**AGAINST OPPONENT:** This is Clarke's second career outing against Memphis. His lone appearance came on June 8, 2018 in Memphis while pitching for Reno. He went 6.1 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run with seven strikeouts in a no-decision. Kevin Herget was the starter for the Redbirds in that game.

- Earned second-career MLB save on April 28 at Chicago-AL with a scoreless ninth...was the first player in MLB history to record each of his first two saves against each Chicago teams

- Was a Southern Leauge Mid-Season All-Star in 2017 with Jackson and a 2016 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in the Diamondbacks organization
