- The Blue Jays fell 9-8 to Tampa in a three-hour slugfest on Wednesday night at TD Ballpark.
- After the Jays fell behind 4-1 in the second inning, Dunedin rallied for four runs with two outs in the bottom of the second inning to take a 5-4 lead.
- Joey Votto collected two RBIs one on a second inning single and the next on an eighth inning double.
- Victor Arias went 3-4 with two doubles and a home run. Arjun Nimmala also roped two doubles and drove in two runs.
- The Blue Jays stranded the tying and winning runs on base to end the game in the bottom of the ninth inning.
- Blue Jays pitching did not allow a home run snapping a streak of seven straight games having allowed a longball.

### **SWEATING IT OUT**

Last night's one-run defeat marked the fourth consecutive game decided by one run for the Blue Jays, and their 31st this season - the most in the FSL. The Jays are 15-16 in those contests. 56 of the Blue Jays 82 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 29-27 record in those games.

## **BLUE JAYS BATS ARE BASHING**

Dunedin's bats stayed red-hot last night, tying a single-game high with eight extra base hits. Across the last nine games, the Blue Javs are hitting .283 with a .921 OPS - both the best in the FSL during that span.

## A PLUS ARIAS

Victor Arias tied a Blue Jays single game high with three extra base hits last night, helping him climb the league leaderboards in multiple categories. Arias ranks top 10 in the league in AVG (8th - .276), OBP (7th - .375), SLG (5th - .459), and OPS (5th - .834). Over his last 10 games, Arias is hitting .300 with a 1.028 OPS.

## CRISTIAN CRUSHES BASEBALLS

Cristian Feliz extended his season-long on base streak to nine games last night with a double and two walks. Feliz's 14 home runs this season are second in the FSL behind Ariel Almonte's 16. In six games against Clearwater last week, Feliz went 8-17 with 3 HRs and a league-leading 1.591 OPS to earn FSL Player of the Week honors. Feliz is on pace to hit the most home runs by a D-Jay in a single season since Orelvis Martinez hit 19 in 71 games in 2021.

### A GAME THAT SPANS GENERATIONS

Joey Votto's RBI single drove in Arjun Nimmala from second base in the second inning last night. Votto, 40 years old, was drafted over two years (2002) before Nimmala was born (10/16/05).

## NICE TO SEE YOU, NIMMALA

In 10 games since his return to Dunedin from the FCL Blue Jays, Arjun Nimmala is 13-37 (.351) with nine extra base hits.

## **SERIES SUCCESS**

With last week's five games to one series win, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in seven of their last eight sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series).

## FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

It was announced last Tuesday that Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez would represent Toronto in the All-Star Futures game on Saturday July 13 in Arlington. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.60), Ks (76), innings (70), and WHIP (1.04). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

### <u>HIITERS PARK</u>

TD Ballpark has proved to be the second-most home run friendly park in the Florida State League this season, as the Blue Jays and their opponents have combined for 77 home runs at the Venue. Bradenton's LECOM Park has seen the most homers with 83, while BayCare Ballpark is third with 64. The Blue Jays lead the league with 42 home runs allowed at home.

### REHAB CITY, USA

With Andres Sosa and Brennan Orf added to the mix Tuesday, Dunedin has hosted 16 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).
