**About the Last One:** Yet again, it was the starting pitching for the Baysox that shined, as **Kevin Smith** threw 4.2 innings and struck out eight batters, including seven consecutive at one point. He did not allow a run, setting up Bowie well for the rest of the night. The Baysox plated one run in the first inning, tacked on four more in the third, and then their last run came in the sixth. Bowie led 6-0 into the eighth, when Richmond scored their first run but left the bases loaded. The Flying Squirrels saw one batter reach in the ninth, but **Luis Perez** locked it down in his first Double-A appearance as Bowie won their second consecutive game.

**Player of the Week:** On Monday, **Patrick Dorrian** was named the Double-A Northeast League's Player of the Week for his play against Reading. Dorrian was 7-21 (.333) with three doubles, three homers (including the grand slam), 11 RBI (including two four-RBI games on Thursday and Friday), seven walks (walked 3 times on Sunday), scored eight runs (three on Sunday, including the winning run), and stole one base. He currently leads the Double-A Northeast league through the first two weeks in SLG (.909) and OPS (1.420). Tied for second in all of Double-A baseball with those five homers in first two weeks.

**Bradish and Smith and Hall, Oh My:** With the win on Thursday night, Bowie is now 9-0 in 2021 when **Kyle Bradish**, **Kevin Smith**, or **D.L. Hall** are the starting pitchers. Together, they have struck out 66 batters in 38.2 innings pitched.

**Peralta Pitching:** Right-hander **Ofelky Peralta**, in his first season in Double-A, will make his second start for the Baysox on Friday night. His first start came in his first appearance, back on May 7th against the Altoona Curve. In that start, Peralta threw four innings, struck out five batters, issued three walks, and was tagged for two runs on three hits, including one homer. He appeared once in relief in the Reading series, throwing four innings on May 14th and only allowing one run on one hit with two walks and five strikeouts. **In the Other Corner:** Richmond will turn to righty **Tristan Beck** to turn things around in this series. Beck is also in his first season at the Double-A level, and was the starter in the season-opener against Hartford. He has started all three games he has appeared in, and has thrown 13.2 innings so far. His ERA sits at 5.40, as he has allowed nine runs, eight of which have been earned, on 15 hits. Opponents are hitting .278 against him.

**This Day in Baysox History:** In 2015, Bowie's offense was stifled in a marathon game against the Trenton Thunder. The teams combined for just a single run in thirteen innings of play on May 21st, as Trenton won 1-0. Bowie only managed four hits in the entire contest.
