LAST GAME

On Sunday, the Baysox rallied in the sixth inning and hung on to take down the Harrisburg Senators 4-3. After Harrisburg took an early 2-0 lead, Bowie would get a run back in the bottom of the fifth on a Donta Williams RBI single, before the Senators would tack on another run in the top of the sixth. Then, the Baysox would get to Harrisburg's left-handed starter Alemao Hernandez in the bottom half. Billy Cook led off the inning with a first pitch solo home run to make it 3-2, before Jackson Holliday hustled out an infield single. Holliday was on the second with two outs when a ground ball back to the mound from Shayne Fontana resulted in an errant toss to first from Hernandez, allowing Holliday to score and putting Fontana at second in a tie game. The next at-bat Rosa drove a single in to left field to score Fontana and give the Baysox the lead. Bowie would hold that lead for the remainder of the afternoon, with the game ending on a play at the plate, where Rosa was able to complete a relay to catcher Ramon Rodriguez, who tug out Harrisburg's Jackson Cluff trying to score from first on a single.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter today with a record of 53-35 - the second-best mark in the Eastern League. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has already clinched a postseason berth as first half champions in the Northeast division, but have a current record of 11-9 in the second half. The Patriots took four of six from the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium to open the second half a little under a month ago. Somerset continues to hold the best ERA (3.73) in the league, with the most strikeouts (912) as well. Offensively, they lead the league in home runs (136) and walks (435). The Patriots' roster includes eight of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, highlighted by OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY / No. 41 overall), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 16 NYY), and IF Tyler Hardman (No. 18 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Blane Abeyta is scheduled to open the series on the mound for Somerset. Abeyta has pitched to contact in 2023, scattering 84 hits through 79.2 innings, with his .269 opposing average sitting as the highest on the staff among qualifiers, while his 10 home runs allowed is the second-highest total amongst Patriot arms. Abeyta has allowed eight hits and three runs through 5.1 innings in each of his past two starts - 7/7 against Reading and this past Wednesday in Hartford. His prior start, on 7/2, came against Bowie, where he allowed just two runs across six innings while striking out nine. Abeyta did allow a home run to Jud Fabian in his outing at Prince George's Stadium earlier this month. An undrafted free agent, signed by the Yankees in 2020 out of the University of Nevada, Abeyta features a low-mid-90s fastball, low-90s changeup, high-80s cutter, and low-80s slider.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 95, Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 60 total. However, in terms of portions, just over 63% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Baysox have been on their hottest stretch of the season as of late, as Bowie has won 10 of its last 12 games. In that span, the Baysox have fared particularly well with coming from behind. Five of Bowie's last six wins have been in come-from-behind fashion, when trailing entering the sixth inning or later. The Baysox have a +5 run differential in the sixth inning or later during that stretch, while having a -20 run differential late in games on the season.

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

The Baysox have enjoyed a majority of their success in 2023 away from Prince George's Stadium. After starting 4-10 away from home, Bowie has either won or split each of its past four road series (three series wins, one split), going 16-9 in the process. This, in part, has stemmed from the performance of the pitching staff, as the Baysox lead the Double-A level with a 3.46 ERA away from home this season - sixth-best in Minor League Baseball.

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .324 since the calendar flipped to June - including .316 in the month of July. Cook's 19 extra-base hits in that stretch (10 doubles, a triple, eight home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 13 stolen bases, in as many attempts, are fourth-most. Cook extended his active hitting streak to a season-high 10 games, with multiple hits in four of the contests. Wednesday night was also the first walk off of Cook's career. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (12), RBI (48), and stolen bases (18).

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Had a stellar month of May, where he pitched to a 0.49 ERA and held opponents to a .098 average - was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.
- Struggled in the two months afterward, moving on-and-off the 7-day injured list while posting a 6.57 ERA through June and July, before being placed on the injured list for the remainder of the season on August 4. Control issues also resurfaced in June in July with twice as many walks in each month as he had in April or May.
- College: Transferred to UT-Arlington from Weatherford College in 2020, after pitching at Weatherford for two seasons.

NOTES BY OUTING

- 4/12 Pitched in relief of Chayce McDermott, allowed a solo home run in his third inning of work after striking out two batters to start the frame.
- 4/19 First start. Struck out the first four batters faced, and retired the first nine. Did not allow a hit until the fifth inning, where he allowed two runs.
- 4/26 Pitched in relief of Connor Gillispie. Retired the first two batters faced, but still allowed a run in the same inning. Third inning of work struggled, allowing a walk and two doubles with one out.
- 5/3 Second start, allowed a leadoff home run in the second inning, and five runs in the fourth on four-straight baserunners and another homer.
- 5/9 Relieved Houston Roth. Single and two walks to open his second inning of work eventually led to two runs.
- 5/14 Third start. Gave up two extra-base hits and had no strikeouts.
- 5/21 Relieved Justin Armbruster. Walked two batters in first inning of work, and allowed an unearned run on a passed ball, but still struck out three in the frame.
- 5/26 Fourth start. Earned first win behind five no-hit innings. Was the second-night that the Bowie starter had thrown five hitless innings to begin the game (McDermott) First reliever gave up a base hit to the first batter faced.
- 6/1 Relieved Houston Roth. Allowed go-ahead two-run home run in the sixth, and another solo later in the frame, and one more in the seventh. Career high three home runs.
- 6/7 Struck out two batters in the first inning, but allowed four straight batters to reach with two outs in the second, including a two-run home run. Bowie lead 7-0, but only won 8-7.
- 6/13 Second pitch thrown was hit for a home run, allowed two more runs to score on two walks and two hits in the first.
- 6/18 After starting ahead 0-2 on the first batter, opened with back-to-back walks, and allowed a three-run home run. Walked two more batters after the home run.
- 6/24 Struck out the first four batters faced, but only one more in the fourth inning. Only allowed baserunners in two innings, while stranding a runner at third in both frames.
- 7/1 Walked three batters in the first inning, but reset to retire seven straight before allowing a leadoff home run and two runs in the fourth inning.
- 7/6 Only run scored following a single, balk, wild pitch, and groundout.
- 7/19 Struck out at least one batter in every inning. Did not allow a runner to reach second base.
