hit streak to five.

**CLIFFORD CRUSH:** Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** hit his ninth home run at the Double-A level in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, which is tied for the team lead. Clifford hit just two home runs in his first 46 games of the season across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton, and in the 23 games since then he has hit eight home runs. The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 25 of his last 27 games and in 30 of his last 33 games. In 23 games in the month of June, Clifford had a .400 on-base percentage and 1.009 OPS with eight home runs, four doubles, 18 runs batted in, 23 walks, and 19 runs. Clifford currently leads all of Minor League Baseball with 62 walks.

**SCHWARTZ THE FORCE:** First baseman **JT Schwartz** has been on a tear. After going 1-for-3 with a walk on Sunday, Schwartz has now reached base in 16-straight games. Over his 16-game on-base streak, the 24-year-old is hitting .365 with a .484 OBP, .965 OPS, 12 walks and just four strikeouts. He has 19 hits, three doubles, one home run, four runs batted in and six runs scored in that span too. Schwartz went 6-for-12 in four games against Portland last week. Here's how Schwartz currently ranks among Eastern League hitters: 2nd in OBP (.412), 3rd in BB (38), and T-8th in AVG (.286).

**DRAKE RAKES:** Catcher **Drake Osborn** is currently riding a five-game hit streak, hitting .444 (8-for-18) with a .500 OBP, 1.056 OPS, four runs batted in, two doubles, and three runs scored over that span. In 17 games in the month of June, Osborn hit .321 with 17 hits, one homer, two doubles, 10 runs batted in, and six runs scored. In 43 games across High-A Brooklyn (16) and Double-A Binghamton (27), Osborn is slashing .299/.458/.410/.948.

**PARADA PARTY:** Mets top catching prospect **Kevin Parada** is hitting .300 with an .877 OPS over his 10 nine games, since the beginning of the series at Akron on June 18. Parada has one home run, four doubles, three runs batted in, and four runs scored over his last 10 games and he has recorded three multi-hit games over that span.

**JACKSON #5:** Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** hit .276 with two home runs, 10 runs batted in, six doubles, and six runs scored across 21 games in the month of June. It marked his most productive month of the season, after he hit just .179 in April and .148 in May.

**GUTS, GLORY, RAM:** Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramirez** hit .242 with one home run, 11 runs batted in, 12 runs, five doubles, and six stolen bases in 24 games in the month of June. Ramirez hit .324 in 19 games in April and .172 in 22 games in the month of May, before having a solid month of June. The 21-year-old leads the Eastern League with 25 stolen bases.

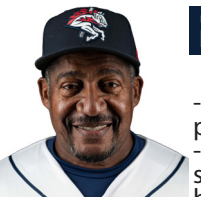

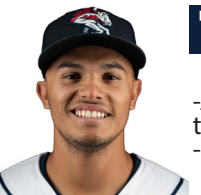
