TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with Bowie, a series that has massive postseason implications.

AST TIME OUT: Bowie drew the series even with a 7-5 win. Jared Triolo picked up 3 hits, including a solo homer in the 3rd, and Fabricio Macias slammed a three-run homer in the defeat.

BIG TREE HIT BALL HARD: Infielder Jared Triolo is playing some of his best baseball on both sides of the ball as the season moves into late-August. Triolo is amid a 12-game on-base streak (8/9 - Present) in which he's batting: .388/.446/.735/1.181 with 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 6 RBI and 3-3 SB. Triolo has scored a run in seven straight games (8/14 - Present), the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In his last 50 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .407 on-base percentage with 24 extra base hits. He's reached base safely in 17-of-18 games in August.

PLAYOFFS?!: With 4 weeks remaining in the regular season, Altoona appears to be playing playoff baseball for the rest of the way. Beginning on Tuesday, August 23, Altoona will play their next three series against teams ahead of them in the stadings, @ Bowie, Akron and @ Erie, giving them a golden opportunity to overcome their 4.5 game deficit in the standings.

K-MAN: Right-hander Luis Ortiz has 116 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since **Taylor Hearn** in 2018. Should he stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 5 more starts in the regular season; giving him a solid chance to set the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (**Ian Snell**, 2004: 142). He would need to average 6 strikeouts per start the rest of the way to lock down the mark.

NICKY G IS BACK: Infielder Nick Gonzales picked up a season-high 4 hits including a walk-off double in the 10th inning of Altoona's 3-2 win over Harrisburg on Wednesday, August 17. After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Gonzales has reached base safely in each of his first 8 games since his activation batting: .286/.459/.393 (8-for-28) with 3´2B, 1 RBI, 7 BB and 1-3 SB since his return.

BOMBS AWAY: Jared Triolo hit 3 lead-off homers in the span of 9 days (8/10, 8/14 and 8/18) becoming just the 2nd player in franchise history to hit 3 lead-off homers in a career. Alen Hanson hit a franchise-best 4 lead-off homers in 2014. The Curve have now hi 6 lead-off home runs this season setting the franchise record.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford homered in four consecutive games for the Curve from August 7-12, all of which were two-run shots. Altoona's franchise record for consecutive games with a home run stands at 6 when Brad Eldred homered in each game from 4/26-5/2 in 2005. With his 22 homers on the season, Shackelford is the 10th player in franchise history to homer 20 times in a season, **Mason Martin** hit 22 homers in 2021 for the Curve. Martin was also the most recent Curve batter to homer in 4 straight games when he did so from 7/3-6 in 2021. <u>Shackelford is tied for 1st among Pirates MiLB with 23 HR (Matt Gorski) and ranks 3rd in</u> the Eastern League with 24 Extra-Base Hits in the Second Half of the Season.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB. com, C Endy Rodriguez. Rodrigurez has picked up at least one hit in each of his first 11 games with the Curve, including multi-hit games in three of his last seven games.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 142 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 28 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (23), Liover Peguero (22) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE MEN FROM THE SENATE: Managed by Kyle Moore, Bowie is right in the thick of the playoff race entering this series. Bowie features several top prospects ranked by MLB.com: OF Colton Cowser (#4), INF Coby Mayo (#7), INF Connor Norby (#12), RHP Chayce McDermott (#14), LHP Cade Povich (#15), INF Joey Ortiz (#19), INF Cesar Prieto (#21), and OF Hudson Haskin (#24).

THE FIRST TO LAY BY THE BAY: Cade Povich takes the ball for Bowie tonight. Povich was drafted in the 3rd round by Minnesota in 2021 out of Nebraska and was acquired by the Orioles in the Jorge Lopez deal at the deadline. Povich struck out 107 batters in 78.2 IP with a 4.46 ERA at High-A Cedar Rapids to begin the season and made one start against Somerset last week, allowing 2 runs in 5.0 innings with 6 strikeouts. Povich hails from Bellevue, Neb. which is about a 20 minute ride east from the Kansas City Royals Triple-A affiliate in Omaha, Neb. Bellevue is actually the third-largest city in Nebraska, behind Omaha and Lincoln, and the secondlargest U.S. city named "Bellevue" behind Bellevue, Washington. Notable people that hail from Bellevue, Neb. incude former Braves RHP Buddy Carlyle, former Phillies RHP Tyler Cloyd, former Mets C Todd Pratt and Hall of Fame RHP Bob Gibson.
