**ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Mets INF Eduardo Escobar** had two of Brooklyn's 14 hits en route to an 8-5 triumph Thursday night against Jersey Shore to take the first three games of the series. INF Shervyen Newton homered for the third consecutive game and INF Jose Peroza extended his on-base streak to 24 games with two hits. RHP Christian Scott struck out five over 3 2/3 innings, while RHP Nolan Clenney earned the save with three shutout innings to close out the victory.

**EDUARDO IS HERE: INF Eduardo Escobar** returns to the Cyclones tonight as the designated hitter for his second rehab game with the Cyclones. Escobar played seven innings at shortstop yesterday, collecting two hits. The switch hitter is looking for at bats against a lefty pitcher after batting lefty in all four at-bats last night against righties. Escobar is recovering from a left oblique strain.

**DIVISION ON THE LINE:** Including today, the Cyclones have 15 games remaining and three series: three at Jersey Shore, six vs. Wilmington, and six at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in second place just a half game behind first place Hudson Valley for the top spot in the North Division.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF Jose Peroza has a OPS of .908 over his past 36 games with a 24-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 35 of the past 37 games, hitting .331 with a .419 OBP. In August, Peroza leads the league with 29 hits and nine doubles.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league in the second half sixth-fewest in Minor League Baseball overall, having allowed 468 runs in 117 games (4.0 runs/ game).

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division of the at ShoreTown Ballpark in Lakewood, New Jersey. Against the BlueClaws, the Cyclones are 19-5. Jersey Shore hosts three of Philadelphia's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 6 INF Hao Yu Lee, No. 21 RHP Christian McGowan, and No. 27 SS Casey Martin. The BlueClaws own a North Division worst -108 run differential.

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 464 runs in 117 games (3.9 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and tied for third-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

**OLD BAY SEASONING: OF Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor leaguers with 122 hits. In six games against Jersey Shore, the No. 4 Mets prospect is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with four doubles, two home runs, and 12 RBIs.

2021 CYCLONES TAKEOVER QUEENS: With Monday's promotion of RHP Connor Grey to the Mets roster, the Cyclones saw three 2021 members of the roster earn the callup in the past two weeks. 3B Brett Baty has played with the big club August 17 and RHP Jose Butto made his MLB debut Sunday in Philadelphia.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** made his MLB debut Wednesday with the Mets in Atlanta, hitting a two-run home run in his first at-bat en route to a 9-7 Mets victory. Baty played with Brooklyn in 2019 and in 2021 and becomes the 91st former Cyclones player to make the major leagues.

TOUGH STRETCH: Moreno has only thrown 11 innings combined over his past three starts, facing Winston-Salem, Wilmington, and Hudson Valley. Moreno has walked 11 and struck out seven over the stretch, including a career-high six free passes last week.

**AGAINST JS:** Moreno has had two outings against Jersey Shore, allowing two runs across 4 2/3 innings in June and then one scoreless inning relief appearance in July.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Luis Moreno won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the week for his performance at Hudson Valley between July 25-31.

MORE-K-NO: Moreno struck out a career-high nine batters at Hudson Valley on July 2 in his first appearance against the Yankees affiliate.

WELCOME: Moreno earned the promotion on June 1 coming to Brooklyn with fellow St. Lucie Mets pitcher LHP Nathan Lavender. The promotions from RHP Hunter Parsons and RHP Jordan Yamamoto to Double-A Binghamton made room for two new arms.

BIG YEAR: The Dominican righty has made three starts and six relief appearances with Low-A St. Lucie, striking out eight over six innings in relief against the Daytona Tortugas on May 31 before the promotion. Moreno tossed consecutive outings which would qualify as "quality starts."

2022: With St. Lucie, Moreno posted a 3.56 FIP and a 2.68 ERA with a 22% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate, compiling 40 1/3 innings in the Florida State League.

**ELIMINATING HOMERS:** Moreno's 2021 season with Low-A St. Lucie featured nine home runs allowed in 73 innings and 21 games, leading to a 6.20 FIP and 5.42 ERA. This season, Moreno allowed just one home run in 40 1/3 innings at the same level.

JUMP IN: Moreno signed with the New York Mets in June of 2019 at 20 years old. While young pitchers usually sign with teams at either 16 or 17 years old, Moreno signed and pitched with the DSL Mets1 and DSL Mets2 in 2019.
