Transaction: Before today's game, the Lugnuts placed outfielder Lazaro Armenteros on the Temporarily Inactive List. No corresponding move was made.

Welcome to the Show: 2016-2017 Lugnuts pitcher Kirby Snead made his MLB debut last night in relief for the Toronto Blue Javs, becoming the 159th Nut all-time to reach MLB and the fifth this year.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is second in the Majors in batting average (.327), second in home runs (32), second in RBIs (80), first in on-base percentage (.424), second in slugging (.656), second in total bases (231), first in OPS (1.080) and third in runs scored (77) behind fellow 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette (78). 2019 Lugs outfielder Griffin Conine is tied for Minor League lead with 24 home runs.

Historical Lugnuts Roster Index: When he pinch-hit in the eighth inning last night, D.J. Lee became the 848th Lugnuts player all-time and the 44th player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have thus surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1997 (42), 1999 (38), 2000 (42), 2001 (40) 2004 (42), 2006 (43), 2007 (43), 2008 (43), 2009 (38) and 2013 (41) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.75% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (159 of 848). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least eight of the 44 Lugnuts players this year will eventually reach the Majors

Family (Scouting) Ties: D.J. Lee's father, Derek Lee, Sr., played in the Majors for the Minnesota Twins in 1993 and played in the Minor Leagues from 1988-1999. He now serves as a territorial scout for the Oakland Athletics in the Midwest and was responsible for scouting/signing Lugnuts pitcher Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny and Garrett Acton.

No Place Like Close to Home: The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

Hoya Saxa: Right-hander Jack Cushing, tonight's starter, has been brilliant since joining the Lugnuts from Low-A Stockton. Cushing's appearances: six innings, one run vs. Dayton; a seven-inning complete game, one run at Great Lakes; five shutout innings of relief vs. Lake County; and Thursday night's six innings, two runs at West Michigan. All told, Cushing has 25 strikeouts and five walks in 24 innings with a 1.50 ERA, allowing an OBA of .157.

Position Player Pitching: Yesterday's game ended with DH William Simoneit tossing the ninth inning, allowing a home run to Agustin Ruiz in the process. Simoneit became the Lugnuts' third position player to be used as a pitcher this year, joining Ryan Gridley (two appearances) and Shane Selman (one appearance) -- although Simoneit is the first of the three to surrender a run on the mound.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** The Lugnuts were down 6-1 late at Lake County, but scored two in the 7th, one in the 8th and two in the 9th to force extra innings before falling, 7-6, on Yu-Cheng Chang's walk-off RBI single in the 10th. In the ninth inning, Lake County reliever Nick Pasquale melted down, balking in the game-tying run, tossing two wild pitches and hitting a batter before Caleb Hamrick pitched the final 1 1/3 innings for the Captains.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher Ty Tice '18, outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, and pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed:** On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Díaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard University, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter Jack Cushing spent four years at Georgetown University.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

Last Start: July 15 vs. Lake County, pitched in relief, piggybacking Shohei Tomioka (4 IP, 2 H, 0 R) and firing the final five innings scorelessly to complete a five-hit 4-0 shutout of the Captains... result was even more impressive considering Captains scored 48 runs in the other four games of the series.

#### 2021 in Lansing:

- Debuted in the High-A Central against the Dayton Dragons, July 2, with a dominating performance: 6 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 6 K... allowed only one hit through five scoreless innings before giving up a run in final frame... Lugnuts cruised to 10-3 victory over Dayton.

- Started Game 2 of doubleheader, July 9 at Great Lakes: tossed 7-inning CG, 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 9 K on 84 pitches (57 strikes) in Lugnuts' 2-1 win... came four outs from throwing a no-hitter, broken up by Leonel Valera's two-out single in the 6th.

#### 2021 in the Low-A West:

- Began the season as the No. 3 starter in Stockton's rotation and blasted out of the gates with four hitless innings, walking three and striking out two, against the Modesto Nuts, May 6.

- Finished May with a 0.92 ERA in four starts: 2 ER in 19 2/3 IP, 7 BB, 23 K and a .147 opponent average. - Struck out 10 batters in six innings at Rancho Cucamonga, May 27, allowing two hits, one walk and one run via solo HR.

- In June, posted a 4.71 ERA in four starts, with 11 ER in 21 IP, 3 BB, 20 K, .321 avg., though of the four starts, two were poor (4 HR in 5 IP vs. San Jose, June 10; 7 R/4 ER in 4 1/3 IP at Fresno, June 17) and two were outstanding (5.2 IP, 2 R, 8 K vs. Lake Elsinore, June 3; and 6 IP, 1 UER, 0 BB, 4 K at Inland Empire, June 24).

- Shut down right-handers: .221/.292/.379... left-handers hit .281/.288/.421... of 10 walks issued, however, nine were to right-handed batters.

- Opposing base-stealers were 5-for-7 in success rate.

Going Pro: Drafted in the 22nd round, 2019, signing with the A's for \$1,000... signing scout: Tripp Faulk, who also signed the Lugnuts' Bryce Nightengale and Elvis Peralta, Jr., and was the scout for 2021 Oakland Athletics draft picks Zack Gelof (2nd round) and Aaron Holiday (13th round).

**2019 Pro Debut:** Opened in AZL with two appearances for A's Gold before making 11 appearances, 6 starts, with Short-Season Vermont... in best appearance, 8/1/19, pitching five shutout two-hit innings at State College, striking out two... opposition went 4-for-5 in stealing bases against him.

**Traveling Childhood:** Born in Enid, Oklahoma - the ninth-largest city in the state - Cushing moved to Colorado for "several years" before his family relocated to Flower Mound, 28 miles northwest of Dallas, when he was seven... he grew up rooting for the Texas Rangers... Flower Mound is named for, yes, a flowering mound - a 50-foot tall hill nicknamed "The Mound," maintained by The Mound Foundation, which features dozens of flowers naturally blooming each spring... Flower Mound is located 28 miles northwest of Dallas, on Grapevine Lake... 2019 Lugnuts starter Sean Wymer also hailed from Flower Mound... in his spare time, he enjoys hunting, fishing and hiking.

Glory Days: Attended Marcus High School... named team captain as a senior, going 6-2 with a 0.73 ERA to earn the honor of District 6-6A Pitcher of the Year... was named to the Texas Sports Writer's Association Class 6-A All-State Team and Dallas Morning News All-Area Team... set Marcus H.S. career records in no-hitters and shutouts, ranking second all-time in wins and innings and third in complete games.. played two years on the Marcus H.S. varsity football team.

Hoya Saxa: Attended Georgetown University, where he set the progam's career strikeout record (236) with 11 K's in his final college appearance, 5/17/19 vs. Butler at Shirley Povich Field... set Georgetown's single-game strikeout record with 16 K's vs. Mount St. Mary's, 3/5/19... notched 87 strikeouts total in 79 1/3 innings as a senior in 15 games, 12 starts, leading the Hoyas with a 3.06 ERA... Named All-Big East Second Team, Big East Honor Roll, and Big East All-Academic Team... baseball greats from Georgetown include legendary scout Clyde Sukeforth, Doc White, speedster Art Devlin, and Del Bissonette... the only Hoyas to reach the Majors in the last 50 years: Sean Maloney (1997-98) and Tim Adelman (2016-17).

Lansing Connection: Played for 2018 Lugnuts hitting coach (and current Dunedin Blue Jays hitting coach) Matt Young on the Dallas Mustangs... teammates with Zac Cook, currently playing for the Dunedin Blue Jays.
