Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Redbirds open a six-game series at AutoZone Park tonight. The teams played a six-game series in Memphis on April 9-14 to a 3-3 split. The series included a rain-shortened game and a doubleheader on April 12. In tonight's game, Nashville will send Taylor Clarke to the mound. He will go up against Zack Thompson for Memphis.

Taylor Clarke: The 31-year-old right-hander will make his fifth appearance (third start) for the Sounds this season. After being placed on the 15-day injured list at the start of the season, Clarke made his first outing of the season on May 12 at Durham. This season, Clarke is 1-0, with a 3.86 ERA (7.0 IP/3 ER) and two strikeouts. He has yet to go longer than 2.0 innings in an outing or more than 32 pitches. In his last outing versus Charlotte on May 24, he picked up the win with 2.0 scoreless innings of work. It was his first win since September 12, 2023 at Chicago-AL. Clarke has extensive minor league and MLB experience dating back to 2015. In 183 appearances (22 starts) in the MLB with the Royals and Diamondbacks, he is 15-15 with a 5.03 ERA (279.1 IP/156 ER) and 260 strikeouts. Last season for the Royals, he was second on the team with 58 appearances and posted a 5.95 ERA (59.0 IP/39 ER). The Ashburn, Virginia native was drafted in 2015 by the Diamondbacks from the College of Charleston. He was acquired in a trade from Kansas City on December 14, 2023 in exchange for RHP Ryan Brady and SS Cam Devaney.

Zack Thompson: The 26-year-old left-hander will make his sixth appearance (fifth start) for the Redbirds in 2024. He is 1-0 with a 2.29 ERA (19.2 IP/5 ER) and 22 strikeouts. With the Cardinals this season, Thompson is 0-2 with a 9.53 ERA (17.0 IP/18 ER) in five outings (two starts). In his last time on the mound at Durham on May 22, he went 5.0 innings, allowing five hits, two earned runs (two home runs), two walks and struck out eight. Thompson has spent his entire minor league career in the Cardinals organization and made his MLB debut on June 3, 2022 at Chicago-NL. He was named an Arizona Fall League Rising Star in 2021 playing with the Glendale Desert Dogs. The Indiana native peaked at no. 5 prospect for the Cardinals according to MLB.com. He was drafted in the first round (19th overall) by the Cardinals in the 2019 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Kentucky.

We're Going Streaking: Isaac Collins extended his hitting streak to seven games and on-base streak to 15 games with an RBI single in the sixth. He's batting .333 (17-for-51) with 12 RBI and 14 runs scored since the on-base streak began on May 10. In May, Collins leads the Sounds in walks (12), and is tied for the team lead in doubles (4). On the season, he is second on the team in total bases (77), and RBI (28), trailing Brewer Hicklen in both categories.

Woes are Gone: Though being charged with the loss, Tyler Woessner continued to improve with one earned run allowed across 5.1 innings. In his last three outings, Woessner has a 1.80 ERA (15.0 IP/3 ER) and 15 strikeouts. In his first two starts with Nashville, Woessner allowed 13 earned runs in 5.0 innings. It is the first time since June 3-17, 2023 that he had three consecutive outings with one earned run or less allowed.

Hot N Cold: After starting the season 6-0 on Sunday, the Sounds have lost three consecutive series finales. Going into Sunday, Nashville had its longest winning streak of the season at five games. Their previous high of four was set in the last series at Jacksonville. Since being no hit by Norfolk back on May 3, Nashville has won 14 of their last 19 games. A win on Sunday would've been their first six-game sweep since beating Gwinnett in all six games at First Horizon Park from June 13-18 last season. Nashville had yet to reach more than one game above .500 beating Charlotte last Thursday.

Big Z: Rob Zastryzny entered Sunday's game with runners on first and second with one out in the ninth. Zastryzny struck out both batters he faced to end the frame. In 20 outings, he is 4-0 with a 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP/3 ER), 27 strikeouts and a 0.67 WHIP. His 9.00 K/BB ratio leads the team and is well above second place at 5.00 (Jared Koenig). He leads Nashville in appearances (20) and is tied for the team lead in wins (4).

Oops! Sunday was the second time this season that the Sounds had three errors in a game (May 19). Last season, Nashville had seven games with three errors committed and three games with four errors. They are tied for fifth in Triple-A with a .982 fielding percentage. Nashville has six errors in their last seven games compared to 26 errors in 44 games to start the season. Tyler Black leads the team with five errors on the season and three at first base. Last season, Black only had one error in 137.2 innings at first base for the Sounds.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 710-607 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,302-2,127 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Picked up the win in a relief appearance versus Charlotte on May 24. Clarke went 2.0 innings, allowing one hit, zero earned runs and struck out one batter.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Clarke's second career outing against Memphis. His lone appearance came on June 8, 2018 in Memphis while pitching for Reno. He went 6.1 innings, allowing three hits, one earned run with seven strikeouts in a no-decision. Kevin Herget was the starter for the Redbirds in that game.

- Set a career high in appearances

- Allowed just one earned run across eight appearances (8.0 IP) in April, but allowed 11 earned runs across 11 games in May (9.1 IP)
- Earned second-career MLB save on April 28 at Chicago-AL with a scoreless ninth...was the first player in MLB history to record each of his first two saves against each Chicago teams

- Was a Southern League Mid-Season All-Star in 2017 with Jackson and a 2016 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in the Diamondbacks organization
