PAPILLION, NEB. - The Omaha Storm Chasers dropped game one of a six-game series 13-7, against the St. Paul Saints Tuesday at CHS Field.

- The series opener started with the Saints plating three runs on two hits in the bottom of the 2nd inning for a 3-0 lead, while Omaha was held scoreless over the first three frames, with the lineup retired in order the first time through.
- Omaha stormed ahead in the top of 4th inning and scored 6 runs on 6 hits, as the first six in the lineup reached and scored ... **John Rave** doubled and scored on a single from **Drew Waters** ... **Nick Pratto** drove home Waters and **Nick Loftin** with a two-run single of his own to tie the game at 3-3 ... the next two pitches left the yard as **Devin Mann** and **Ryan Fitzgerald** became the first Chasers to hit back-to-back home runs this season, a two-run shot and solo homer that put Omaha up 6-3.
- Starter **Daniel Lynch IV** went 4.0 innings, struck out 4 and allowed 4 runs on four hits, with St. Paul adding a run in the bottom of the 4th inning ... **Austin Cox** entered the game for Lynch in the bottom of the 5th inning and the Saints continued to inch closer, tagging him for an unearned run that moved the score to 6-5.
- Reliever **John McMillon** entered in the bottom of the 6th inning behind Cox as St. Paul continued to rally and plated three runs of McMillon to take an 8-6 lead ... a home run, walk and 3 singles plated three runs to give the Saints a lead they held onto the rest of the game.
- Omaha came back in the top of the 7th inning, as **Tyler Gentry** tripled to open the frame, then Rave ripped a line drive single to right field to cut the deficit to 8-7, moving the potential tying run to third base with one out, represented by **Cam Devaney** ... Devaney, who drew a walk after Gentry's triple, was stranded on third base and Omaha couldn't get any closer the rest of the afternoon.
- Colin Selby** worked out of McMillon's jam in the 6th inning, then allowed a leadoff homer to **Alex Isola** in the bottom of the 7th as St. Paul answered back the run Omaha scored in the top of the inning, but Selby retired his next three to finish the frame.
- Major League rehabber **Jake Brentz** took over for the bottom of the 8th and struggled, as St. Paul plated 4 runs of insurance on 3 walks and 3 hits, capped by a three-run homer from **Michael Helman**, the Saints' fourth home run of the day, to give St. Paul a 13-7 lead over Omaha that ended as the final score of the game.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

THE SAINTS CAME MARCHING IN

Yesterday's 13-7 loss featured the most runs the Storm Chasers have allowed in a game this season.

- The 6-run loss to St. Paul was the second-worst loss of this season and just the third time this year Omaha has lost by more than 3 runs.
- Omaha is the last team in the International League to allow at least 10 runs in one game, the Chasers are one of 2 teams to only allow 10+ runs once this season (also: Syracuse Mets) ... 15 of the 20 IL pitching staffs have had 3 or more 10+ run games.
- Yesterday featured season-worst for the pitching staff in runs allowed (13), walks (9) and opposing total bases (25).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has won 10 of its last 12 games ... 9 of those 12 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 8 of the team's 10 wins in that 12-game stretch.

- After Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games, 7 of the last 9 wins have had a save awarded ... **Will Klein** has earned 3 saves in the last 7 wins, while **Walter Pennington** has 2 and **Carlos Hernández** and **Sam Long** each have 1.
- In total, 25 of Omaha's 37 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (68%), including 10 of 13 losses this season ... in 5 of the 10 games that Omaha has lost by 3 or less runs, the Chasers have had the tying run at the plate or on base.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 218 to 175 this season, a +43 run differential.

- A +43 run differential ranks as the best in the International League, is 2nd in Triple-A and tied 6th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams ... Oklahoma City leads the Triple-A level at a +66 run differential, while Modesto ... leads MiLB at +115.
- Omaha has had a positive run differential after 30 of 37 games this year, including 28 straight games ... last year, the Chasers only had a positive differential after 28 of the team's 145 games and never more than 15 days in a row ... in 2022, the Chasers did have a positive run differential after 112 of 149 games, but only 5 times in the first 42.

GETTING OFFENSIVE

Omaha has been one of the top hitting teams in the International League in the month of May, with a 10-2 record so far this month.

- Omaha leads the league in doubles this month (33) and is tied for the league lead in runs scored ... the Chasers are tied 3rd this month in home runs (14) 4th in hits (113) and total bases (194) and tied 4th in stolen bases (16).
- Overall in 2024, Omaha's 218 runs scored rank 6th in the International League and tied 12th in Triple-A, with 6 of the 10 Pacific Coast League teams ahead of the Chasers.

JUST THE 2 OF US...

- The Storm Chasers are one of the best 2-out hitting teams at the Triple-A level.
- In 2-out situations this season, Omaha is slashing .262/.340/.490 (107-for-408) ... among all 30 Triple-A teams, the Chasers are 2nd in slugging (.490) and 4th in OPS (.803) ... 200 total bases with 2 outs are tied 4th-best at the Triple-A level.

TODAY'S START

- Cessa is making his **8th appearance** and **7th start** of the season after opening the year on Omaha's Opening Day roster ... he spent a week on the Development List (April 5 to 11), but has made 4 starts since.
- The Royals in 2024 mark Cessa's 7th MLB organization ... was with the Mets for the first 8 seasons (2008-15) of his professional career before being traded to the Detroit Tigers midseason in **2015** and dealt to the New York Yankees later that offseason ... joined the Cincinnati Reds in a trade in **2021** and pitched for them through **2023** ... pitched for Washington and Colorado's Triple-A affiliates in **2023** ... Cessa has made five MLB Opening Day rosters: **2016, 2019 & 2021** with the Yankees and **2022-23** with the Reds.

LAST OUTING: THURSDAY, MAY 9 VS. JACKSONVILLE

Was his longest start of the year by pitches (74) and batters faced (20), his first time facing the opposing lineup a third time through ... worked around a pair of runners for the Royals in the 2nd on 4 hits, a walk and an error, with only 2 runs earned ... walked a batter in a scoreless 3rd inning, allowed a 2-out single and was removed in the top of the 4th inning.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 6 Cactus League games out of the bullpen for the Royals and went 0-0 with a 4.60 ERA (4 ER in 7.2 IP), with 5 strikeouts ... held opponents to a .179 average (5-for-28).
- Made his first appearance of the season on March 30 vs. Iowa with 2.2 innings of relief but has made starts his last 6 appearances.

CAREER NOTES

- Was on the 2023 World Baseball Classic roster for Team Mexico and pitched 2.0 innings of relief on March 11 vs. Columbia ... returned to spring training with Cincinnati after only pitching the one game, to prepare for the MLB regular season in the Reds rotation.
- In his third season with Cincinnati, opened the regular season with the Reds and made 7 appearances (6 starts) before he was designated for assignment on May 9 and released May 14 ... did not appear in an MLB game the rest of the year.
