YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 2-1. The Baysox opened the scoring in the first inning with an RBI single by Adley Rutschman, the first run allowing by Richmond starter **Matt Frisbee** in 2021. A second run scored in the first inning on an error by the Flying Squirrels defense. Richmond scored its only run in the fifth inning with an RBI infield single by **Kyle Motrice**. Frisbee was charged with his first Double-A loss after allowing two runs (one earned) over 5.0 innings. Bowie starter Kyle Bradish struck out 10 Flying Squirrels batters over 4.0 scoreless innings of work and allowing two hits and one walk. Richmond relievers **Mac Marshall** and **Patrick Ruotolo** combined for 3.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels played the third of a six-game set against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams will face of 24 times this season, with two series in Bowie and two in Richmond. The Flying Squirrels enter on a three-game losing streak. The Baysox are in first place in the AA-NE Southwest and have won seven of their last eight games.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 9-5 record is the second-best start through 14 games in team history, trailing only a 10-4 start in 2018. That year's edition of the Flying Squirrels opened the year 11-4 through the first 15 games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in third place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 1.5 games behind Bowie. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Six players from the 2019 team are currently on the Richmond roster, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** pitched in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE BAYSOX lead the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division by a half-game over Erie. Patrick Dorrian was named the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week after hitting .333 with three homers and 11 RBIs last week against Reading. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Adley Rutschman (1), D.L. Hall (4), Terrin Vavra (11), Kyle Bradish (13) and Kevin Smith (17). The Baysox are tied for first in the league in home runs (19) and runs scored (88).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Gerson Garabito** makes his third start of the season. Last time out, allowed three runs in the first before settling in to go scoreless through the rest of his season-high 5.0 innings in a no-decision at Harrisburg on Friday. In his Giants organization debut on May 8 against Hartford (G2), Garabito worked 4.0 innings and allowed one unearned run in a no-decision. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Kevin Smith takes the mound for his third start of the year. In his first outing of the year on May 6, he fired 4.2 scoreless inning at Altoona with five strikeouts. He followed with 3.2 innings and two runs allowed on Friday against Reading. Smith was traded to the Baltimore Orioles along with Victor Gonzalez (PTBNL) from the New York Mets on August 31, 2020 for RHP Miguel Castro. He was selected by the Mets in the seventh round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels leads all of Double-A (2.72) in ERA. The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for second in shutouts (2), tied for second in saves (6), second in fewest runs allowed (46) and third in opponents' batting average (.202). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** is tied for fourth among qualified pitchers in ERA (0.56). He leads Double-A and sits second in all of the minors in WHIP (0.38). **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for second in Double-A with three saves.

AIN'T THAT GRAND: On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** clubbed a go-ahead grand slam for his first Double-A home run. It was the first grand slam for the Flying Squirrels since **Jacob Heyward** hit a walk-off slam in the tenth inning to beat the Erie SeaWolves on August 19, 2019. Angulo now sits tied for eighth in the Double-A Northeast with a .325 batting average this season. Prior to the 2021 season, Angulo had not played above the Low-A level. He spent the 2019 season with Single-A Augusta, seeing time in 73 games.

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for the lead in the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for third in games pitched (6). Last Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise.

TOP OF THE CLASS: Adley Rutschman is the fourth player selected No. 1 overall in the MLB Draft to play against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond. In 2011, Harrisburg's Bryce Harper (2010 Draft) played five games in Richmond, batting .278 (5-for-18) with a double from July 21-24. In 2019, Reading's Mickey Moniak (2016) played six games in Richmond, batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles and six RBIs. Also in 2019, Casey Mize (2018) pitched against the Flying Squirrels on July 21 and allowed six runs (five earned) while only recording two outs in his start. Two other top overall draft picks who played in the Eastern League/Double-A Northeast during the Flying Squirrels' existence, Gerrit Cole (2011 Draft) and Stephen Strasburg (2009 Draft), never pitched at The Diamond.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Monday night, 2019 Flying Squirrels outfielder **Johneshwy Fargas** made his Major League debut for the New York Mets in Atlanta. He picked up his first MLB hit in the game, an RBI double. In 2019, Fargas was named the Flying Squirrels Player of the Year after hitting .249 over 127 games. He also set the franchise's single-season stolen base record with 50 on the year.
