RIDERS FALL IN GAME THREE TO ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were within two runs until late in Thursday's ballgame, but the Arkansas Travelers added four late runs to win 8-2 at Dickey-Stephens Park. Dustin Harris doubled to lead off the seventh for Frisco, stole a base and scored on an error to cut the deficit to 4-2, but Arkansas (27-15) scored the final four runs of the night. Frisco (18-23) put multiple runners aboard in each of the final three innings but did not score after Harris came home in the seventh. The RoughRiders, who entered the series with the third-highest scoring offense in the Texas League, have been held to two runs in each game this series. **Owen White** (1-2) allowed four earned runs and six hits in four innings for Frisco, with five walks and five strikeouts. He eluded early trouble with a pair of strikeouts in the first inning and a double play in the third, but allowed runs in each of his final three frames. Emerson Hancock (5-1) conceded just two hits to Frisco and one earned run in six innings. Evan Carter recorded the RoughRiders' first hit with two outs in the fourth inning but Hancock immediately got a ground out to end the inning. **Trevor Hauver** finally drew blood off Hancock in the fifth inning with an RBI single to score Harris. Harris had walked that inning and went 2-for-3 in the game with two runs. Hauver recorded three base hits to raise his batting average to .250.

STRENGTH IN ARMS

After the RoughRiders had the worst ERA in the Texas League over a two-week span, over the last nine games, Frisco has the sec-ond-best ERA in the Texas League at 3.04 while going 5-4. The Riders have ceded a league-low four home runs and 42 hits (.158 BAA) with a 1.04 WHIP.

BROKEN BATS

While the RoughRiders pitching staff has been fantastic over the last week and a half, the Riders offense has taken a step back over the same span. In the last four games, Frisco has just scored seven runs while hitting .160 (19-for-119)/.266/.202/.468 with five extra-base hits (all doubles). In the last six contents, the Riders have scored a league-low 16 runs with a .199/.302/.262/.564 slashline and only one home run.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Liam Hicks hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**). Frisco also has a 1.213 OPS with the bags full, which is second in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.445).

TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder Evan Carter is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher Owen White is No. 51, infielder Luisangel Acuña places at No. 58 and pitcher Jack Leiter is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher Brock Porter, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 23 games, he is hitting .351 (33-for-94)/.398/.521/.919 with five doubles, a triple, three homers, 16 RBIs and 16 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .341/.375/.488/.863 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder Kellen Strahm has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just 125/250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .282/.390/.439/.829 with five doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking 15 times. Over the last 22 games, he has raised his average 102 points and his OPS 275 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .302 (51-for-169).374.432/.806 through the first 40 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (51), eighth in average (.302), tied for seventh in doubles (11) and tied for first in stolen bases (18). Over his last 36 games, he is batting .318/.395/.464/.859. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 205 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is fourth in Double-A. Dustin Harris is second in the league with 31 walks while Evan Carter is fourth in OBP (.418) in the league and third in the league with 28 walks.

ABOUT RICKY

-Born in New York, but moved to Florida when he was three years old.

-At Williston High School, he was a 2017 Rawlings-Perfect Game HM All-American after posting a 0.53 ERA with 87 strikeouts over 53 innings. He also hit .390 with three doubles, 18 RBIs, 22 runs and 22 steals. He won back-to-back Class 1A State Championships.

-Committed to Stetson University before being drafted in the 15th round of the 2017 draft by the Rangers.

-Studied video of Rays pitcher Tyler Glasnow and modeled his game after him. Grew up a fan of Florida native Alex Rodriguez.

-Between 2020 and 2022, Ricky added nearly 40 pounds with the help of the Rangers nutrition staff following his surgery. He ate up to 6,000+ calories a day with protein shakes and massive Chipotle bowls being staples in his diet.

2023 SEASON

-No. 27 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Began the season on the Injured List with left knee injury suffered in Spring Training.

2022 SEASON

-No. 17 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Added to the Rangers 40-man roster before the season.

-Pitched in a MiLB game for the first time in 959 days (8/27/19 from 4/12/22) when he made his season debut on April 12th, throwing 1.2 innings and allowing three runs.

-Over his last six starts in High-A (7/30-9/2), he went 1-2 with a 2.30 ERA. Over 27.1 innings, Vanasco struck out 38 while walking 16 and allowing just a .214 batting average against.

-Missed season due to "Tommy John" surgery.

-Pitched in Arizona Fall League.

2020 SEASON

-Missed season due to COVID-19 Pandemic

2019-2017 SEASON

-After going a combined 3-1 with a 1.81 ERA in Hickory and Spokane, he was named the 10thbest prospect in the Northwest League.
