JACKSONVILLE LOSES SEESAW BATTLE 11-8

Jacksonville erased a six-run deficit only to see Charlotte score four in the eighth to win 11-8. The Knights jumped out to a lead with a four-run first and two-run second. A five-run Shrimp fifth pulled Jacksonville within just one run. After Charlotte tacked on a run in the sixth, **Jerar Encarnacion** homered in the seventh to make it a one-run game. An error led to the tying run in the eighth before **Xavier Edwards** doubled in the go-ahead run. However, four Knights runs in the bottom of the eighth won it for Charlotte.

X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 29 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 50-for-124 at the plate, slashing .403/.435/.516/.951 with five doubles, three home runs, 20 RBIs and 25 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in the International League in batting average (.365) and fifth in on-base percentage (.433). Among the 267 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (3.6 percent). He has registered at least three hits in each of the last six games, going 19-for-30 in that span.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 39 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 41-for-139 (.295/.376/.698/1.074) at the plate with nine doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 40 RBIs and 26 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 18.5 percent of the time in 2023.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Including an 11-loss to Charlotte on Saturday, nine of Jacksonville's last 14 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Of the Jumbo Shrimp's 85 games played thus far in 2023, 47 have been decided by these slim margins. Jacksonville is 22-25 (.468) in these contests this season, but they excelled in them during an 80-69 2022 campaign, going 44-38 (.537). In 2021, when the club went 75-55, Jacksonville was 49-28 (.636) in games decided by three runs or fewer.

NINTH TIME'S A CHARM!

After falling in the first two games of their series at Memphis on May 2-3, Jacksonville rallied to win the series, taking the final four games. After that, though, the Jumbo Shrimp lost four consecutive sets before finally splitting a pair of series with Nashville and Memphis. They then lost four of six at Gwinnett before splitting their series with Durham last week. However, by taking the first four games of their series at Charlotte, Jacksonville has finally snapped an eight-set drought without a series victory. It was the club's longest such drought since June 11-August 11, 2015, when they went 12 consecutive series' without a win in what turned out to be a 57-81 (.413) campaign.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on Sunday, Jacksonville has scored at least five runs in nine consecutive contests, their best such run of the season, as well as in 11 of their last 12 games. Over this 12-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 87 runs (7.3 per game), ranking third in the International League, while batting .292/.387/.491/.878, figures that respectively rank fifth, seventh, sixth and fifth. Over the season's first 73 games, Jacksonville's 347 runs (4.8 per game) ranked 19th in the 20-team circuit. The club collectively batted just .247/.331/.404/.735, which placed 18th, 20th, 18th and 20th, respectively.

KNIGHTY-KNIGHT

Jacksonville has dominated Charlotte over the series' first four games in the Queen City. The Jumbo Shrimp have outscored the Knights by a whopping 45-26 margin. Of the 89 half-innings thus far in the series, Jacksonville has led at the end of 61 of them. The game has been tied at the end of just eight half-innings, with Charlotte holding a lead for just 20 half-frames. With one more win in this set, the Jumbo Shrimp will win five games in a series for the first time since beating Memphis in five of six games from August 2-7, 2022, and the first time on the road since knocking off the Redbirds in five of six games from May 3-7, 2022 in Tennessee.

SHRIMP BITES

JAX starters have gone at least 5.2 in six of their last seven games after doing so just twice in the previous 11 games.

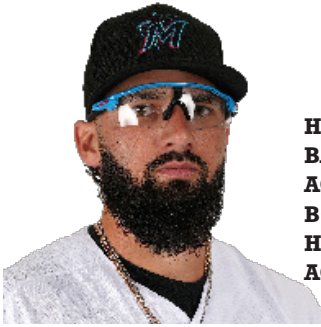

ABOUT DEVIN

-In the summer of 2015, Smeltzer played collegiate summer baseball for the Hyannis Harbor Hawks of the Cape Cod Baseball League, where he was co-MVP of the league's all-star game, and tossed a nine-inning no-hitter in which he missed a perfect game by a single walk.

-The San Diego Padres selected him in the 33rd round of the 2014 MLB draft, but he chose to enroll at Florida Gulf Coast University to play college baseball for the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles rather than sign with the Padres.

-After one year with the Eagles, Smeltzer transferred to San Jacinto College, so that he would become eligible in the 2016 MLB draft. Smeltzer had a 9-3 record and a 1.18 ERA with 128 strikeouts in 91.2 innings pitched for San Jacinto's baseball team.

-Smeltzer committed to transferring to Texas Tech after his sophomore year, but the Los Angeles Dodgers selected Smeltzer in the fifth round of the 2016 MLB draft. He signed with the Dodgers rather than transferring to Texas Tech, and received a \$500,000 signing bonus.

2022 SEASON

-The Twins promoted Smeltzer back to the major leagues on May 14, 2022.[18] On October 11, Smeltzer was sent outright to Triple-A and chose to elect free agency and landed in Jacksonville.

2021 SEASON

-On July 17, 2021, Smeltzer was placed on the 60-day injured list with left elbow inflammation. Smeltzer made one appearance for the Twins in 2021 and was outrighted off of the 40-man roster on November 19, 2021.

2020 SEASON

-Smeltzer made Twins Opening Day roster, the first of his career.

-Four of six relief appearances were of 2.0 innings-or-more. Went 0-0, 4.15 ERA (4.1 IP, 2 ER) in one start and 2-0, 7.71 ERA (11.2 IP, 10 ER) in six relief appearances. Held right-handed batters to a .269 average and left-handed batters to a .385 (5-for-13) average.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Smeltzer attended Bishop Eustace Preparatory School in Pennsauken, NJ before pitching two seasons at San Jacinto College in Houston, TX.

-Smeltzer had his picture posted on the school's Wall of Legends.
