LAST GAME

On Sunday, the Baysox rallied in the sixth inning and hung on to take down the Harrisburg Senators 4-3. After Harrisburg took an early 2-0 lead, Bowie would get a run back in the bottom of the fifth on a Donta' Williams RBI single, before the Senators would tack on another run in the top of the sixth. Then, the Baysox would get to Harrisburg's left-handed starter Alemao Hernandez in the bottom half. Billy Cook led off the inning with a first pitch solo home run to make it 3-2, before Jackson Holliday hustled out an infield single. Holliday was on the second with two outs when a ground ball back to the mound from Shayne Fontana resulted in an errant toss to first from Hernandez, allowing Holliday to score and putting Fontana at second in a tie game. The next at-bat Rosa drove a single in to left field to score Fontana and give the Baysox the lead. Bowle would hold that lead for the remainder of the afternoon, with the game ending on a play at the plate, where Rosa was able to complete a relay to catcher Ramon Rodriguez, who tug out Harrisburg's Jackson Cluff trying to score from first on a single.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots enter today with a record of 53-35 - the second-best mark in the Eastern League. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has already clinched a postseason berth as first half champions in the Northeast division, but have a current record of 11-9 in the second half. The Patriots took four of six from the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium to open the second half a little under a month ago. Somerset continues to hold the best ERA (3.73) in the league, with the most strikeouts (912) as well. Offensively, they lead the league in home runs (136) and walks (435). The Patriots' roster includes eight of the Yankees' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, highlighted by OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY / No. 41 overall), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), OF Elijah Dunham (No. 16 NYY), and IF Tyler Hardman (No. 18 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Blane Abeyta is scheduled to open the series on the mound for Somerset. Abeyta has pitched to contact in 2023, scattering 84 hits through 79.2 innings, with his .269 opposing average sitting as the highest on the staff among qualifiers, while his 10 home runs allowed is the second-highest total amongst Patriot arms. Abeyta has allowed eight hits and three runs through 5.1 innings in each of his past two starts - 7/7 against Reading and this past Wednesday in Hartford. His prior start, on 7/2, came against Bowie, where he allowed just two runs across six innings while striking out nine. Abeyta did allow a home run to Jud Fabian in his outing at Prince George's Stadium earlier this month. An undrafted free agent, signed by the Yankees in 2020 out of the University of Nevada, Abeyta features a low-mid-90s fastball, low-90s changeup, high-80s cutter, and low-80s slider.

AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC

While the Baysox sit with the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League at 95, Bowie has struggled with the timeliness of its long balls. The Baysox have hit the third-most solo shots in the league at 60 total. However, in terms of portions, just over 63% of Bowie's home runs have been solo blasts. That is the highest portion of any team in the Eastern League.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Baysox have been on their hottest stretch of the season as of late, as Bowie has won 10 of its last 12 games. In that span, the Baysox have faired particularly well with coming from behind. Five of Bowie's last six wins have been in come-from-behind fashion, when trailing entering the sixth inning or later. The Baysox have a +5 run differential in the sixth inning or later during that stretch, while having a -20 run differential late in

LEADING THE WAY, AWAY FROM HOME

The Baysox have enjoyed a majority of their success in 2023 away from Prince George's Stadium. After starting 4-10 away from home, Bowie has either won or split each of its past four road series (three series wins, one split), going 16-9 in the process. This, in part, has stemmed from the performance of the pitching staff, as the Baysox lead the Double-A level with a 3.46 ERA away from home this season - sixth-best in Minor League

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook has enjoyed a breakout at the Double-A level in the summer months. Cook has hit .324 since the calendar flipped to June - including .316 in the month of July. Cook's 19 extra-base hits in that stretch (10 doubles, a triple, eight home runs) are also fifth-most in the league, while his 13 stolen bases, in as many attempts, are fourth-most. Cook extended his active hitting streak to a season-high 10 games, with multiple hits in four of the contests. Wednesday night was also the first walk off of Cook's career. Cook currently leads active Baysox hitters in home runs (12), RBI (48), and stolen bases (18).

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor leaguest 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen Iron-Birds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization hermann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles' left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Herrmann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox development coach for his first season in Bowie, after filling the same role for Aberdeen last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time in 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving no to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
