Today's Game: Nashville takes on Memphis in five of the six-game series at Memphis. The series is tied at two games apiece. The Sounds will send left-hander Aaron Ashby to the mound and will be opposed by right-hander Sem Robberse.

Aaron Ashby: The 25-year-old lefty is making his third start of the season and second with the Sounds. Ashby's last appearance came for Milwaukee where he went 3.2 innings, six hits, eight runs (four earned), two strikeouts and was charged with the loss. His lone start with Nashville was versus St. Paul on April 2...5.0 IP, 4 H, 3 ER, 2 BB, 5K. He has 41 career appearances (24 starts) in the big leagues and 24 appearances (15 starts) with the Sounds. He is 5-5 with a 5.01 ERA (70.0 IP/39 ER) with 106 strikeouts lifetime with Nashville.

Sem Robberse: The 22-year-old is making his third start of the season for the Redbirds. He is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (10.0 IP/2 ER) with nine strikeouts. Robbers was acquired from the Blue Jays in deadline trade that included yesterday's starter Adam Kloffenstein in return for Jordan Hicks on July 30, 2023. After the trade, the Netherlands native pitched eight games (seven starts) for the Redbirds with a 4.84 ERA (35.1 IP/19 ER) and 44 strikeouts. He is ranked as the #12 prospect for the Cardinals according to MLB.com.

Hot and Cold: The Sounds were shutout for the second time this season (4/6 vs. St. Paul) in the first game of the doubleheader yesterday. They mustered just three hits which was also a season low. At the conclusion of game one, Nashville had gone the last 18 innings with one run scored (Eric Haase home run, 9th inning on 4/11). In game two, the story flipped with the Sounds pitching their second shutout of the season (3/31 at Toledo). Tobias Myers was the starter in both of those games. Myers averages 7.0 runs scored per start which is second on the team (Junk, 10.0). 36 of Nashville's 68 runs have been scored in three games.

Francisco! Francisco Mejía went 3-for-6 with a triple and three RBI in the doubleheader. He has reached base in all five games he has played this season with two multi-hit games. His triple in game two was his first since September 20, 2023 at Gwinnett while playing for Durham and 23rd professionally. He is 6-for-16 to open the season with a 1.037 OPS.

Scorching Hot: Owen Miller extended his hitting-streak to seven games which matches Brewer Hicklen (3/31-4/11) for the longest by a Sounds player this season. Additionally, Miller is riding a team-leading 11-game on-base streak. He has three-straight two-hit performances which he hasn't accomplished since he had four straight from 4/10/22-4/13 while playing for Cleveland. He ranks second on the team in batting average (.310) third in total bases (16) and tied for third in doubles (3).

Brewmaster: Brewer Hicklen scored three times in game two of the doubleheader. He accomplished this feat just one time last season (June 30 vs. Iowa). He leads the Sounds in runs scored (10), stolen bases (6) and OPS (1.016). He has reached base safely in 10 of the 12 games he has played this season and is tied with Owen Miller for the most multi-hit games (4). Only five players in Triple-A have stolen more bases without being caught than Hicklen (6-for-6). He has nine straight steals without being caught dating back to July 4, 2023.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen continued to be the best at the Triple-A level with another 2.2 scoreless innings in the doubleheader. Nashville relievers have four wins on the season and boast the best ERA (1.12), WHIP (0.87) and opponent batting average (.135) at the Triple-A level. Kevin Herget (5.1 IP), Enoli Paredes (5.0 IP), Harold Chirino (3.2 IP), Rob Zastryzny (4.2 IP), Nick Bennett (4.0 IP) and Darrell Thompson (2.0 IP) have yet to allow an earned run in multiple appearances this season. The next best ERA among Triple-A bullpens is Columbus at 2.79 (51.2/16 ER) and the next closest opponent batting average is Syracuse/Worcester at .200.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 688-588 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,281-2,109 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Ashby pitched 3.2 innings in a start for Milwaukee. He was charged with the loss by allowing six hits, eight runs (four earned), two walks and had two strikeouts.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Ashby's third career start against Memphis. Both took place in 2021 (5/12 and 8/18). He has allowed one earned run and struckout five in 3.2 innings. He acted as the opener in his most recent appearance on August 18, 2021 where he pitched a scoreless first inning with two strikeouts.
