**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Sea Dogs, 6-5. Richmond took a 2-0 lead in the first with RBIs by **Tyler Fitzgerald** and **Brett Auerbach**. **Jacob Heyward** hit a solo homer in the second to open a 3-0 lead. In the third, **Ceddanne Rafaela** closed the score to 3-1 with a homer. **Brandon Martorano** extended the Richmond lead to 5-1 in the eighth with a two-run double. The Sea Dogs took a 6-5 lead with five runs in the bottom of the eighth.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from June 21-26 to close out the first half. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Portland since June 4-6, 2019, when Richmond won two-of-three in a the series.

**WE ARE HEADED NORTH:** The Flying Squirrels are in the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond.

**TICKET PUNCHED:** The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 11-24 to open the second half. They have lost 16-of-the-last-21 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23 and six-of-the-last-seven. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost seven and split four this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,144 strikeouts (11.0 per game) and rank tied for third with 134 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 24-30 on the road this year. Richmond is 23-22 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 12-20 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 3-6 record in road games.

**THE SEA DOGS** are leading the Northeast Division second-half standings by a half-game over Somerset. They have won four-of-their-last-five games after dropping the previous five straight. Portland's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including RHP Bryan Mata (7), RHP Thad Ward (14), 3B Alex Binelas (20), INF/OF/C Stephen Scott (23), SS Christian Koss (24), OF/INF Ceddanne Rafaela (25) or OF Wilyer Abreu (29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his league-leading 22nd start of the season. Last time out, Teng struck out 10 batters over five runs and allowed one run in a no-decision on Saturday at New Hampshire. Over his last two starts since July 30, Teng has collected 16 strikeouts and allowed one run in 8.0 innings, combining for a 1.13 ERA. Teng is fourth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (113), tied for first in games started (21) and seventh in innings pitched (99.0). Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

**FOR PORTLAND:** Right-hander Bryan Mata makes his seventh Double-A start of the season and his first against Richmond. In his last outing, Mata allowed five runs (four earned) over 5.2 innings in a win over the SeaWolves on Saturday. He missed the start of the season working back from Tommy John surgery and joined Low-A Salem for his first outing of the year on June 4, his first action since the 2019 season. He made three appearances for High-A Greenville before being assigned to Portland on June 28. Over his first four Double-A outings of the year from June 28-July 15, Mata went 1-0 with a 0.55 ERA (1 ER/16.1 IP). Over his last three starts, he is 1-2 with a 5.65 ERA (9 ER/14.1 IP). Mata first reached Double-A in 2019 and made 11 starts for the Sea Dogs, going 4-6 with a 5.03 ERA before missing the next two years.

**GOING UNDER:** With Wednesday's loss, the Flying Squirrels' overall record dropped under .500 for the first time since August 19, 2021, when they were 46-47. Last year, the team climbed back over .500 to finish the season with their first winning record since 2015. In the team's history, the Flying Squirrels have posted winning records in 2011, 2014, 2015 and 2021. Thursday's loss pushed Richmond two games under .500 for the first time since August 18, 2021, when they were 45-47.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 13th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

**THE STARTING LINE:** Over the last 11 games since July 29, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10 ER/53.1 IP) with 73 strikeouts and 22 walks. Over those 11 starts, Flying Squirrels pitchers have held opponents to one-or-less runs in eight of them, including six scoreless starts.

**STRIKING OUT THE SEA DOGS:** On the year, Richmond starting pitchers have posted their four highest strikeout totals against the Sea Dogs. From June 24-26, Richmond starters **Kai-Wei Teng**, **Bryan Brickhouse** and **Kyle Harrison** each struck out 11 batters in three straight games. Those outings were the first 11-strikeout performances by Richmond pitchers since **Conner Menez** recorded 11 strikeouts against the Yard Goats on August 19, 2018. On Wednesday, **Matt Frisbee** struck out 13 Portland batters, breaking the Flying Squirrels single-game franchise record.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 134 home runs this season, which is tied for third in the Eastern League. Last Sunday in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

**MARTY PARTY:** **Brandon Martorano** is riding a seven-game hit streak dating back to July 28, during which he is batting .423 (11-for-26) with a homer, three doubles and six RBIs. He has hit in the leadoff spot in three-of-his-last-four games played, including a 4-for-5 game last Thursday night and a two-hit game on Saturday, both at New Hampshire. In his four games this year batting first in the order, Martorano is batting .444 (8-for-18) with two homers and four RBIs.

**BACH TO FORM:** In his last nine games, **Brett Auerbach** is batting .306 (11-for-36) with four homers, three doubles, 12 RBIs and nine runs scored. He opened last week's series with a four-game game on Tuesday at New Hampshire, including a homer. He went deep again last Wednesday, his third straight game with a home run. On Sunday, Auerbach picked up four hits again, including a homer and three doubles, and drove in six runs. On Monday, Auerbach was announced as the Eastern League's Player of the Week for August 2-7. He is hitting .083 (1-for-12) with one RBI in this week's series at Portland.

**FITZ ON FIRE:** Over his last 22 games since July 10, **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered eight times. He now has 18 homers this season, which ranks tied for the third-most in a season in franchise history, even with **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lison** (2014) and trailing only **David Villar** (20 - 2021) and **Sean Roby** (23 - 2022). On the current road trip, Fitzgerald is batting .314 (11-for-35) in eight games with two homers, one double and eight RBIs.

**ROBUST:** **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked third in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for in homers (23). **Mike Gigliotti** is 10th in OBP (.368), ninth in walks (50) and tied for sixth in stolen bases (23). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (18). **Kai-Wei Teng** is fourth in strikeouts (113), tied for first in games started (21), seventh in innings pitched (99.0) and tied for ninth in BAA (.256).

**WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Christian Koss is ranked fourth in batting average (.282), fifth in RBIs (64), second in hits (105) and fifth in total bases (166). Tyler Dearden is seventh in OBP (.376). David Hamilton is first in triples (8) and first in stolen bases (51).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Casey Schmitt** (6), **Ryan Murphy** (15), **Cole Waites** (21) and **Ricardo Genovés** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), Schmitt (13), **Tristan Peters** (25) and Genovés (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 23 overall prospect.
