**HOW SWEET:** With last night's 7-1 win, Sounds Manager Rick Sweet picked up his 400th win as the Sounds skipper. Sweet enters 2025 as the winningest active manager in Minor League Baseball and has the fifth-most wins in MiLB history.

**ROSTER CONSTRUCTION:** The 2025 Nashville Sounds Opening Day roster features 13 active players that appeared for the Sounds last season and all but five players played at the Triple-A level in 2024.

There are six members of the Brewers' 40-man roster: RHP Grant Anderson, RHP Logan Henderson, RHP Carlos Rodriguez, LHP Grant Wolfram, INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio.

Five players are listed among the Brewers' Top 30 prospects (MLB Pipeline): Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Logan Henderson (#13), Craig Yoho (#19), Caleb Durbin (#22), Carlos Rodriguez (#23).

**ON THE BUMP:** Brewers' no. 13-ranked prospect Logan Henderson will make his season debut on Saturday night. The right-hander made his Triple-A debut last year and made six starts for the Sounds, going 1-3 with a 4.56 ERA. The right-hander ended the 2024 season 8th in the Brewers farm system in strikeouts (104), was T-8th in wins (7), T-9th in GS (19) and was added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19, 2024.

Over his professional career, Henderson starts the 2025 season 11-10 in 44 career starts and boasts a career 3.11 ERA with 233 strikeouts to just 47 career walks.

For the Jumbo Shrimp, **RHP Robinson Piña** will make his Jacksonville debut on Saturday night. The right-hander spent the 2024 season in the Philadelphia Phillies organization, combining to go 13-8 with a 4.18 ERA between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley. His 13 wins were tied for the third-most among full-season minor leaguers last year. His 132 strikeouts were second-most in the Phillies organization and he paced their farm system with his 129.1 IP, was 3rd in WHIP (1.26), and 4th in BAA (.266).

**OPENING YAY:** With the win on Friday night, the Sounds record on Opening Day now sits at 22-25 all-time and Nashville improved to 29-18 in home openers.

**MASHVILLE:** Dating back to the end of the 2024 season, the Sounds have homered in seven straight games. The six-straight home runs to end 2024 was the longest-HR streak by the team.

**OOOOH, THEY STEALIN':** The Sounds swiped five bases on Friday night including two each from Jared Oliva and Raynel Delgado. The five stolen bases are the most on an Opening Day by a Sounds team since 2005 when MLB Stats Portal stops tracking team high/losses. The five stolen bases are also tied for the fifth-most overall by Nashville for a single-game since 2009. Nashville and Iowa both had five stolen bases in their games last night.

**TREYNEL:** Raynel Delgado matched his single-game career-high with his three hit performance on Friday night. It was the 16th time in his career that he had three hits in a game. His three-hits are tied for the second most by a Nashville player on Opening Night over the last 15 seasons.

**DURBIN DINGERS:** Caleb Durbin hit the first home run for the Sounds this season with a two-run home run in the bottom of the third inning on Friday night. It was the first time in his professional career that he has homered on Opening Day. Durbin, who checks in as the Brewers' no. 22-ranked prospect was acquired by Milwaukee in the trade that sent Devin Williams to the Yankees last December.

**C-ROD:** Friday night marked the eighth time in Carlos Rodriguez's 78-game career that he has had 7+ strikeouts while working 5.0 IP or less.

### 2024 SEASON NOTES

**SPRING BREAK:** Was invited to early camp by the Brewers and made his first Cactus League appearance on February 26th against the Reds in the 7th inning (1.0 IP, HR, K)...Was one of 10 pitchers on the Brewers roster for the inaugural Spring Breakout Game against the Royals but faced just one batter before straining an oblique muscle that delayed the start of his season.

**NONCOMPLEX:** Returned to the mound in May on rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League where he worked 4.2 no-run innings and allowed a pair of hits and struck out 10 of the 16 batters he faced.

**BIG APPLE(TON):** Activated from the 7-day IL on May 24th and made two starts with High-A Wisconsin...Took a loss while allowing one earned over 2.2 one-hit innings in his first appearance and then worked 4.0 IP of no-run ball where he struck out seven without a walk and allowing three hits.

**OH SHUCKS:** Over nine starts in his first taste of Double-A from June 9-August 2 he was tied for the league-lead with six wins, posted the best WHIP (0.88), had second-most strikeouts (58), third-most IP (46.1), and had the eighth-best ERA (3.30)...His 58 strikeouts were T-6th across MiLB during the span....Set his career-high with 6.1 IP his final start with Biloxi (2 H, 2 ER, 8 K).

**KING OF THE SOUTH:** Earned Southern League and Brewers MiLB Pitcher of the Month honors in June after posting a 4-0 record and carried a 1.66 ERA in his four starts...Held opponents to a .192 BAA and matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN & 6/28 vs. PNS)...His 29 strikeouts paced the Southern League from the time of his first start and were third-best overall in June.

**NASH-TY STUFF:** After leading the Brewers farm system in strikeouts (78) and being tied for the second-most wins (6) over his first 13 starts, he was promoted to Nashville and made his Triple-A debut on 8/9 vs. IND...Suffered the loss in his first appearance despite allowing one run on three hits over 4.0 IP...Spun his lone Triple-A quality start in his second appearance on Aug. 15 @ DUR with six shutout innings, eight strikeouts, and three hits allowed.

**ORG CHARTS:** Despite the late start, ended the year 8th in strikeouts (104), T-8th in wins (7), and T-9th in GS (19) among Brewers farmhands...Added to the 40-Man Roster on Nov. 19th.

**2023:** Began the year as Milwaukee's no. 15-rated prospect (Baseball America)...Made his season debut on May 9th with Carolina...From the time of his arrival, he ranked third in Low-A as well as the Carolina League in Strikeouts (106) while pacing all Mudcats...His strikeouts total was 10th-best in the Brewers farm system...Set his career-high with 10 strikeouts in his final start of the year on Sept. 2 vs Down East...35.2 percent K rate ranked fourth among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP...Tossed the first of three quality starts on the season on July 22 vs. Kannapolis which also set his career-high with 6.0 IP.

**2022:** Missed the majority of the season after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring and was placed on the 60-day IL on June 1st...Totaled 13.2 IP and seven starts between Carolina and the Arizona Complex League...Elbow soreness kept him from continuing his season in the Arizona Fall League.

**MISC:** Pitched one season at McLennan CC and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 appearances (14 GS)...Led NJCAA Division I in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Guided the Highlanders to first championship since 1983 and struck out 17 over eight innings of one-run ball in the championship game en route to tournament MVP honors...Was his seventh straight outing with 10+ K.
