**YESTERDAY...** Luis Trevino walked it off with an RBI single on Wednesday, helping the Hot Rods take down the Braves 4-3. In the first inning, Jacson McGowan collected a double and Grant Witherspoon hustled for a triple, both knocking in a run. Greg Jones added another run with a solo homer in the fifth inning. Colby White earned his first win of the season, while Zack Trageton tossed 5.0 innings out of the bullpen.

**NINE-STRAIGHT...** Bowling Green is enjoying a season-high nine game win streak. The streak started on July 11th in Rome against the Braves, and the Hot Rods carried it through the first half of the home-stand, sweeping Winston-Salem in a six-game series. The Hot Rods offense is putting up 5.5 runs per game and the pitching staff has posted a 2.60 ERA over that span. The streak also ties the second-longest run in team history (2017, 2016, & 2011) and is one behind the longest streak in Hot Rods history (10 games) in 2018 & 2019.

**RECORD BROKEN...** The Hot Rods have hit 110 home runs this season, breaking the franchise record of 106 set in 2011. Bowling Green has hit their 110 homers in 68 games, passing the record just over halfway through the season. The record set in 2011 was done in a 140 game season, opposed to the 120 game 2021 campaign.

**FAMILIAR FACES...** The Braves and Hot Rods have played 26 times this season, with Bowling Green leading the series 18-8. The offense is batting .225 against Rome, but has hit 29 of their homers this season with Braves pitchers on the mound. Hot Rods pitching has been sharp when facing Rome as well, posting a team ERA of 2.64 with 239 strikeouts in their 26 games pitched.

**GETTING THE CALL UP...** Both of the Hot Rods June Player and Pitcher of the Month are now playing in AA Montgomery. OF Niko Hulsizer received the call up to AA on July 13th after hitting .248 with 13 homers in 44 games. RHP Jayden Murray was called up on July 20th after posting a 7-1 and a High-A East leading 1.72 in 12 starts. Overall, Bowling Green has had nine players called up to the AA level in 2021.

**YESTERDAY'S NOTES...** Trageton tied his season-high with 5.0 innings pitched... This is the sixth time this season he has tossed 5.0 innings... Hollis collected his seventh multi-hit game of the year... Trevino had his sixth multi-hit performance of the season... His walk-off single is the first for the Hot Rods since June 29th... This is a season-high ninth consecutive win for the Hot Rods... Bowling Green extended their season-high win streak to nine games... This is also their third straight win over Rome... The Hot Rods are 18-8 overall this season against the Braves... BG is 29-12 when scoring first... They are 11-8 in one-run games... Bowling Green is 8-2 in day games...

**NOW PITCHING: MICHAEL MERCADO...** The Hot Rods rightly picked up his first win since July 12, 2018, in his last start against Winston-Salem. He also tied his season-high with 5.0 innings pitched, marking the fourth time this season he has gone 5.0 innings. His five strikeouts in his last outing was the most for him since June 29th, where he struck out six against Greensboro.

July 22, 2011

On this day in Hot Rods history, Bowling Green held the Burlington Bees to one hit in a 2-0 win. In the bottom of the fifth inning, Cody Rogers singled to bring in the first run and take a 1-0 lead. In the next inning, Julio Cedeneno crushed a solo homer to give the Hot Rods their second and final run. Enny Romero started the game, tossing a hitless 4.0 innings while walking three and striking out seven. Victor Mateo earned his 10th win of the season, hurling 3.0 hitless innings and striking out four. Stephen Hiscock picked up his first save, giving up the Bee's only hit in a scoreless 2.0 innings.

**2019:** Did not pitch in 2019 due to injury... Was placed on the injured list June 14, 2019.

**High School:** During his senior year at Westview High School Mercado dominated opponents... He finished his final year of high school with nine wins, holding a 0.69 ERA... He tossed 70.2 and struck out 97 batters over that span... He held opponents to a stunning .120 batting average... Boasted a 1.000 fielding percentage... Finished high school at 6'5" and 165 pounds... Was ranked the 1,507 player in the nation and the 164th player in the state of California by MaxPreps.
