

LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox dropped their fourth straight contest on Tuesday afternoon by a 4-2 final against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Bowie struck first, with two runs in the bottom of the third delivered via a Zach Watson RBI double and John Rhodes RBI single. The early offense for the Baysox was backed by four one-hit, shutout innings thrown by right-hander Houston ROth. However, Richmond would scrape ar run across in each of the fifth and seventh innings to tie the game, as Tyler Fitzgerlad came around to score on a fielder's choice and infield single respectively, after leading off both frames with an extra-base hit. Two solo home runs, courtesy of Patrick Bailey and Andy Thomas, off Bowie right-hander Tyler Burch in the eighth inning gave Richmond the 4-2 lead it would hold the rest of the way. The Baysox bats were unable to generate much through the back-half of the contest, despite two hits from Cesar Preito, as the Flying Squirrel's bullpen totaled six shutouts innings in the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter this week's series atop the Eastern League Southwest division with a 9-6 record - a game ahead of jointsecond-place Akron and Harrisburg and 3.5 games ahead of the Baysox. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond is coming off a first-half division title and postseason berth in 2022. The Flying Squirrels are led by second-year manager Dennis Pelfry, who returns most of his staff from last season. Through 15 games, Richmond is on a tear at the plate, leading the league in team average (.252), on-base percentage (.354), OPS (.732), hits (122) and runs (86). The Flying Squirrels also have the fewest errors in the league (10) and most strikeouts as a pitching staff (170). They are led by Patrick Bailey, who sits third in the Eastern League with 17 hits, and leads the team with a .340 average - sitting second on the team with 9 RBI. Riley Mahan leads all Flying Squirrels with three home runs and a .514 slugging percentage. Bailey (No. 11 SF) is one of seven Giants Top 30 prospects currently on the Richmond roster, per MLB Pipeline. Others include OF Luis Matos (No. 7 SF), along with RHPs Mason Black (No. 10 SF), Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), Randy Rodriguez (No. 26 SF), and Ryan Murphy (No. 27 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond looks to send left-hander Nick Zwack to start on the mound tonight. Zwack has gone 10.1 innings across his first three starts, allowing four earned runs, while striking out 14 batters and walking just five. The southpaw recently took the mound for his shortest outing of 2023 when he went just two innings, allowing a pair of runs on solo homers against Erie last Thursday, throwing 49 pitches in the process. He tossed four one-hit, shutout frames on April 8 against Reading with nine strikeouts and no walks. Zwack, much like yesterday's starter for Richmond, Carson Seymour, was a part of last season's trade between the Mets and Giants that was headlined by the Mets accquiring Darin Ruf. Through 93 innings across High-A for both Brooklyn (Mets) and Eugene (Giants), Zwack posted a 2.52 ERA with 109 strikeouts to 32 walks. In total, he only allowed six home runs across his 105.2 professional innings in 2022, despite having the second-highest fly ball-ratio (54.2%) in the Giants' system. Zwack's 2022 earned him a South Atlathic League postseason All-Star selection for Brookyln. Zwack was originally a 17th-round pick for the Mets in 2021 out of Xavier University. His main out pitch is a sweeping slider, which plays alongside a mid-90s fastball with arm-side action and a high spin rate. Zwack also features a changeup.

HAIL CÉSAR

Cesar Prieto's 2-4 performance on Tuesday was already his eighth multi-hit game of the season. The Bowie infielder leads the Eastern League, and is tied for the most in Double-A, with 25 hits. Prieto also leads the Eastern Leauge in batting average, and is fifth in on-base percentage, among qualified players. He has hits in 13 of 15 games, including multiple hits in four of the last five contests. Among Baysox, Prieto leads the way in hits, average, on-base percentage, doubles, and OPS. He's also second on the team in slugging percentage. Prieto's 25 hits are also the most in the Orioles' system in 2023, despite Triple-A Norfolk playing six additional games.

ELEMENTARY, MY DEAR WATSON!

OF Zach Watson has hits in six-straight Double-A contests for just the third time in his career. Watson also has multiple hits in three of his last five games for just the second time in his professional career. In this current hitting streak, Watson is batting .391 (9-for-23), with a home run and seven runs batted in. On the season, Watson is batting .400 (4-for-10) in a limited sample size with runners in scoring position. His season average is up to .300, after hitting just .199 for the Baysox throughout all of 2022.

DOUBLE (PLAY) TROUBLE

The Baysox bats have struggled to capitalize on their chances early on this season. The Baysox have lost six of their last seven games, dating back to Sunday, April 16 against Akron. In this seven-game stretch, Bowie has hit into 14 double plays, while only stringing together consecutive hits seven times. By comparison, Bowie has hit into eight double plays immediately following a base-runner in the last seven games. The Baysox are also hitting just .205 with runners in scoring position - the second-lowest total in the Eastern League.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japking career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson as Japked two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Onoles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.
