FEATURING SEAN PAUL: Sean Paul Liñan makes his Double-A Debut tonight. In his first season in the Yankees organization after being acquired in March in a trade with Washington for 2B Jorbit Vivas, Liñan has pitched to a 5.65 ERA, 1.39 WHIP and .236 BAA in 19 GP (17 GS) in Hudson Valley this year. Across his last four outings with the Renegades, he posted a 3.32 ERA, 1-0 record, 1.11 WHIP and .179 BAA with 17 K in 19.0 IP. Liñan becomes the 15th unique Patriot to start on the mound this season and joins Jack Ceibert as the second pitcher to do so that started the year on Hudson Valley's opening day roster.

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: On Thursday night, Josh Moylan's second inning grand slam supplied the Patriots with grand slams in back-to-back games for the second time in franchise history (5/15/26 - 5/16/26 vs. BNG). Somerset's nine grand slams this season tie a franchise record (2023), lead the Eastern League, are T-1st in AA and T-2nd in MiLB. Following Friday's pair of home runs by Moylan and Alfonso, the Patriots have collected multiple homers in 48 of 114 games this season, improving to 33-15 in those games.

HOMERUN HISTORY: The Somerset Patriots enter today leading all Double-A teams with 162 home runs this season, which is tied for 7th in MiLB with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY - AAA). The home run total is already the most the Patriots have hit in a season since hitting 197 HR in 2023. With 162 homers in 114 games, the Patriots are currently on pace to hit 196 home runs this season (Double-A record: 205, SOM, 2022). Somerset's 1,016 home runs since becoming the Yankees' Double-A affiliate in 2021 lead all Double-A teams (AMA, ARI, 2nd, 933), while ranking 16th among 120 MiLB teams.

WINS OF CHANGE: At home against New Hampshire last week, Somerset took five of six games over the Fisher Cats, marking the fourth time this season the Patriots have won five games in a single week. Since July 23, Somerset's .652 win percentage (15-8) ranks third in the Eastern League, fifth in Double-A and 10th in MiLB. The Patriots' five-game win streak last week was their seventh winning streak of 3+ games this season, while they have had nine 3+ game losing streaks.

SOMETHING IN THE (BRIDGE)WATER: Roderick Arias matched his career-high in homers with his 13th of the season on Wednesday, with his first Double-A home run. Arias becomes the 13th player to suit up for Somerset this season to have matched or surpassed their previous career-high in homers, joining Garrett Martin (24), DJ Gladney (21), Josh Moylan (21), Jace Avina (19), Coby Morales (19), George Lombard Jr. (14), Core Jackson (12), Connor McGinnis (7), Kevin Verde (5), Manny Palencia (4) and Owen Cobb (3).

NEED FOR SPEED: Somerset has stolen a base in eight of its last nine games for the first time in the second half. Dating back to August 7, Somerset has racked up 19 SB which ranks 3rd in the Eastern League and 5th in Double-A. In 105 games prior, Somerset's 127 SB ranked 9th in the EL and 22nd in Double-A.

ARIAS HAS ARRIVED: Roderick Arias crushed his first Double-A home run on Wednesday, and now has reached base safely in 10 of 12 games since being promoted to Somerset. Reaching safely in 14 of his last 16 games dating back to his time in Hudson Valley, Arias is slashing .311/.373/.492 with 8 RBI, 8 XBH, 8 R, 4 BB and 3 SB in that span.

MAMBA MENTALITY: With a single on Sunday, Coby Morales extended his on-base streak to 12 games. During the span, he's slashing .262/.426/.452 with a HR, 4 RBI and 4 XBH. Entering Tuesday, he ranks among all Yankees minor leaguers in XBH (43 - T-2nd), hits (106 - 3rd), RBI (74 - T-3rd), OPS (.854 - 5th) and HR (19 - T-7th).

MR. DJ SONG PON DE REPLAY: DJ Gladney's team-high third two-homer game of the season on Tuesday clinched a new career-high 21 home runs, tying Garrett Martin for the Somerset team lead. No Somerset batter has surpassed that mark in a single season since Tyler Hardman hit 26 HR in 2023. In 15 games since 7/22, Gladney is slashing .333/.369/.700 (1.069 OPS) with 6 HR, 21 RBI, 10 XBH, 14 R, 4 BB and 3 SB.

HANDY MANNY: On Saturday, Manny Palencia smashed his fourth home run of the season and second home run of the series against New Hampshire. Palencia has now homered four times in eight August games, after only homering once in his first 258 career games. Palencia has hits in 17 of 21 games since the start of July, including nine multi-hit games with a slash line of .372/.395/.590 with 4 HR, 11 RBI and 9 XBH in that span. Palencia's .372 AVG leads all Double-A catchers and ranks 4th among all Double-A hitters with over 80 plate appearances in that stretch. Palencia's 9 XBH and .590 SLG since the start of July are juxtaposed by just 1 XBH and a .216 SLG in his first 46 games of the season from April through June.

SULTANS OF SWING: DJ Gladney accomplished his third two-homer game of the season on Tuesday, which leads all Patriots batters, in what was his 11th career two-homer game. Somerset has had 16 individual multi-homer games this season, accomplished by 12 different players. In the previous three seasons combined (2023-25), 12 different Patriots batters recorded multi-home run games.

BULLPEN BUSINESS: Somerset's bullpen has allowed two runs or fewer in 10 of its last 11 games dating back to August 5, pitching to a 2.55 ERA (6th in MiLB), 0.99 WHIP (1st in MiLB) and .176 BAA (3rd in MiLB) in that span with 57 K to 15 BB in 42.1 IP. Trent Sellers has posted a 2.30 ERA over his last 11 appearances with a .203 BAA and 19 K in 15.2 IP. Tony Rossi has tallied a 1.80 ERA, 2-0 record, 0.73 WHIP and .137 BAA with 17 K in 15.0 IP over his last 12 appearances. Geoff Gilbert has registered a 1.04 ERA, 0.69 WHIP and .107 BAA with 14 K to 3 BB in 8.2 IP across his last five outings. Kelly Austin has tossed 7 straight scoreless outings, over which he has allowed 4 H in 11.0 IP (.108 BAA, 0.91 WHIP). Across his last 19 GP, Austin has a 2.13 ERA, 2-0 record, 0.99 WHIP and .163 BAA with 27 K to 10 BB in 25.1 IP.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.
